WHILE WE'RE AT IT... October 1, 2017

Dear Friends,

Progress in being made on the St. Lawrence Parish Center repairs. The water main leak did some extensive damage to ceilings and floors, and a contractor is in the process of replacing them. Most of the cost will be covered by insurance but unfortunately not all and we'll have to cover some expenses ourselves.

Having the Parish Center disrupted in this way, even temporarily, made me reflect on how vital it is to the life of the parish. We've been able to work around it by relocating activities to unaffected parts of the building. But it made me realize just how far we have come in transforming a closed down school and potential "white elephant" into a vital, state-of-the-art parish center.



In 2008, it was just an empty school with nothing much going on. A year later, thanks to Donna Collelo and Maureen Patterson, our educational mission came back to life with the still-successful Early Childhood Learning Center.

Now every Sunday in the Parish Center there is our KidZone baby-sitting for 0-3 year olds during Mass. All Stars for kids 4-6 and Kidz Chapel for 7-9 year olds run each week during the Liturgy of the Word. Our Religious Education program operates and houses its offices there, as well as the Family Program of religious education there. Our Edge Middle School youth ministry and high school Lifeteen program also operate out of the building. CYO and special camps use the gym.

Our parish museum with artifacts from nearly 140 years of parish life is on the first floor of the Parish Center.

On the second floor, in what used to be the convent for the Sisters of Divine Compassion (up until 1978 – 40 years ago!) major renovations have re-purposed that area into our Adult Faith Formation Center where our Scripture programs, Women's Gift, Men's Ministry, Oremus program on prayer, and many other formative mini-courses go on. Our parish organizations all share the space as well for their mission to help build up the parish.

We use the building at night each winter to take in the homeless through our collaboration with the Brewster Emergency Shelter Program. We adapted an unused area for showers and laundry for the homeless to help them feel our support and our respect.

Last year our expert building maintenance staff, Luis Rueda and Pablo Quille took on the huge job of renovating the old school cafeteria and turned it into an inviting dining hall for parish functions of up to 180 people. It can host parish dinners and conferences and it is where we run the Alpha evangelization program.

We're using every part of the building to build up our community of faith and to make people real disciples of Jesus Christ and reach out to those who do not know him yet. That's the mission of this parish.

A little flooding can create some headaches and require some logistical magic, but it can't stop the parish from doing what we're here for: to lead people closer to Christ.



What Do I Do? And More! 8 Ways to Pray During Adoration Becky Roach

Maybe, you've heard about the benefits of Adoration or heard some of your friends talk about "going to Adoration," but you still don't really understand what that means. That's ok! Though the practice of Adoration has been a part of the Catholic faith since the very beginning, it has experienced a revival of sorts among Catholics today.

What is Adoration?

When Catholics say they are "going to Adoration," they are typically referring to Eucharistic Adoration. Which, in the most basic terms, is the worship of the Eucharist outside of the Mass. The Eucharistic Host is displayed in a monstrance on the altar so that all can see and pray in the presence of Christ.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that, "Adoration is the first attitude of man acknowledging that he is a creature before his Creator. It exalts the greatness of the Lord who made us and the almighty power of the Savior who sets us free from evil. Adoration is an homage to the spirit to the "King of Glory," respectful silence in the presence of the "ever greater" God. Adoration of the thrice-holy and sovereign God of love blends with humility and gives assurance to our supplications." (CCC 2628) We can show our adoration to God in many ways, but in Eucharistic Adoration, we spend time adoring the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

What is the Point of Eucharistic Adoration?

When Can I Go to Adoration? This depends on your parish. Some parishes are blessed to have Perpetual Adoration, which means that you are able to pray before the Lord at any time, day or night. In order to have perpetual adoration, at least one person must be present in Adoration at all times because Jesus may never be left alone. If your parish does not have perpetual Adoration,

there are usually specific times set aside for Adoration during the week. There is no need to sign-up or ask permission to attend, you can just show up and be with Lord.

What Do I Do During Eucharistic Adoration?

If you attend Adoration at your parish, it will most likely be in a small chapel or part of the Church. As a form of respect, you should always genuflect when you see the Lord in the Host. Maintain an attitude of respect, and if others are present, silence. On retreats or other special occasions, there may be music playing to help foster a spirit of prayer, worship, and Adoration. Always keep in mind that you are in the presence of God!

Kneeling, sitting, standing, and even laying on the floor before the Blessed Sacrament are all appropriate forms of prayer. Let your posture reflect your worship of the King and do what is comfortable for you. You really don't have to "do" anything during Adoration. You can just sit there and look at Jesus. Take the time to be with Him. If you are the only person in the chapel, don't be afraid to pray or sing aloud. This is your personal time with Christ.

The Saints Encourage Us to Go to Adoration

"Whenever I go to the chapel, I put myself in the presence of our good Lord, and I say to him, 'Lord, I am here. Tell me what you would have me to do' . . . And then, I tell God everything that is in my heart. I tell him about my pains and my joys, and then I listen. If you listen, God will also speak to you, for with the good Lord, you have to both speak and listen. God always speaks to you when you approach him plainly and simply." – St. Catherine Labouré

The time you spend with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is the best time that you will spend on earth. Each moment that you spend with Jesus will deepen your union with Him and make your soul everlastingly more glorious and beautiful in heaven, and will help bring about an everlasting peace on earth." – St. Teresa of Calcutta

Have you ever been in love? Like, where you're smiling all the time, and everything somehow reminds you of the other person kind of love.



Like, when you're annoyed because your significant other did something that bothers you, or didn't do what you asked of them, but no matter how frustrated you feel, you still care about the other person kind of love.

Well, I feel that way about God. Just the thought of Him makes me smile, and I see Him in pretty much everything I do. I run to Him in many ways, and Adoration is just one of those ways. I am a broken person, but the love of God shines through the cracks of my heart and completes me.

There is nothing out there, not a parent, a boyfriend, a job, or a bobby, or anything that could fill the cracks of my brokenness with light the way God does. We can search, and I have searched, and I have given myself over to people and things that I thought were sure to fill me and give me joy, only to constantly be in a state of dissatisfaction.

There are a few lines from one of my favorite prayers, the Prayer of Abandonment by Blessed Charles de Foucauld, that I feel sums up the relationship I strive to have with God. It reads "Into your hands I commend my soul; I offer it to you with all the love of my heart, for I love you Lord, and need to give myself, to surrender myself into your hands, without reserve, and with boundless confidence, for you are my Father"

I'm not always thrilled with God, sometimes He does things that frustrate me because I don't understand why He does them, or I don't feel happy because His plans don't match the ones that I made. But, I love Him. I can't imagine a day without Him. I need Him. I need to run to Him in all things. Adoration is a beautiful opportunity that He has given us where we can run to Him and share our lives with Him. Going to adoration is one way that to keep that light of His shining bright inside of me. He is my lifeline. Without God, without the light that makes me whole, I would never be able to find authentic joy in my relationships, or never would I be able to experience genuine happiness from my job or hobbies.

"Pie-crust" Promises

In 1964 the movie "Mary Poppins" took the world by storm. It is an amusing child's film filled with cute phrases and witty music.

There is, however, a scene in the movie that speaks rather poignantly to today's Gospel. At the end of her first day as the new Nanny, Mary is putting the two children to bed. Little Jane asks Mary: "You will never leave us, will you?" Her younger brother quickly adds his own thought: "Will you stay if we promise to be good?"

Mary Poppins smiles and replies, "That's a pie-crust promise. Easily made. Easily broken."

The Gospel today is a warning about making "pie-crust promises." The story of the two brothers, one who promises and does nothing and one who balks but achieves the task, is meant to remind us that God is not interested in words but in actions. Faith is not

a matter of knowing what to say. Rather, faith is a matter of knowing what to do.

It reminds me of an ancient Japanese legend that tells of a man who dies and goes to heaven. Heaven is beautiful beyond words. But in his journey through paradise the man comes upon a room lined with shelves. On the shelves are stacks of human ears.

A heavenly guide explains that these ears belonged to all the people on earth who listened each week to the Word of God, but never acted on God's teachings. Their worship never resulted in action. Therefore, only their ears ended up in heaven.

"Pie-crust" promises and ears that hear with no actions to follow are sadly more common than we would like to admit. God isn't interested in our telling others "I am

a person of faith." God is interested in our showing others how much we are a person of faith by what we say and by what we do.


