

Dear Parishioners,



Repentance and Preparing for Christmas

TOM AND APRIL HOOPES


Today we hear quite a statement about quite a man: "John the Baptist appeared in the desert proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. People of the whole Judean countryside and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem were going out to him and were being baptized by him in the Jordan River as they acknowledged their sins." This is a man who wore only camel's hair, ate essentially whatever he could find in his desert, and stationed himself outside the holiest city on earth. Yet "all of Jerusalem," as some translations put it, "were going out to him."

We know that God sent his only Son "when the fullness of time had come." We are well aware that many elements of society were not willing to receive him at that time. But today's Gospel shows that the time was also ripe with people who were willing to try something radical.

The Church brings this very reading to us at this time of the year in order to propose that we should be willing to try something radical, too. In order to receive the fullness of Christmas joy, we should do as John the Baptist says: Repent. That's easier said than done. It requires a very deep and careful look at oneself to find what one really needs. For John the Baptist, it meant rejecting life as he had lived it. What will it mean for us?

It should mean a radical turn in our lives, too. St. Gregory the Great described how true virtue only comes at a cost: "There are some who wish to be humble, but without being despised; who wish to be happy with their lot, but without being needy; who wish to be chaste, without mortifying the body; to be patient without suffering. They want both to acquire virtues and to avoid the sacrifices those virtues involve. They are like soldiers who flee the battlefield and try to win the war from the comfort of the city."

Have we fled Advent for the comfort of Christmas too soon? Christmas will definitely bring us tidings of comfort and joy. But true Christmas joy comes at a cost: the cost of our ego. Repent! Go to confession! And then receive the Good News.

8 REASONS TO BRING YOUR CHILD TO MASS

Children learn to value what their parents and extended family value, and they learn not so much by what we say as what we do. Make regular participation at Mass together a fundamental priority. Taking our children to Mass will:

- 1. Reveal their true identity as beloved children of God. In a fast-changing world, children need to know that they are valued and loved.
- 2. Shape their values. People take on the values of those with whom they associate. Join together with the people who strive to follow Jesus' way.
- 3. Connect them with many generations. Mass unites people of all ages.
- Populate their imaginations with stories of faith.
 Expose your child to the stories that lead to abundant life.
- 5. Fill their hearts with songs that shape their souls. Music has an impact. The songs we sing at Mass help us to see how God is active in our lives.
- 6. Nurture their inner life. Attend to your whole child; don't neglect his or her spiritual self. Worship brings our spiritual selves to life.
- 7. Feed them on the journey. Our children will face many challenges in their lives. Jesus offers his very self to them no matter what comes.
- 8. Help them to find their true home. God longs for the whole family to gather around the table. In the Eucharist, we realize that we are all one in God.

Life from the Edge

Shortly after I became a member of St. Lawrence O'Toole Parish I heard about their new Religious

Education program for 6 - 8 grades, called Edge. I had been a Catechist for many years in my former parish and immediately was drawn to learn about this program as I always felt that something was missing in the standard programs. The Edge program had all the tools to introduce and instruct the children on how to discover a more personal side to their faith. To learn that their faith is not just being a good person, going to Mass and receiving the Sacraments (although these are core Catholic requirements) but in addition to recognize and experience Jesus's existence in their lives. To feel His protection, comfort, love, mercy, forgiveness and to know, really know, His enduring love for them. It allows them to explore their faith through bible scripture and how the Word applies to them personally in their current circumstances at school and at home. The program builds their confidence as Catholics to live with the love and hope that their Lord has promised them. These tools will help them through their faith journey.

One night in my small group discussion we were talking about the Scripture, Isaiah 41:13 "For I, the Lord your God will hold your right hand, saying to you, Fear not, I will help you." I noticed one boy was very quiet looking sad. When small group was over I asked him if he was okay and he told me no, he hasn't gotten a lot of sleep at night because he worries that his parents are going to die. The EDGE program also includes the opportunity for the children to go to Adoration in which we were heading to then (I am sure this was the Lord's perfect plan to have Adoration that very night just for this little boy). I told the boy that Adoration was the perfect time to let the Lord help him just like we just read. I told him to talk to Jesus about his worry about his parents and ask for help. After Adoration this boy came to me and said simply, 'I feel so much better". There is nothing more I can say to express the joys that come from being a group leader and the fruits of the Edge program.

I can honestly say that serving the Parish in Edge strengthens my hope and deepens my faith in which I feel blessed. New programs such as Edge allow the children to think and respond with a faith attitude. Thank you St. Lawrence O'Toole for stepping out of the box.




