Dear Friends,

Finally we've had our first heat wave and we've passed the 4<sup>th</sup> of July so we are officially into summer – like it or not! I thought I'd offer some rules to make the summer worth while for you and your family:

1. Plan – don't just let the days drift by. Even if you are staying close to home, plan some time off. I grew up in New York and never saw the Statue of Liberty until I was out of college. A couple of friends and I decided to do it one summer day, and it was a treat. There are probably 20 nearby places you have hardly ever but should get to visit... start with Ground Zero, the Hudson River, Central Park, the Bronx Zoo, West Point, the Divine Mercy Shrine in Stockbridge...
2. Make Memories – pictures and videos are so much easier to do than when we were kids... and write things down so you won't forget it all. When you're older, you'll love revisiting these summers.
3. Volunteer – we're always too busy and we get stuck on our own running around. How about connecting with a nonprofit to help others? Go fix a door, paint a house, sit and visit with a shut in... giving back is so key for us to become who we should be.
4. Read stuff – off with the TV and electronics and pick up some good books that are not just entertainment, but will teach you things you don't know. My mom made me enroll in the library book club every summer (probably just to keep me out of her hair) but it got me loving to learn.
5. Push your kids: turn off the screens and make them take up a hobby and develop a talent. Maybe music, painting, writing... nothing creative comes from playing video games. They'll be better people the more talents they develop.
6. Make a new friend. Don't let the summer go by unless you've worked up a new friendship for life. Time is short and you've got to get into relationships by working at them.
7. Family time – don't let everyone scatter in different directions. Make a family night and watch a movie and order a pizza. Go someplace together. Families don't become families just because they have the same address but because they are united.
8. Get to know God better. At the end of summer, why not have a closer relationship with Him? Pick up the Gospel for ten minutes and day and read and reflect on it. Say a rosary. Drop in to a daily Mass... read a spiritual book to learn something new about our faith.

Whatever you do, remember our time is short and we need to take advantage of the opportunities we have to grow and become who we should be.

## just have faith

*While he was still speaking people from the synagogue official's house arrived and said, "Your daughter has died; why trouble the teacher any longer?" Disregarding the message that was reported, Jesus said to the synagogue official, "Do not be afraid; just have faith. "He did not allow anyone to accompany him inside except Peter, James, and John, the brother of James. When they arrived at the house of the synagogue official, he caught sight of a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly. So he went in and said to them, "Why this commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but asleep. "And they ridiculed him. Then he put them all out. He took along the child's father and mother and those who were with him and entered the room where the child was. He took the child by the hand and said to her, "Talitha koum," which means, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!" The girl, a child of twelve, arose immediately and walked around. At that they were utterly astounded.*

*—Mark 5:35-42*

I remember when I was a teenager involved in youth ministry, there was a man in our area that would frequent retreats and lock-in's, telling the story of his daughter who was essentially brain-dead in a hospital bed. She had been given no chance to survive, so he was asked to give the directive to take her off life support. To aid in his discernment process, he went to Mass in the hospital chapel. On his way up the Communion aisle, somehow the Eucharist fell to the floor in front of him. He bent over, picked up the Eucharist, and consumed it. A few people at that Mass had witnessed this occurrence. A man who was there afterwards spoke to

him on the way to the elevator. The stranger told him that because Jesus had fallen and he had bent down to pick Him up, a miracle was in store for him. When he got off the elevator for his daughter's floor, he saw that a great commotion had begun and nurses were racing down the hall: to his daughter's room. With anguish, he ran to the room, and this supposedly brain-dead girl, the one he would have to take off life support, sat up and said, "I am hungry." As the years went by, that girl went on to attend Georgetown University and graduate with honors.

I do not remember that man's name. I hope I have not misrepresented details of the story, since the last time I heard it was 30 years ago. However, the impact of the story has never left me. It taught me the same thing Jesus taught those who witnessed him healing the daughter of Jarius; anything is possible with God. As Everyday Stewards, we are always looking for the small actions that make big differences. God takes what we offer in a simple action and performs miracles. The words of Jesus to Jarius should be in our minds everyday as we go forth into a chaotic world where things are unsure: "Do not be afraid; just have faith."

### **Idea for response**

Take a risk and finally reach out to that person you have been afraid to contact for what ever reason. Do not be afraid; just have faith!

### **Take time to reflect**

What are three things in my life that God is calling me to let go of and just have faith?
