## while we're at it

August 26, 2018

Dear Friends,

The Church is very much in the news these days but for very sad reasons. Whenever we see reports of abuse of minors by priests, or misconduct by bishops, or coverups of scandals, we know that evil has entered into the hearts of some who Jesus has entrusted with the care of his flock. We feel outraged and betrayed by those we should be able to trust. It can lead people to question their faith.

Pope Francis addressed the crisis in a letter to all the Church this week and reminded us of what the Scripture says, "if one member suffers, we all suffer with him" (I Cor. 12: 26) because we are all members of the Body of Christ, the Church and we are all in this together. The sufferings of the victims require us all walk with them and accompany them in their suffering and make sure it never happens again.

We should all speak up and demand justice for the perpetrators, no matter who they are or how high up. And we should demand care and healing for the victims wherever they are. Hopefully that will be happening; it seems the momentum is moving decisively in that direction.

Maybe it's not fashionable to speak of the devil anymore. But he is real. He attacks and tempts us all but most especially those in leadership, in order to scatter the sheep and destroy souls.

This is a spiritual battle with the forces of the evil one, Satan.

The Pope also pleaded: "let us beg forgiveness for our sins and the sins of others". Here he touches on something every one of us can and should do: prayer and reparation.

Maybe we've lost some of the sense of the need to "repair" or "atone" for our sins and the sins of others. It goes to the heart of the mystery of forgiveness and redemption. We won't get out of this mess until we rediscover its importance and practice it again. It is the way to break the power of the devil over us.

This is where the crisis gets personal: each one of us, as members of the Church, need to do prayer and sacrifice for those who have sinned and those who have been victims. We need to do it so that the Lord will purify the Church. In our modern world, we don't much like sacrifice and reparation, but it's time we embrace it again.

May I suggest we return to the healthy practice of acts of reparation? These include our voluntary sacrifices, fasting, adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, the rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Pray to the Blessed Mother. Take on one thing each day and offer it for our Church.

Join in the rosary at Church. Take an hour of Adoration. Do the Chaplet at home. Skip a meal or two one day each week.

Through our prayer and sacrifice, God unleashes his healing power on his people.



## you are never alone

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. —Acts 2:1-4

My oldest son was having a tougher time than expected in his first year of college. In high school he expected to get As and be one of the smarter kids in the class. Now, he was at a school where everyone came from a similar experience in high school, and he found himself pretty darn average. His mother and I urged him early on to seek some help from a tutor. He gasped. When he was in high school, he WAS the tutor. After some reflection he said, "I just like to do things on my own."

So often many of us are like that. We find it hard to accept help. We think maybe it says something about our lack of capability or skill to reach out for help. When help is offered to us, we can quickly respond, "No thanks, I'm fine." It is amazing how sometimes we are anything but fine.

Living a stewardship way of life as a committed disciple of Jesus is not easy. In fact, we are guaranteed to fail. That inevitable failure is called sin. Grace makes it possible for us to continue on the journey. On that first Pentecost, the first followers of Jesus received the Holy Spirit who would guide them. For over 2000 years, that same Spirit moves in us and guides us. Help for the journey is always available. Sin and temptation constantly seeks to impede our steps. But through the gifts of this Spirit we can discern and make wise judgments, lessening the toll life can exact on us. Reach out and take the hand of God, allow His Spirit to lead you and guide you. Don't look back after making the journey harder than it needed to be and say, "I just liked doing things on my own." You are never alone.

#### Idea for response

Ask someone to be your prayer partner and talk with that person once a week to discuss how your prayer lives have been that week.

Sports Camp at St Lawrence is in full swing! We were off to a phenomenal start this past week. We offered basketball and soccer. The kids are truly enjoying themselves. It is easily noticed in the huge smiles we see on all of the faces when they arrive each morning, and then again, when leave us in the afternoon.



Basketball Camp this past week has had a total of 36 campers along with 11 teen volunteers. We are expecting over 25 more basketball campers next week. Each day starts out with a warm up type activity while the participants are arriving, and that leads into basketball skills and drills. Following the skills section is a prayer piece and a snack. The campers then participate in a hands-

on, basketball themed, arts and crafts project transitioning into a brief basketball related video. The basketball morning ends with a game of basketball.

It has been rewarding to watch all of the children improve their skills, learn from their peers and interact with each other. It's endearing to witness the children open up their hearts and minds to the idea that Jesus is ever present, and enables them with the strength and ability to play sports.

Every day, during the prayer piece, the children are read aloud a scripture verse to meditate on. They are given a few minutes to reflect, and to listen to Jesus, to find out

what it is He is saying to them. They are offered the opportunity to share with everyone the message they received from Jesus for the day. The verses were chosen in an effort to show the children how Jesus talks to us through the bible about everything. Jesus can even help us to become better athletes if we ask, trust and have faith in what we can do through Him.

On Day 1, we read 2 Timothy 4:7-"I have done my best, have run the full distance, and I have kept the faith." Day 2, we read Philippians 4:13-"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." On Day 3, we read Hebrews 12:1-"Let us rid ourselves of everything that gets in the way, and let us run with determination the race that lies before us fixing our eyes on Jesus." Day 4, one of my personal favorites, we read Matthew 5:41-"If anyone forces you to go one mile, go two with Him." On Day 5, we finished the week meditating on 1 Corinthians 9:25-"Run for the prize that will last forever."

Once again, it has been a true pleasure for me to spend the week with all of the children. I am always so grateful to the parents and families for their generosity in sharing their children with us. I feel so blessed to be able to enjoy my time with each and every one of them!
