Dear Friends,

We're blessed here to have so many good programs running for our two parishes every semester and there is something practically every day of the week. Some have already gotten underway but this week more start up:

Monday evenings is **Women's GIFT** (Growing in faith together), a small group experience that will focus on the role of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

Tuesday evenings features the popular *Walking to Eternity* that takes a scriptural approach to how to overcome obstacles that hold us back in our relationship with Christ.

Starting this Wednesday, in sessions in the morning or evening, we are offering the *Alpha Course* for anyone who has questions about faith and life, about God and how we can believe. Connect with others over a meal and rediscover what faith is all about. Bring anyone—if your faith life is stuck and needs a jumpstart, or if you are struggling to believe, *Alpha* is just perfect.

How long has it been since you and your spouse spent some time together totally focused on the quality of your relationship? The *Alpha Marriage Course* runs the next seven Wednesday evenings and gives you and your spouse time to enjoy a meal, reflect on what makes your marriage work, and renew your communication and your love. We babysit the kids while you spend time with each other. Treat yourselves to a better marriage.

Go to **stlawrenceotoole.org** and sign up for the program that will most help you grow as a Catholic. You'll be really glad you did.

We all feel a need to do something on a parish level about the scandals we are suffering with. True reparation has deep scriptural roots and a long tradition in the Church and always involves prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Prayer: Every First Friday for a year, starting this week, we will have a Mass of Reparation for the sins of the sex abuse scandal. We'll offer Confessions at 6:00, Mass at 7:00, and a half hour of Adoration after Mass with Benediction and the Litany of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Fasting: We recommend one of the following practices. **A**. Bread and water fast on Fridays; **B**. Skip a full meal each Friday, as we do during Lent. **C**. Go meatless each Friday, like we used to do in the old days in the Church.

Almsgiving: A sacrifice of our money and detachment is good for the forgiveness of sins. We'll be focusing on two projects for the poor: our **Brewster Emergency Homeless Shelter** that helps up to 15 local homeless each night in winter, and the **Haiti Project**, which is looking for \$6000 to build a home for a destitute family in that country. We'll have envelopes in the Church you can drop in the collection, or give on the website of the parish.







God's gift of leisure

Remember the sabbath day—keep it holy. Six days you may labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a sabbath of the Lord your God. You shall not do any work, either you, your son or your daughter, your male or female slave, your work animal, or the resident alien within your gates. For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them; but on the seventh day he rested. That is why the Lord has blessed the sabbath day and made it holy. —Exodus 20:8-11

When the fall months come they bring with them increased opportunities for relaxation and recreation.

However, our fast moving world would often seek to deny a those gifts of time and space. We can find ourselves in a place where the desire for leisure is seen as a sign of laziness or lack of commitment. But was it not God who gave us the model of rest by refraining from activity on the seventh day of creation? And if all we have comes from God, by not taking th time for leisure do we not disregard this essential gift?

When we take time to include "inactivity" into our daily life and into our year, we acknowledge that we are not th sum of our career, job, schoolwork, or teen parenting. We have been given more by God and sometimes the only way to experience the richness of those gifts is to take a break from that which we normally do. The German Catholic philosopher, Josef Pieper, spent much of his time writing about these very issues. In his book, Leisure: The Basis of Culture, he wrote about the dangers of becoming consumed by work. He wrote, "Of course the world of work begins to become-threatens to become- our only world, to th exclusion of all else. The demands of the working world grow ever more total, grasping ever more completely th whole of human existence."

Whether it is during fall or another time of the year, let us be good stewards by taking time to rest in the Lord. At times the fields must lie fallow to be watered by the rain and nourished by the sun. This will provide time to the sower to decide the best crops to plant and seeds to sow. Then his harvest, when it arrives, will be that much fuller.

Idea for response

Take a day off from work or a Saturday and give yourself permission to do nothing. Take time to rest in God.


