# while we're at it

**our vision** Create a parish of missionary disciples whose personal relationship with Jesus Christ inspires others into a life-changing relationship with Him.

Dear Friends,

Last week we heard the familiar Gospel of the Rich Young Man, someone who was blessed with material goods and who also happened to be a good person. Many people perhaps think that is all there is to life, all we should aspire to.

But he had something in his heart telling him there is more to life than that. It was something the Holy Spirit put there, a hunger for something more. That's what led him to ask Jesus, "**What more must I do to be saved?**"

Isn't that the same question all of us need to be asking? It's easy for us to get into a decent routine, to be a good person, to not hurt anyone deliberately. But if we avoid asking ourselves and God the deeper questions, something is missing in our lives. Questions about what is it all for, or why I'm here, or what my legacy will be.

*These are the questions about meaning, about the purpose of it all.*

As Catholics we know that we are here for something that is ultimately beyond this world. "**God made me to know Him, to love Him, and to serve Him in this life, and be happy with him forever in the next.**" The old catechism answer was right on the spot.

**What more must I do to be saved?** When we pray on that sincerely and with an open heart, God starts speaking to us deep down in our soul. And he tells us to put our security in him and not in accumulating money or stuff. He tells us to make sure we have what we need but to use everything to help us achieve the goal we are created for: eternal life.

And he tells us to be generous, to share, to live as if we are only passing through this life, to live lightly. To give, to be generous, to sacrifice. Getting stuff and worrying about security bog us down. Greed and avarice are deadly sins and generosity and temperance are virtues.

Are you free to go for the more important things in life, the things that last forever?

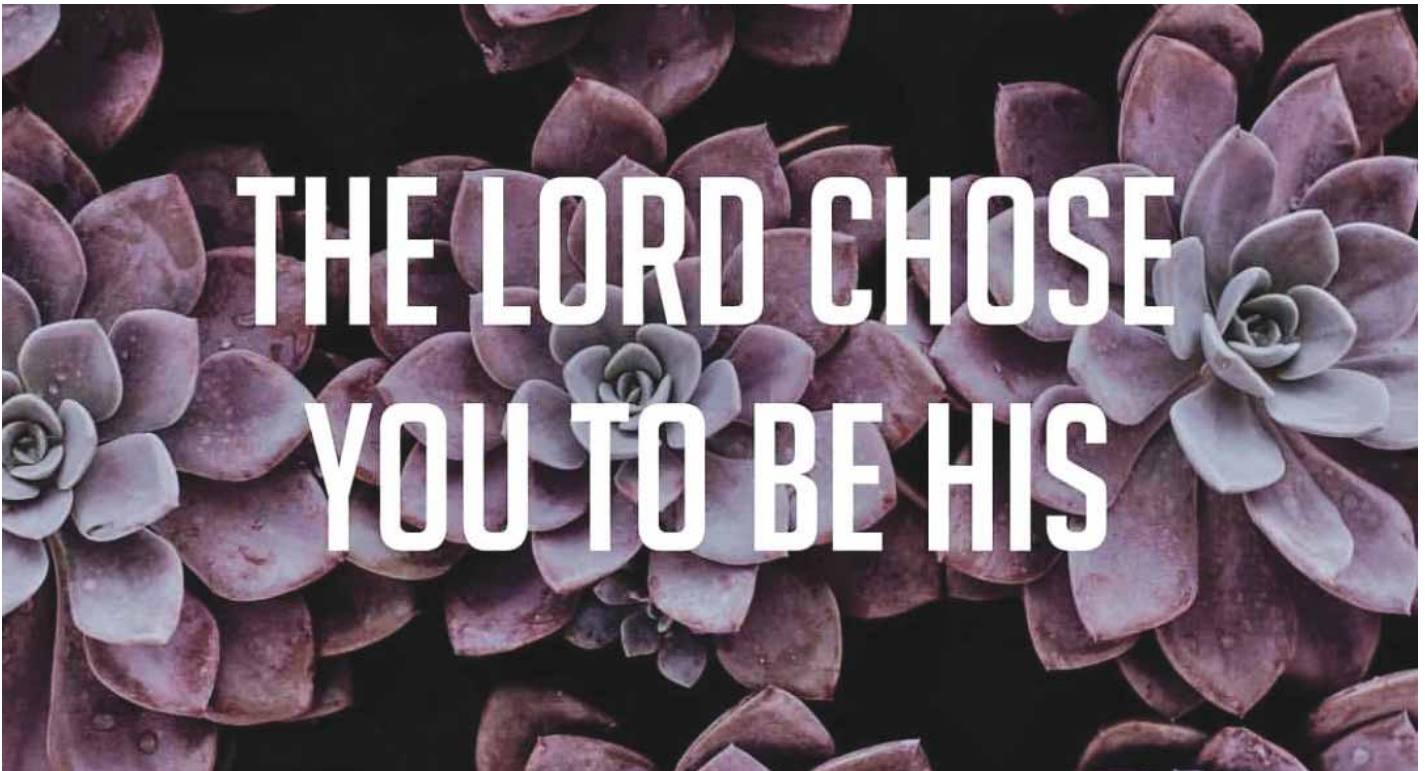

*It was not you who chose me, but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will remain, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name he may give you.*

—John 15:16

Do you remember being a child and deciding on captains to choose sides for a game of kickball, soccer or other sport requiring little more than a ball? Kids sat on a curb, waiting to hear their fate. “Surely, I will not be picked last,” each boy or girl thought. But alas, someone always had to be last. The worst part was it often came down to one kid who thought he was not too horrible, and one kid who knew he was horrible. Guess who was picked first, assuring that the sole survivor of this ritual was left to question why he or she even left the house that day? Good times!

Most of the time, to be chosen can make a person feel wanted or needed. You realize that someone else sees

something in you that they respect and value. You become a part of something bigger than yourself, a community, even if it is a community of two, such as in a marriage.

# giving hope on a cold winter night

brewster emergency shelter partnership  
kick off luncheon 10/14

**Brewster Emergency Shelter Partnership (BESP)** is the ONLY homeless shelter in Putnam County. It is a partnership of St. Lawrence O'Toole Church, NOW United Methodist Churches, St Andrew's Episcopal and First Baptist Church as the sleep sites, further supported by Trinity Lutheran Church, The Mission Church in Holmes, Temple Beth Elohim, and Mt.Carmel Baptist Church who provide volunteers, storage space, meals and more. It is a partnership of area churches that relies upon the generosity of its people to provide for the basic needs of God's vulnerable people.

The non-profit was started because a homeless man froze to death in the woods 11 years ago. BESP receives no government funding and is supported solely by private donations. It is staffed by volunteers with only one paid position, that of overnight supervisor, whose role is to ensure the safety of all the volunteers and guests. The shelter operates during the cold winter months, from December through March. Several churches in Putnam and part of upper Westchester assist in providing food and funds toward the shelter.

Guests gather at a designated meeting place each night and arrive at the host church at 9:00 pm. There they are served a hot meal, offered the use of shower facilities in only two of the 4 host churches in the village of Brewster, and it's lights out by 10 pm. Guests are then awakened at 5:15 am and given a light breakfast and sometimes a bag lunch to go. They must vacate the space by 6:00 am.

With God's help, this year's goal is to extend the season into April, when the nights are still quite cold. It would be a blessing to be able to extend the hours of operation also.
