# while we're at it

**our vision** Create a parish of missionary disciples whose personal relationship with Jesus Christ inspires others into a life-changing relationship with Him.

Dear Friends,

One detail of this week's Gospel about Bartimeus the blind beggar healed by Jesus always stood out to me. St. Luke tells how he used to beg by the side of the road every day, but this one day he heard the sound of a crowd and Jesus passing by, and seized the opportunity to cry out, "Jesus, Son of David, have pity on me". And so it happened – Jesus cured him of his blindness.

But the detail that fascinates me is that when Jesus called him to come forward, Bartimeus "threw aside his cloak". Why would he do that? And why did that make it into the Gospel text? Maybe it is an insignificant detail but why would a blind man not cling to his cloak, and all his possessions for that matter? He let go of what he had, he dropped the things that gave him a little security. He left his few things behind him. He was freed of clinging to his few things. And he went to Christ full of trust and confidence that Jesus, and Jesus alone, was the answer. That only Jesus could provide him security and healing. And no amount of possessions could ever give him what he truly needed: to see again.

**Only Jesus could make the light of God shine on him and give him a new life.  
Only Jesus can make us see.**

For me it has always made me wonder about how much we cling to the things that cannot answer to our deepest needs. We need to run to the light, but not be burdened by dragging along the things that do nothing for us... we need to let go of what holds us back.

Maybe that is the case for you too. Too much worry and preoccupation about money and things? Is it all causing anxiety and tension in your life? Do you have an intuition that all of those concerns are leading you nowhere?

We all need to let go. "Give, and it shall be given back to you a hundred fold", says Jesus. Do we trust in the Lord enough to let go and be generous with him?

## nourishment for the job ahead

*I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and everyone that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit. You are already pruned because of the word that I spoke to you. Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me will be thrown out like a branch and wither; people will gather them and throw them into a fire and they will be burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you.” —John 15:1-7*

I remember one woman I had the privilege of working with in RCIA, who ultimately decided to become Catholic because of the Eucharist. She had experiences in other denominations that held celebrations of holy Communion, but they did not see the Eucharist as the real presence of Jesus Christ. When she realized what the bread and wine truly became in the Mass, she stated that she could not truly be who she wanted and needed to be without weekly participation in Mass and reception of Eucharist. After she

became Catholic, she soon became a daily communicant for this very same reason.

In *THE LIFE OF A CHRISTIAN STEWARD: A REFLECTION ON THE LOGIC OF COMMITMENT*, published by the International Catholic Stewardship Council, one reads, “To be most effective in service to God and humankind, Christian stewardship must stem from the liturgical worship in the Church. Here one finds the supernatural motive, the word of faith, and the grace necessary to get the job done.” Then the document quotes John 15, with Jesus teaching, “I am the vine, and you are the branches.” The reality is that without nourishment from the vine, Jesus, the branches, you and I, cannot bear fruit and will wither and die.

Recommit yourself to the Eucharist. Come to church in time to calm your heart and mind. Be attentive and participate. Be mindful of your actions, your senses, and your intentions. Approach the Eucharist reflecting on the reality that you are encountering and consuming the actual risen Lord. Do not let moments in Mass pass you by without reflection. Then, you will find the nourishment needed to bring the Good News of Easter to the world. You will be equipped to “get the job done.”

### **Idea for response**

Take a tour of a local winery or vineyard and listen to how wine is made. Take note of the value of good vines in producing good grapes.

Many students will assist the Sunday morning *KidZone* group at Mass, while others will visit with the elderly at Putnam Ridge, help clean up an elderly persons lawn, collect and organize food collection for Putnam Community Action Partnership (CAP), or say prayers for those in need at a prayer service. They are also deep into their study of the Bible time line working their way through Genesis and Exodus.
