

Dear Friends,

It's an annual ritual for us all to complain about how Christmas has gotten so commercialized. Of course it has. We lament it even as we get caught up in it. What a battle it is not to be dragged along by the tow of material things.

Lately, the economic news is consumed with reporting on "consumer confidence" as a key driver of the national economy. Which means if people feel optimistic and comfortable, they spend more on stuff, fueling stronger earnings for corporations. "And key economic indicators for the holiday season now show that…". And so on.

When I pray over the meaning of Christmas, I'm always struck by something Pope Paul VI said once about Nazareth. He said it was a school for us all to learn simplicity and poverty. Everything was silent and he went practically unnoticed. Jesus didn't really need much when he came into the world – just a stable and a manger, and the love of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph. The whole atmosphere was simple and poor with no amenities, but they got by with what was truly essential: the love of Jesus, and the promise of the salvation he would bring.

Maybe as we gather with family and friends, we can put things in perspective. The fancy new gadgets we give and get, the new clothes, the festive, well-prepared meals, the traveling and visits and the decorations are good and necessary things, but they distract us.

What is essential for us this Christmas? We should spend some quiet time on that one.

I hope it is the promise of a new life brought about by the coming of Jesus into our world. I hope it is our faith that his coming demonstrates the love of our God, and makes it possible for us to love others as he does.

And this is the verdict, that the light came into the world, but people preferred darkness to light, because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come toward the light, so that his works might not be exposed. But whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be clearly seen as done in God. - John 3:19-21

My pastor collects old paschal candles. They never stand as profoundly as they did when first brought out at Easter. However, the burnt wicks and melted wax represents the many lives made new in baptism, the faithful who have passed into the next life, and the glory and grandeur of another Easter Vigil and Easter season.

When entering a room with much history, we often reflect, "If only these walls could talk." What if a paschal candle

could speak? It would tell us of each life that was filled with darkness until the light of Christ entered into them. It would tell us of infants who received the promise of eternal life through their parents' faith and testimony. We would hear of adults who once were lost and wandering and how now they were found. It would share with us the stories of pain and suffering that ended in the loving arms of Jesus Christ at death. It would tell us all these things, and would remind us that it existed to attest to the truth of the Light, that through that Light all things might be seen more clearly.

Do you have your baptismal candle close by? It has shared a flame with one of these paschal candles. It attests to the truth that the Light still resides in you. Bring it out and light it once more. Use it to pray and reflect on your life. Ask the Lord to grow that Light inside you, that all around you may see it. By this Light you have been able to see more clearly. By the Light shining more brightly in you, others might be able to see more clearly as well.

In the Carpentry Hut, students participated in using tools like Joseph and Jesus did. They read and discussed John 6:35 "Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever




comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst."


