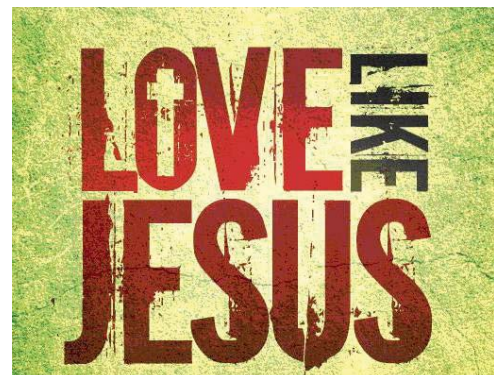

Dear Friends,

This week the Pope is gathered in Rome with representative bishops throughout the world to address the international crisis of sexual abuse in the Church. We need to hold them up in prayer, as this crisis has clearly weakened the Church.

We all have friends and loved ones who have walked away from the Church and are no longer even interested in a relationship with God. And they often say they can't trust the Church. We feel it in our own families. We are outraged yet feel helpless.

And yet the crisis goes far beyond the Church: it exists even more widely in public schools, in civic organizations like Boy Scouts and in workplaces. It ravages families and throughout the world.

Of all institutions, the Catholic Church has implemented the most thorough safeguards and systems of accountability – other organizations are following our lead. Much more needs to be done. Keep in perspective that the news we hear is overwhelmingly about abuses that happened several decades ago. New cases of abuse have been reduced to a trickle, as bishops over the past 17 years have instituted a zero tolerance policy and offenders have been removed.

But the media gleefully reports on any failing of a priest or bishop because their strategy is to discredit the Church and cripple it. They zero in on the Catholic Church as their number one target.

We can gripe about the injustice and the bias of the media, but it is not going away. Christ is asking us to do something much deeper and spiritual. Our response has to be more than anger at anti-Catholic bias.

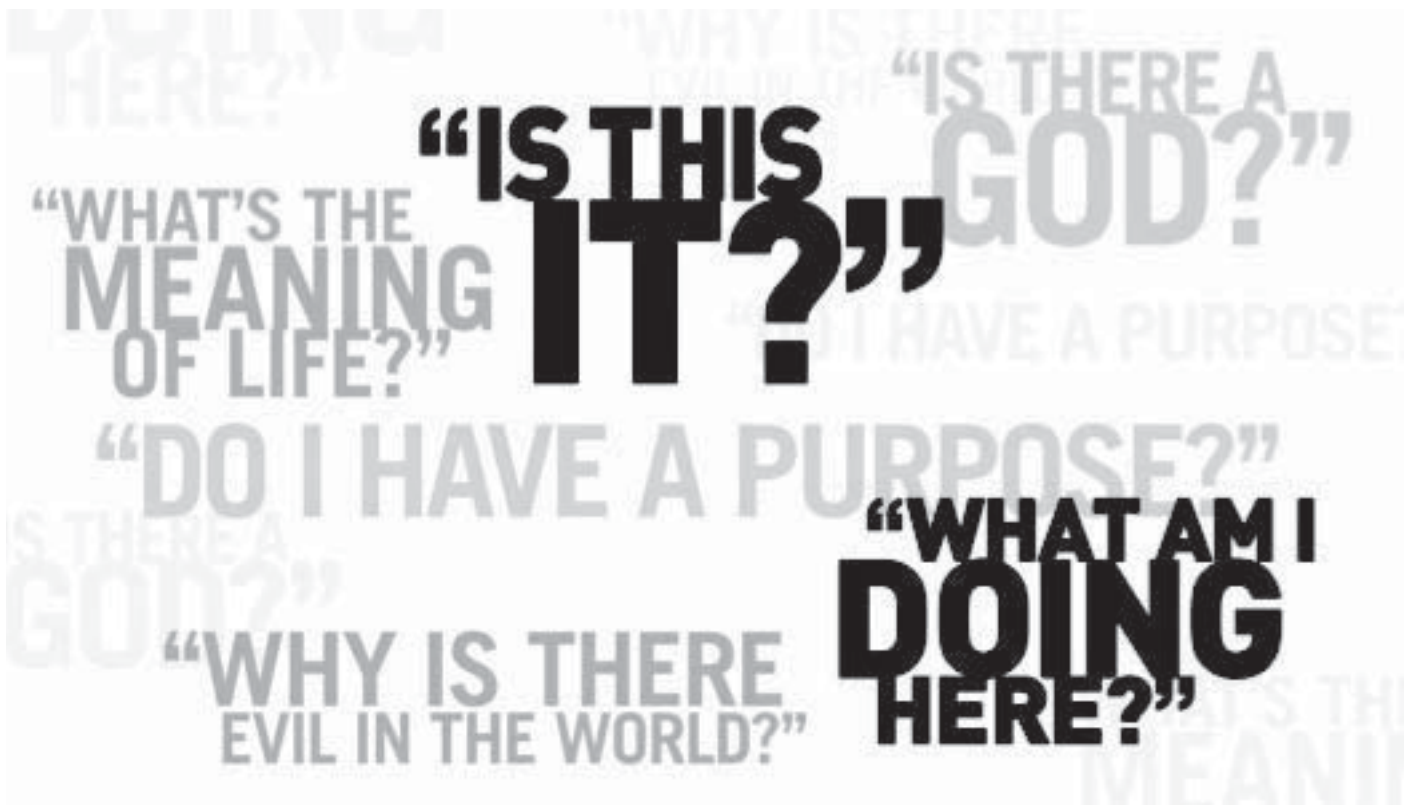
The first thing to do – every one of us – is to **live our personal lives with absolute fidelity to the Gospel**. “Make no provision for the flesh...” says St. Paul. Live the Gospel without compromise in our own lives: charity, honesty, purity, perseverance, fidelity, integrity of life. Go to Confession when we fall and renew ourselves with the grace of God. Make the Eucharist as the center of our lives. Pray every single day. Do not allow any sin to take root in your life – fight it and do not give up. Follow Christ's teachings totally.

And next – and this too is every one of us – **do reparation for our sins and the sins of others** through prayer and sacrifice. Jesus said certain demons can be expelled only by prayer and sacrifice. Give up something. Deny yourself some pleasure or indulgence. Give to the poor, bear sufferings with patience for those who can't or won't. Serve others at the cost of your comfort and convenience.

On Friday, March 1 we have our next **Mass of Reparation** for all the sins committed in this crisis. Join with other parishioners at 7:00 p.m. A period of Adoration and Benediction follows. And all the while, be confident because God will not abandon his Church, and “the gates of hell shall not prevail against it”. Christ has won the victory for us by his Cross and Resurrection.

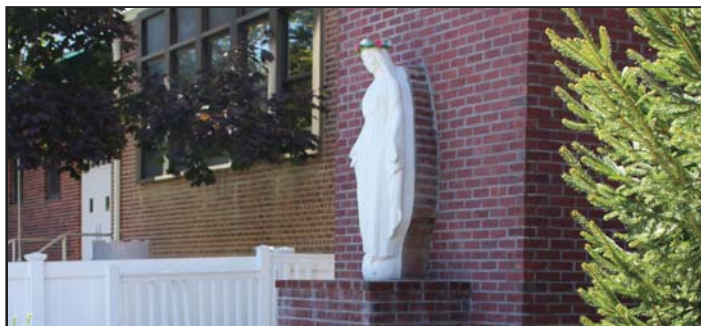

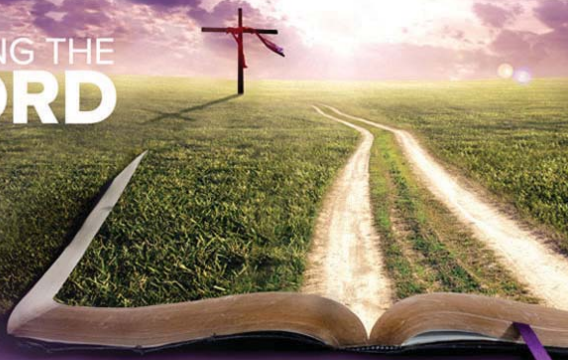
