why do we sing at mass?

Veronica Champa, Director of Music

If you are like me when I was younger, I deliberately did not sing during the Mass because I had no idea what its role was or its purpose. “Why can’t we just listen to the choir?” “No one wants to hear my voice.” “No one around me is singing and I don’t want to stand out.” I’m sure, for many of you, these thoughts have come across your mind at least once while you were attending Mass. You may not realize how important it is that we sing during the Mass. Each and every one of us.

Many of you may have heard St. Augustine’s quote, “Singing is praying twice.” That is actually a misquotation of what St. Augustine said. His true words were, “Singing is for one who loves.” Music is a sign of God’s love for us and of our love for Him. If you think about the early civilizations, tribes, societies, you will learn that music, singing, chanting played an important role in rituals, ceremonies, and while working. My heart sinks when someone tells me they cannot sing. It is quite literally in our evolutionary history that we can all sing. No, that does not mean we are all able to sing like an operatic soprano or like the famous pop singers of today. It simply means we are able to use our voice in a different way than speaking.

Just imagine: You are at Christmas Mass and the opening song is announced, everybody stands and sings. Not just sings, but sings with purpose, with joy, with excitement. No one really cares about the quality of their own voice because everyone around them is singing loud enough that they would not be able to hear themselves if they joined in anyway. That happened this Christmas right here at St. Lawrence. It made my heart so happy to finally hear the congregation sing with such joy and excitement. That should be every week! That can be every week!

The songs selected each week, if you have noticed, are a reflection of the readings. These carefully chosen songs are meant for you to reflect on the messages we are given every Sunday. It does not matter whether or not you are a good singer or a bad singer, or whether or not you know the song. You are all invited to sing at each Mass. For the sole purpose of worshipping our God, praise him with the voice He gave you. He wants to hear you (and so do !!).

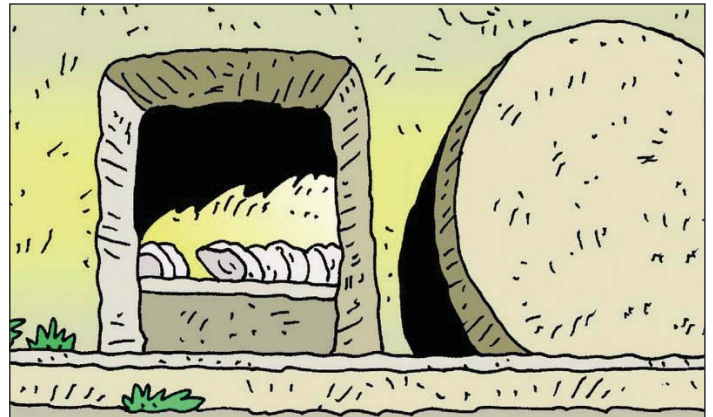

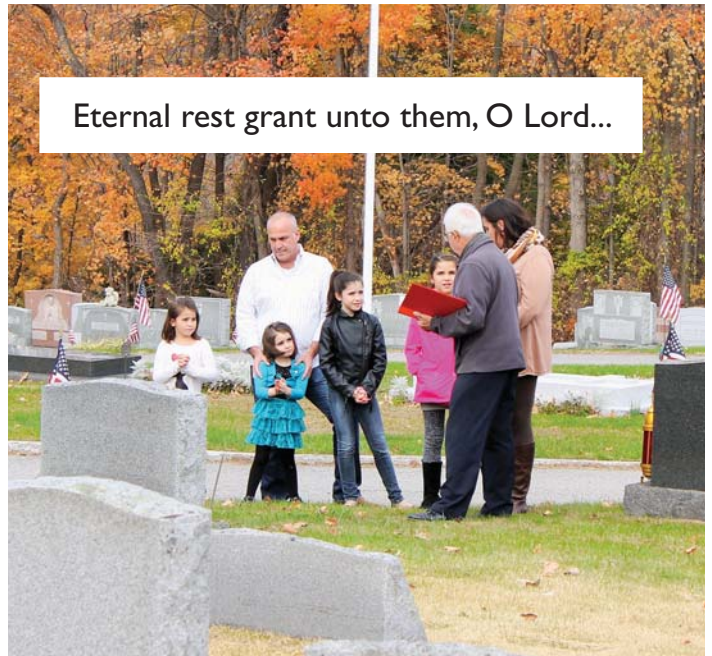
