our vision Create a parish of missionary disciples whose personal relationship with Jesus Christ inspires others into a life-changing relationship with Him.

Dear Friends,

The crisis of sexual abuse in the Church has been with us for some time and will continue, as lawsuits and compensation work through the system. It is a painful time for us all but necessary to purify the Church and work toward healing for the victims.

Last week Cardinal Dolan published a report the names of all Archdiocesan priests who ever had a credible accusation of sexual abuse of a minor against them. It was hard to read a list of brother priests who had done such terrible things. Our response is to continue our prayer for the victims and reparation for the sins of the perpetrators.

Without minimizing the gravity of the scandals, the report does show progress in addressing the issues. Since the Church put in strict standards in the year 2002, there have been only two new cases reported. The overwhelming majority of the cases date from the 1970's into the early 1980's. Most of the priest perpetrators were ordained in the 1950's and 1960's and none are in ministry any longer. Two-thirds of them are deceased. It is also important to note that in about half the cases, the Archdiocese made a settlement with the victim in spite of the fact the priest accused was deceased, and unable to respond to the accusation against him.

I mention these facts only to indicate that progress is being made and hopefully one day this will be a thing of the past. Decades ago these things were not handled properly but today we have a greater awareness of how serious a problem it is and how wounded the victims are. Standards for entering the priesthood are stricter, with psychological testing the norm, and a zero tolerance policy firmly in place. No known abuser is in ministry.

We all need to grow in holiness, obedience to God's commandments and fidelity to our commitments in order to overcome this evil.

At St. Lawrence we pray for victims and abusers and for our Church every First Friday at 7 pm at a special **Mass of Reparation**. It is the most important thing we do: to beg God to have mercy on us all. Join us.

I was born and raised in Paraguay. I migrated to the United States 15 years ago and have lived in New York ever since. I come from a traditional catholic family and grew up going to church. I remember experiencing the presence of Jesus as a child and as a teenager. However, a few years after coming to the USA, I lost my faith. Thinking that self-sufficiency alone was all I needed to be successful and to advance in my career.

I just left my former 'dream job,' as campus manager with a very successful student program at the City University of New York. After twelve years of pursuing and actualizing that dream, I am saying goodbye to my university, with a cheerful heart.

Recently, my family and I moved to Brewster, while we all wondered why we were here in this very very quiet, and green neighborhood. But in our hearts, we knew that it was all part of God's plan. The very day we moved to Brewster, I met Father Gill. I asked for a priest to come bless our new home. Then, a few weeks later I took my kids to the Family Program.

As the new **Director for Evangelization and Family Program**, my job will be to serve you and your family. I am starting by sharing my story with you and inviting you to take courage. Take courage in the fact that Jesus is Love. He is Love incarnate and there is nothing He cannot make anew.

It is true that I have plenty of administrative experience, and well-developed skills to organize and mobilize people under a common vision. However, the reason I am here is not because I have skills, but because I have fallen in love with Jesus, I have encountered His Glory and now my heart's desire is to serve Him. why i chose to become catholic

When I was young my life was tumultuous. After my parents divorce I thought it was my fault and carried that into my teens. When I was thirteen my oldest brother Angelo was killed in a car accident and I don't think I had a fear of death but I was more afraid to open myself and get close to people only to lose them. I think I shunned a relationship with Jesus as a result.

My brother was a chef and in the restaurant industry it is common to abuse alcohol and drugs, which Angelo did. I wasn't aware of that and idolized him. He worked in Boston until it got so bad that he came home to rehab. After finishing that he went to business school and was a year sober when the accident occurred. My best memory was when he was trying to teach me the rosary prayer and after his accident I questioned why God would take someone who had turned his life

around and I subconsciously wrote off religion. I abused drugs and alcohol and had one toxic relationship after another, never letting anyone close to me including family.

Then I met my wife and my life got so much better and harder. We had our first child out of wedlock and named him Angelo. We visited a justice of the peace to marry us and had two more children, and she asked to go to church. She finally took me and the children to Mass and I wish I had listened to her sooner. We attended the Alpha course and went to RCIA to finish our sacraments. I'm so glad we did and wish we had gone sooner. I no longer close myself off from people and finally accepted Jesus into my life and see the errors I made in the past.

I no longer feel like a cork bobbing in a turbulent ocean and have accepted my purpose and direction as a husband and father and follower of the Way. I understand I will not be here forever for my family but am happy knowing that we have been accepted in the church community and that when I'm gone they will have that. And it gives me peace knowing we will be together again in heaven.

Carolina, I grew up in a strong Southern Baptist community, where the presence of the Holy Spirit was evident. While never pressuring me to convert it is apparent now that Nick's spiritual journey supported by Father Gill, Deacons Mark with Greg, and numerous parishioners, exposed me to Catholicism.

When I moved to Brewster, I was determined to find a Baptist church where I felt that authentic intensity for the Lord I experienced back home in North Carolina. I attended a few services at some local Baptist churches. Though being very welcoming, there was something missing. It was during a Bible study at one of the churches where the debate of Jesus's true presence in Communion was raised. It was at that moment that the words of Christ in John 6:55 began to clarify for me— "For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed". I was immediately stuck; what was I doing here? I walked right out feeling numb and confused.

During that time, I was working as a home health aide taking care of elderly patients, and it seemed that every single one of my patients was Catholic! I was constantly asked my denomination and was provided with various readings on the Catholic faith. I was so naïve to see what God was doing. I fought it and rebelled. Soon after my husband and I got married we became pregnant and God urged me to study and know his word more, which pointed me to the Catholic Church. With the baptism of our son, his enrollment in the Early Childhood Learning Center, and my attendance at Mass, I was convinced and excited to become Catholic this past Easter vigil.

If you still your mind and listen to His will, you can serve Him, others, and yourself through his work on you. I want to express my sincerest appreciations to Father Gill, Deacon Mark, and all the parishioners of Saint Lawrence O'Toole for welcoming me into the faith.

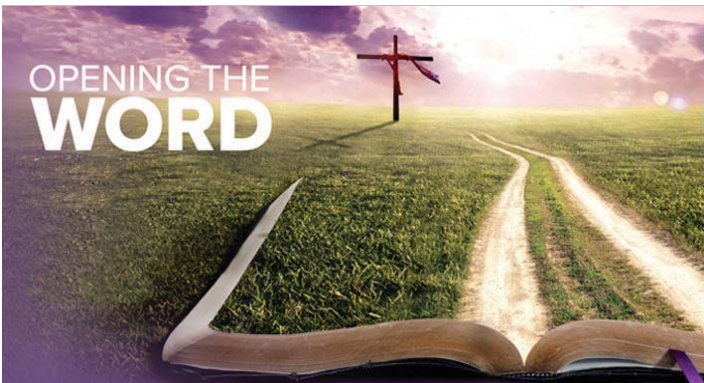
