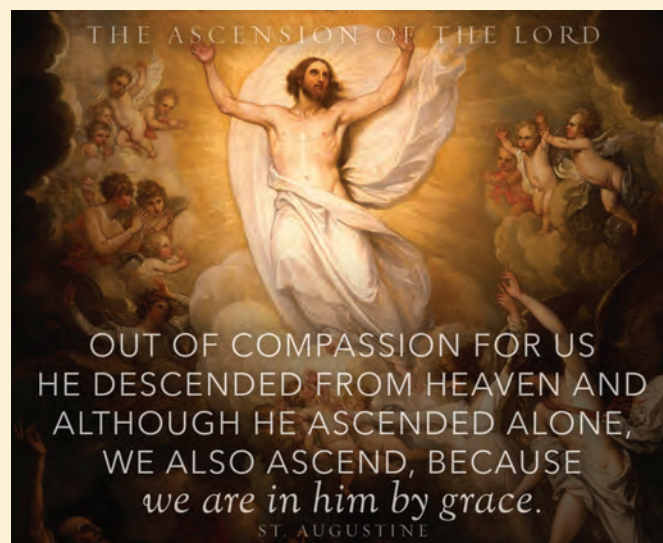

Dear Friends,

A little bit of financial business this week, folks:

1. Thank you once again to everyone using the Gold Centennial envelopes to support our renovation debt reduction. We just made a large payment \$125,000 against the principal on the loan, reducing our debt to \$930,000.

The overall cost of the Church renovation in 2015 was nearly \$4 million. That means we have paid down more than 75% of the principal in just five years. We're also paying 5% interest on that loan, so it's a good idea to pay it down as fast as we reasonably can. Our goal is to pay it all off by the year 2024 – five years from now.

I am so grateful for everyone participating in this campaign that has renewed our beautiful parish.

If you haven't yet started making a monthly gift to the Centennial fund by using the Gold envelopes you receive each month, or by *WeShare* at stlawrenceotoole.churchgiving.com, I encourage you to do so. A gift of \$50 or \$25 each month in addition to your weekly contribution allows us to reduce our renovation debt faster.

And remember, every dollar given to the Centennial goes directly to that fund with no taxes or assessments by the Archdiocese. It's a great way to give.

2. We've also reached about 73% of our goal of \$64,500 at St. Lawrence for the Cardinal's Appeal this year – this is the fund that allows the Cardinal to fund works of charity, like assistance to poorer parishes. Please if you can, make a pledge. We can all be proud that every single year for seven years running we have made our goal – doing our part to help our brothers and sisters in the faith.

3. In the Fall, we'll do our annual Stewardship Campaign, inviting everyone to reflect on their weekly giving to the parish. The past two years we have had good success in inviting parishioners to consider giving a percentage of their income back to God on a regular basis. This is the concept of tithing – that we give the "first fruits" back to God and in prayerful dependence on his providence, we live on the rest which He has provided.

4. Our historic St. Lawrence Cemetery on Turk Hill Road has reached the venerable age of 150 years... it is actually older than the parish, and dates from the time when the only church in the area was St. Joseph's, then in Croton Falls. St. Lawrence Parish would be established in 1878. Currently we are on a beautification campaign for the cemetery, adding new sections for in-ground burials. Last year we installed a Columbarium (for interment of cremated remains) with 144 niches. We are considering installing above ground mausoleum structures as well, if there is enough interest in that kind of burial arrangement.

It is a beautiful hillside cemetery and the perfect place for you and your family. I encourage you to plan ahead and make arrangements with our cemetery office and administrator, Eileen Stokes.
