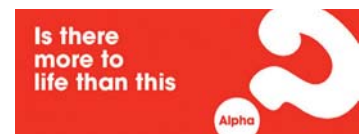

witnesses of Jesus

A Corpus Christi procession is when the eucharist is carried through the streets solemnly with singing. This procession of Corpus Christi gives a public witness of our faith and our devotion toward the blessed sacrament.

There are many passages in the history of the people of God where pilgrimages took place. We could mention the exodus of the Israelites, the Holy Family traveling to Jerusalem every year for the feast of Passover, or the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem on 'Palm Sunday.' Walking with Jesus along the streets of Brewster reminded me of the passage where Peter denied Jesus three times. Luke 22:54-62 Peter followed Jesus to the high priest's house while trying to not be noticed. Instead, at every step, he was recognized as a follower of Jesus. The first lady said to him "You are His follower," the second person said to Peter, "You were with Him, your accent gives you away". The third time someone else insisted, "You are certainly one of them, for you too are Galilean!" Everyone knew he was one of Jesus's disciples, for he had been seen with Him.

And for us, after Corpus Christi, are we going to be recognized as 'those who were seen with Jesus?' What a blessing it would be that our faces, our way of talking, our way of being would allow others to see in

us the love of Jesus! Can you imagine, if you walk into a store in the next few days and someone comes to you and says, "Were you one of those people walking with Jesus?" What would you say? Or, if you overheard a conversation where people are talking about the Saint Lawrence

procession through Main Street would you jump in and say, "I was one of them, we were walking with Jesus?"

For Peter, the rooster crowed and that was the signal that he had been given three chances to either accept being 'one of those who follow Jesus', or being 'one of those who don't follow Jesus.' For Peter a rooster gave him the signal he needed. What would our signal be?
