while we're at it

our vision Create a parish of missionary disciples whose personal relationship with Jesus Christ inspires others into a life-changing relationship with Him.

Dear Friends,

We're already well into another election cycle and it seems there is no end, no break from around-the-clock politics and the divisiveness that seems to come with it. Unfortunately we are a nation divided on the values we all once took for granted, and the debate about those values, which could be positive, is increasingly personal and vindictive.

Most of us feel vaguely uneasy about that and know it shouldn't be that way. We feel uprooted from what we knew to be true and reliable.

Can I suggest a simple, if partial, antidote? Silence and spiritual reading.

Create more space in our lives for reflection and silence. Unplug and turn off the cell phone and the laptop and the tablet and the TV. Go some hours daily without the radio or other sources of noise. Allow there to be some silence in your day... when you are alone with your thoughts. During that time, take up some spiritual reading: the best is Scripture.

Or it can be a good spiritual book. I think we would all be better people if each summer we were to read just one good spiritual book. How about taking that on?

Silence is a kind of cleansing for the soul. It flushes out the toxins of superficial things and allows us to begin to think again about things that matter and sort out those that really don't. It grounds us and enables us to think more clearly and objectively, with less emotion and passion and prejudice.



And most importantly, it allows us to hear the voice of God. He promised us the Holy Spirit who would teach us inwardly, who would lead us to understand the meaning of what Jesus said and did.

Without silence in our lives, we won't be able to hear the Holy Spirit. When we create silence we can hear his voice. And we discover anew his love and his faithfulness, and we know the way to go forward.

You'll find little by little you become a deeper person, that you see things as they are, from a more mature, profound perspective. You'll find that your opinions become more thoughtful and insightful and less reactive. You'll also become more grounded and more secure in your deepest spiritual and Catholic values.

Give it a try: some time for silence and spiritual reading. Drop in to the Adoration Chapel for some silence and reflection.

wisdom: god's vision for life

Over the years I have heard many people say that they go to Mass and they would like to read the Bible but it's all really just a conglomeration of old stories that have no practical application. The stories in the Old Testament took place thousands of years ago, before trains, planes and automobiles - how could those stories be relevant to anything going on today.

I have always understood the scriptures to be "the operating instructions for humans" given to us by God and we were to follow them to live fulfilling and meaningful lives. When we understand the instructions we are able to follow them. When we experience how well things work out when we do as we should, our faith grows and deepens. As our faith grows we are inclined to pattern our lives closer to God's plan for us.

Wisdom: God's Vision for Life teaches us how the lessons of the Bible, both Old and New Testament are as relevant to today's life as they were thousands of years ago. The class is divided into eight sessions, some of the topics include: Finances, Decision making, and Relationships. Each class is divided into a video presentation and a discussion of the readings from the past few days, all of which are focused on a particular relevant topic.

Thousands of years ago people wrestled with the same issues of morality, financial debt and family issues that we still do today and the answers found in scripture are practical and easily applied in our daily lives.

As the famous American writer Mark Twain once said "history doesn't repeat itself but it does rhyme". The scriptures are as relevant today as they were thousands of years ago, in many cases more so and Wisdom: God's Vision for Life is a great way to remind ourselves of that truth.
