

Dear Friends.

There are so many times I see how families love and care for their ill mothers, fathers, and spouses that I am always humbled. So often people provide such care during a long illness, putting aside their own priorities to serve and make the last weeks and days something beautiful and unifying... they go out of their way to make loved ones comfortable, making sure they have the best care, reminding them they are valued and loved and that they will be at their side faithfully to the very end.

A beautiful act of love and mercy is to make sure that as they get closer to the day they will meet the Lord, that they have access to the sacraments. Having the chance to get to Confession, receive Holy Communion, and the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick ensures that the mercy of God will cover them as they die. Be sure to pray with the dying and encourage them to ask for a priest. Be sure to call the Rectory to arrange for a priest. It is job number one for any priest and we never, ever mind assisting someone in dying well, in the grace of God.



A wake affords the opportunity for many friends and family to visit and it the perfect place for a Eulogy, or for people to share reminiscences and even casual shared stories about the deceased.

Everyone should have a proper funeral Mass, so that they return into the Church one last time and so the prayers of our parish community can be offered for them. The purpose of the funeral is to renew our firm hope in the resurrection of the dead and the mercy of God.

And we should always bury them in a Catholic cemetery, in sacred ground. By doing so, we all have a visible place to visit them and continue to pray for them so they are never forgotten. It is also a beautiful witness to our faith in the Resurrection of the dead on the last day.

Cremation is permitted by the Church, but in that case they should still have a funeral Mass just as if the full body were present. And we should keep in mind the cremains must be treated with the utmost respect and reverence. They should never be kept in the home or scattered around, and never divided up among relatives. All such things are disrespectful to the deceased. Cremated remains should always be buried, or interred in a Columbarium in a Catholic cemetery.

Catholics consider these end-of-life devotions very important for the living as well as the dead. By looking after the spiritual and material welfare of our loved ones, we leave a legacy of love and a solid witness of their dignity as children of God, who go back to the loving arms of Jesus, the just judge of the living and the dead.



Transformed is broken up into different aspects of our faith and once a week we watch a video and have small group discussions on such topics as spiritual, physical, mental, emotional, relational, financial and vocational health.

writing an icon

With a morning prayer before beginning the writing of an icon



and a blessing of hands by Sr. Christopher, our instructor, we began our five-day immersion into iconology. A group of 8, we set aside time to open ourselves to this experience.

Artistic competence was not required because an icon is constructed; step-by-step, layer-upon-layer, following prescribed stages. For example, one step was to apply a clay base for the halo onto our prepared wooden board,

burnish it with a stone, then blow our breath upon this substance; the moisture in our breath bound an application of 24k gold leaf to the clay.

Individual prayer intentions were set each day, either silently or aloud as we were drawn in and focused on the work at hand, each of us working with the same icon of the Archangel Michael; the traditional "first" for those just beginning to write icons. Intermittent music and silence enhanced the experience.

Theology, symbolism, and the history of icons were incorporated into the workshop and a number of books on the subject were made available. Sister also gave an interesting comparison of the acrylic method (which we used) vs. the egg tempera method of writing icons.

My sincere gratitude to Sr. Christopher for her guidance and inspiration and to the workshop group for a meaningful week of camaraderie.




