our vision Create a parish of missionary disciples whose personal relationship with Jesus Christ inspires others into a life-changing relationship with Him.

Dear Friends,

An old friend was lamenting the decline of religious practice. She warned her kids, "this country will be so messed up and it will be all yours". She pointed out she won't be around for the worst days and they will have to deal with it. We had a good laugh because her comment was more from frustration, but in any case, it's not a constructive approach.

She's too pessimistic, and needs a renewal of her hope. I tried reassuring her that the Holy Spirit never quits and he's just as powerful as ever if he finds willing partners like us to cooperate with his grace. That's our job – to continue to trust God's grace and power to change hearts even when trends don't seem to go our way.

A new study shows the increasing number of "unreligious" people (who nearly never attend church and don't affiliate with any church) at over 20% of the population now. There are large differences between this group and Catholics or Evangelical Christians. Statistically the unreligious tend to be a bit younger and are more frequently from broken or conflicted homes. They are much more likely to say marriage is "outdated" and approve of cohabitation and casual sexual relations. They are much more supportive of abortion, and have a much lower number of children than religious people. Notably, they are more than twice as likely as religious people to say that extramarital affairs are morally permissible.

We all have a sense of this from our personal experiences in our families, workplaces and neighborhoods. Unfortunately, the attitudes of the non-religious gradually influence the attitudes of religious people too.

Every society - if it will last - must pass on the inherited values that have made us what we are – one nation under God. It's what we all want for our children and grandchildren. Families and parishes share in this mission.

So many parents and grandparents do an excellent job. Despite the temptation to throw in the towel, they bring their kids to Mass, sign them up for religious education, encourage them to join our Lifeteen youth group. And most of all, they live it out at home, living by the Gospel and God's commandments.

We can't take our faith for granted – we need to renew it constantly, to live it daily, to grow in our prayer life and in our understanding of what God wants for us. What he wants is our happiness, a happiness based not on false gods or a misuse of our freedom, but a true happiness rooted in the truth.

"The truth will set you free." Don't grow tired in passing on the truth.

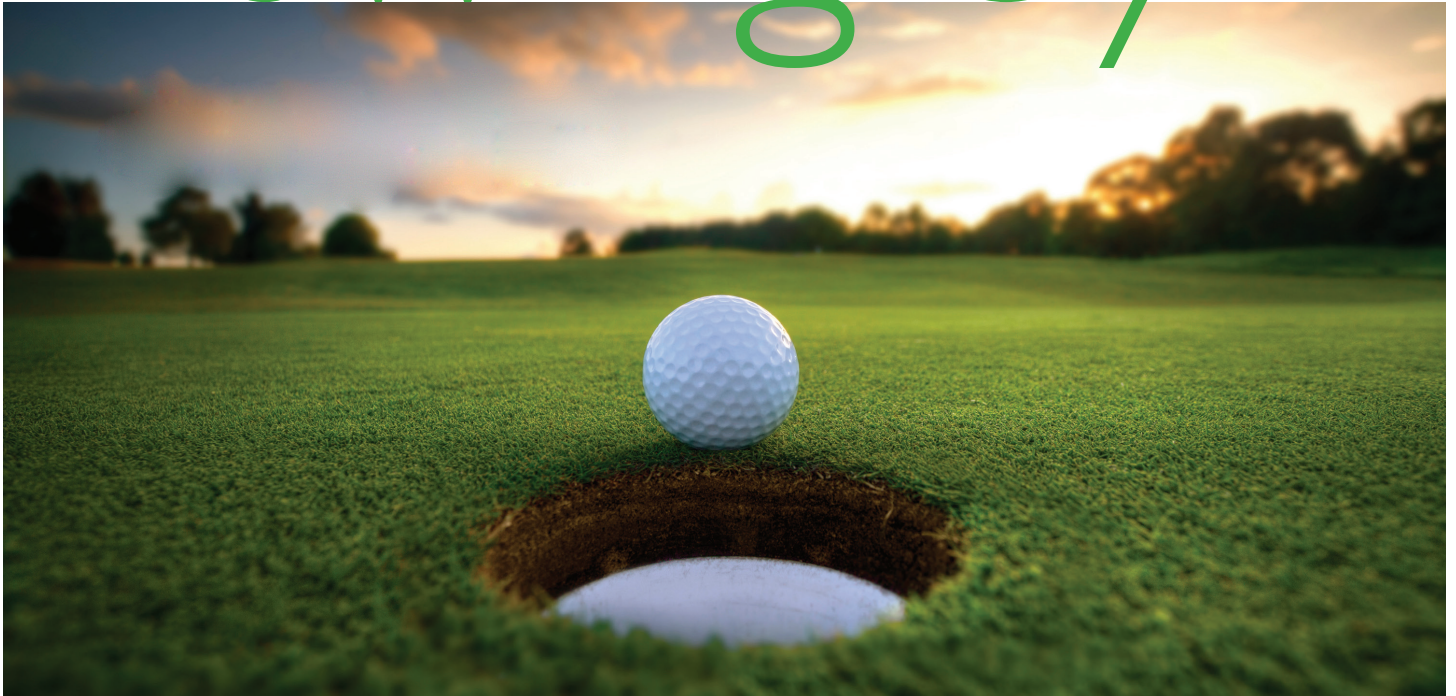

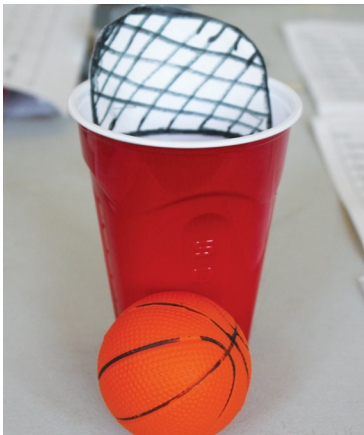

During the Hundred Years War, Joan led French troops against the English and recaptured the cities of Orléans and Troyes. Captured near Compiègne the following year, Joan was sold to the English and placed on trial for heresy and witchcraft. Burned at the stake as a heretic, Joan of Arc was beatified in 1909 and canonized in 1920. St. Joan of Arc is the patron saint of France and of Military Members. Special thanks to Lynda Holler for organizing the event, and the Knights of Columbus for helping set up and serve.

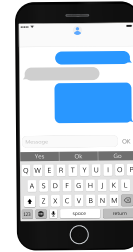

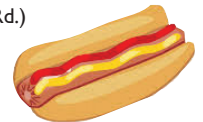
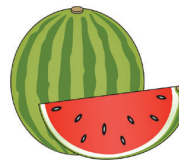
