Dear Friends,

As I'm writing this letter I'm preparing for another funeral, the kind that has become tragically routine. Whenever that phone call comes in to the parish office about a drug related death of a young person in the prime of life, we are heartbroken but not quite shocked anymore. There are several each year and the reports fill the newspapers. We're in danger of becoming numb to the epidemic.

One of my buddies in high school was a kid who had it all – brains and good looks and athletic too, the "most likely to succeed" type. But he washed out of college in a blur of drug abuse and could never hold a job and died young of complications. I never forgot that guy.

Studies are published and books are written on how and why the scourge of drug abuse and related crime has spread to practically every community in the nation – Brewster, Danbury, Carmel and Mahopac included. Experts search for answers and solutions but none seem to work.

For the family, it is often the climax of years of struggle to rescue him. Usually they have done everything they could, even heroically fighting for their loved one, but in the end they found themselves helpless before a force that stole their child from them.

I wonder what it is about our contemporary society that leaves so many people unhappy and unfulfilled that they seem to be without hope. While others flourish and succeed, others are left behind and dwell in despair, turning to artificial pleasures - searching somehow to fill a hole in their heart. What can we do to give hope and faith to people, to help them embrace life as good and as a gift from a loving God? Why is it that the Good News of Jesus – that a loving God has plans for our good and our happiness – does not catch on in so many hearts?


As a Church, we will mourn and grieve with the family, and entrust this soul to the mercy and love of the good God who created him. He loved the world so much that he sent his only Son, that the world would not perish... We trust in him to set things right in the Kingdom where he rules forever.

And we pray that our broken and confused world turn to him in our struggles and helplessness and call upon his Holy Name: "Come, Lord Jesus, come! Only you have the words of eternal life, and we have come to know and believe that you are the Holy One of God."






