guess what i learned today?

I was asked how I was able to get my son, Ralph, back to Church. I replied, "I have no idea." I know I prayed, talked with God, and lit candles to St. Joseph to intercede. I can remember saying certain things to him and his wife, Debbie, and I would see a glimpse of – I never thought about it that way - expression on their faces. 




