Dear Friends,

Monday night I returned from a wake at Beechers and noticed the parking lot at the Parish Center packed full of cars. So I took a walk through to see what was going on. I saw all the rooms filled up with different groups praying and the Parish Center alive and buzzing with activity.

There were middle school kids in the attic with Greg, our youth minister, doing their Edge Confirmation preparation. In the New York room, the Stephens Ministers, who offer one on one Christian accompaniment to those going through difficult life struggles, were having a review session. Spanish speaking parishioners were in the Parish Center chapel praying the rosary. Another group of women were doing the "Growing in Faith Together" program. In the gym - a CYO team doing drills for the upcoming season and in the dining hall, a session of the Family Program was just letting out.

Over in the Church was another group praying the rosary, and most importantly, people in the Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel on their knees before the Blessed Sacrament. There would be others coming all through the night...

I joined in with them to give thanks to the Lord for sending all these people who want to grow in their faith. I prayed for all of them. And then I headed back to the rectory to meet up with a couple preparing for the Sacrament of Matrimony.

Then the Holy Spirit put something on my heart – all that activity is thanks to the generosity and good stewardship of our parishioners. They make it all possible. Their offerings and sacrifices each week make the difference.

Your weekly gift to the parish makes it possible to maintain our beautiful churches, to create space for our homeless shelter, for Twelve Step groups, to collect for the food pantry, to reach out to the sick and the homebound, to visit the hospitalized and those in nursing homes.

Your regular giving enables our kids to have the best youth ministry programs and our families to learn the faith, for adults to grow in faith, for people to learn to pray... and for all of us to have a Catholic community with which to gather.

Your giving changes so many lives for the better.

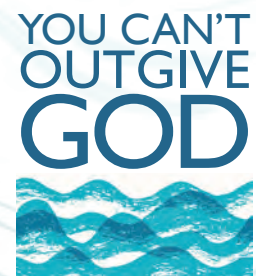

There was a Levite, a native of Cyprus – Joseph, to whom the apostles gave the name Barnabas, which means ‘son of encouragement’. He sold a field that belonged to him and brought the money and laid it at the apostles’ feet.

-Acts 4: 36-37

Barnabas was a foreigner, not from Jerusalem or Galilee or anywhere in Palestine like the apostles. He was from a far-off island country of Cyprus. No doubt as soon as he spoke, everyone knew from his accent that he was not from around here.

Jesus, became one himself, and made a commitment. His stewardship was not just “paying his part” or helping with expenses of the Church.

No, his giving was a tangible expression of his faith in response to what he saw going on in the early Church. He experienced the Spirit of God there and he responded in generosity. Barnabas used his money to advance the mission of the Church.

And we went further. When the early Christians doubted the conversion of their former persecutor Saul, Barnabas brought him in and vouched for him, putting his reputation on the line. He was generous with his money, generous with his friendship and generous in charity. No wonder they called him “son of encouragement”.

Let's all be like St. Barnabas – generous with our money, with our friendship, and with our charity to all.

Barnabas became a great missionary, a companion to St. Paul, and then went out on his own. Eventually the New Testament loses track of him but we have some traditions about where he preached later on.

His story begins with money, or probably more with a vision. He caught on to what was happening with the followers of

It was interesting to learn that the **Gospel of Luke** is also referred to as the Gospel of Mercy. So, it is fitting that our

Scripture leaders chose to study Luke this fall and winter. We know Jesus is also known as the Word and that His Word is alive. Therefore, Jesus speaks to us personally through the Scriptures and as we study this Gospel we are immersing ourselves in Jesus' message of mercy.

On Saturday, November 2nd, 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM we will be hosting an all-day retreat at the parish for all parishioners. **"Who do you say that I Am?"** is the question that Jesus asked his apostles and He continues to ask us today.
