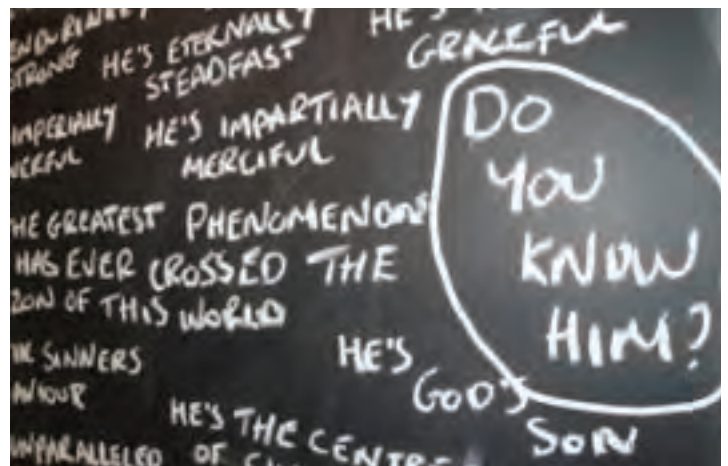
Dear Friends,

Last weekend sixty people took part in the “WHO DO YOU SAY THAT I AM?” retreat, where members of both parishes were challenged to consider the full story of Jesus and what he did for us. Each one reflected how his life and death and resurrection for us amounted to a love story of God and us.

It was a powerful experience because it got everyone away from the idea of religion as a series of “duties” and “rules” and into thanking about the relationship God wants to have with us.

Is that the way we all think about how we relate to God?

Maybe not. Probably the way we were taught the faith led us (unintentionally) to think of faith as a more or less structured set of ideas, a system. One that held together logically and that we had to learn – with Catechism questions and answers. So we naturally thought of faith as stuff we needed to know.



Of course, that is part of it, but only a part.

The most critical part of faith is the relationship with a loving God who walks with us in our suffering and our pain, who shares it and who loves us even when we fall. He came to earth in Jesus to reveal who he is and his loving plan for our eternal happiness and to invite us to love him.

When we approach our Catholic faith that way, everything changes. God is no longer just a judge and lawmaker. He is a father with a heart of mercy and goodness.

We've all got a long way to go to deepen our relationship with God. To help, we'll be offering that sort of retreat again, so watch for it next time.

Our Alpha Course also gets us started down that same path to a personal relationship with Jesus... check it out. You'll find it opens you up to a new way of looking at faith.

There are also many good mini-courses we offer for faith formation all throughout the year. Join one of them and move your own relationship with God to a deeper level.

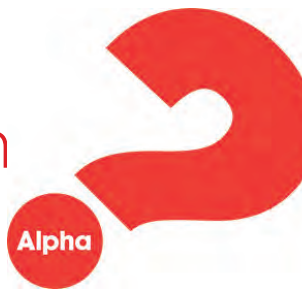

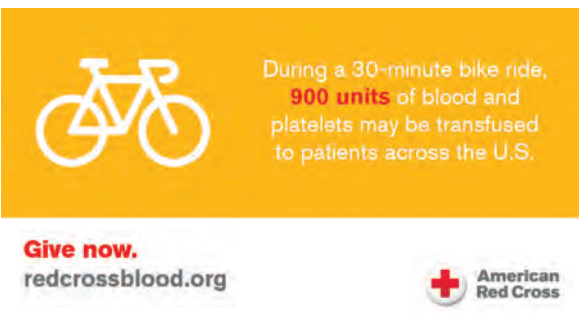
