Dear Friends,

A special word of thanks to people in both our parishes for the time and prayer you put into discerning how to give in the coming year. Our **YOU CAN'T OUT GIVE GOD** Stewardship campaign is yielding good results again this year. Thank you for your generosity.

What is most important is that each of us periodically stops and reflects on the blessings God has given us in our lives and give thanks to him. When we give thanks and live in gratitude and humility, we find a real sense of peace and serenity. And the confidence that he will always be with us as we go forward. After all, he promised he would "be with us all days, even to the end of the world". There is never a moment we are outside of God's loving care. Once we are convinced of that, we look at our material goods in a new way and our giving changes too. It becomes a way of worshipping our good God, of giving him thanks and praise.

The Archdiocese is interested in the results from parishes trying to promote good stewardship. So they are launching a new initiative with a pilot group of six parishes from around the New York area to explore ways to bring the idea of good stewardship across to more and more people. We have gotten their attention somehow and we've been chosen to participate in the first group.

I'm not really sure what it involves, but I suppose it is a bit of honor and recognition of all we have achieved so far. We'll get started next month with a seminar and I'll let you know what I find out.

Is it just me, or are people more stressed out and angry and conflicted than ever before? It seems there are few people around with real peace of soul.

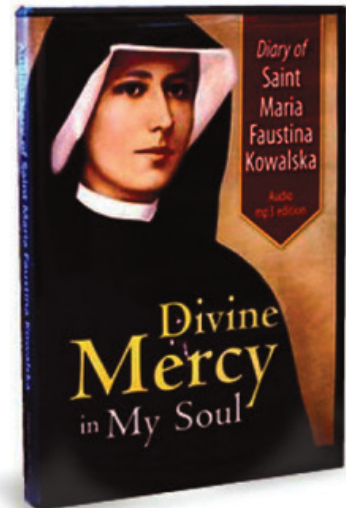
So we led a pilgrimage of 43 parishioners to the **Divine Mercy Shrine** in Stockbridge, MA this week. It's a special place nestled in the Berkshire Mountains that is devoted to the revelations given St. Faustina and the atmosphere is one of peace, of trust in the goodness of God, of love, of gratitude to Jesus who is rich in mercy. We did an outdoor Stations of the Cross, a Holy Hour, Mass and the chaplet and came back more connected to the mystery of the love of God.

If you can, pick up the **Diary of St. Faustina** and give it a good read. Or even better, make your own pilgrimage to Divine Mercy. You'll find peace of soul there.

This All Saints Day the Lifeteen teens had a special Mass dedicated to **St. Josephine Bakhita**. Liana, one of the Lifeteen teens, felt God place on her heart a desire to have an event at the parish dedicated to her. St. Josephine was Liana's Confirmation saint and a heroic example of Christ's love. St. Josephine was born a slave in the Sudan under incredibly harsh conditions. Her owner traveled to Italy, taking Josephine with her on the trip. She left her in the care of a group of Catholic religious sisters. In their convent in Italy Josephine had a deep religious conversion and desired to become a sister herself. The Italian court deemed her a free woman and she was allowed to stay. She learned to love Jesus Christ above anything else and bravely forgave her captors.
