

We did an outdoor Stations of the Cross, a Holy Hour, Mass and the chaplet and came back more connected to the mystery of the love of God.

If you can, pick up the **Diary of St. Faustina** and give it a good read. Or even better, make your own pilgrimage to Divine Mercy. You'll find peace of soul there.

This All Saints Day the Lifeteen teens had a special Mass dedicated to **St. Josephine Bakhita**. Liana, one of the Lifeteen teens, felt God place on her heart a desire to have an event at the parish dedicated to her. St. Josephine was Liana's Confirmation saint and a heroic example of Christ's love. St. Josephine was born a slave in the Sudan under incredibly harsh conditions. Her owner traveled to Italy, taking Josephine with her on the trip. She left her in the care of a group of Catholic religious sisters. 
