Dear Friends,

I've had a series of encounters with other pastors and meetings with officials from the Archdiocese in recent weeks to discuss parish development and evangelization. Talking the issues over helps me understand the common challenges we have as parishes. To sum it up: we are trying to communicate the Gospel in a society that is more and more drifting away from God.

Parishes are facing lower attendance and with fewer priests, it is hard to turn that around.

That involves helping people know and love their faith, develop a real, personal relationship with Jesus, learn to pray well, to form their consciences according to his teachings, and reach out to others to share what they have discovered.

I think we at our parishes of St. Lawrence and Sacred Heart are blessed in this regard – we are working hard on all those things. We have developed many wonderful service opportunities. We have been running Alpha successfully as a way to introduce people to faith. We have excellent faith formation activities for adults and kids. And our discipleship program brings people to the next level of real, personal relationship with the Lord. We are parishes focused on adoration of the Blessed Sacrament around the clock.

As we approach the end of this year, I'd like to ask you to do a gut check. Are you closer to God than you were this time last year? Have you grown as a person of faith? Is Jesus at the center of your life?

Maybe the year 2020 is the year you need to change that. The world we are in is very good at draining our faith away. You have felt that and you've seen others fade away. Don't let it happen to you.

Take a look at all our parishes offer to help you grow as a Catholic. Maybe it is time to start getting to Adoration, to take a faith formation class, to join Alpha, to volunteer... make this new year ahead the year you and God will get closer.
