

Dear Friends,

Yesterday the Church all around the world celebrated the Feast of the Holy Innocents – the day Herod sent his soldiers to slaughter all the male babies of Bethlehem in a desperate attempt to kill Jesus and prevent him from replacing him as "King of the Jews".

They were the first who died as a witness to Jesus Christ and his kingship over the earth. They would not be the last by far. Many millions more martyrs would give their lives for their faith in Jesus – even up to our present day.

In our time, taking innocent human life and justifying it has become something we are all supposed to accept and get used to. Advocates for abortion expected by now we would give up. But Christians cannot and will not, because they know that every human life is made in the image and likeness of God.

That's why we still march on Washington every January, to demand that innocent human life be welcomed in life and respected in our laws. That we once again be a nation that respects the fundamental right to life. Join us for the March for Life January 24 – we have a bus going from our parish.

But these days abortion is not the only threat to innocent human life. Now "assisted suicide" is spreading from state to state. Laws allowing doctors to give lethal drugs to patients with terminal illnesses are passing and New York State is heading in that direction. Gov. Cuomo wants to sign a bill sponsored by our State Senator Peter Harckam. We can't let that happen.

You'll probably all remember Dr. Jack Kevorkian years ago started up helping terminally ill with lethal doses of drugs. At the time he was shunned by everyone in the medical profession and wound up going to prison for it. But a generation later, attitudes among doctors have sadly shifted in favor of death.

Suicide is always wrong because life is a gift from God. Enlisting doctors in the work of suicide perverts the healing profession and makes it contradict its mission to heal and to care.

Those targeted include the handicapped, the terminally ill, the elderly and others who have no further "usefulness" in society and are a burden to the rest of us. People propose this law as a "death with dignity" law but there is no screening for depression, no counseling, no safeguards in place. It opens the door to abuse of the elderly and the sick and the defenseless innocent people.

Our Catholic faith calls us to defend all innocent human life, from conception to natural death. Please take a stand and contact Senator Harckam with your objections. There is further information in this bulletin on what you can do. Next Sunday we will host a letter-writing campaign. Act today to defend the true dignity of human life.





a culture of death

Lynda Holler

In 2014, while my husband Kenny was dying, Californian, Brittany Maynard was advocating for Physician Assisted Suicide (PAS) to be legalized there. She had been diagnosed with brain cancer and wanted to kill herself rather than experience the disabilities and suffering that doctors told her could be expected. She ultimately moved to Oregon where PAS is legal, where she requested and received a prescription from a doctor for a lethal dose of pills and ended her life before her suffering began.

I was at the very lowest point of my life; my family was experiencing our greatest suffering, but I felt sorry for her. Brittany had been deceived into believing that her life did not have value if she was going to suffer, whereas it was through our suffering that our family grew closer to God, to one another, to our communities, and came to more deeply understand the meaning of life.

After Kenny died, I joined other people who were working to oppose PAS legislation in NY. I have written articles for newspapers, spoken to groups, met with legislators, and spoke at a NYS Assembly Health Committee Hearing in NYC.



9 States and DC with Legal Physician-Assisted Suicide



Because of Brittany's misguided direction, 8 states, including California, and the District of Columbia have adopted this law. This year there will be a big push from legislators and Governor Cuomo to pass it in NY. Even if people do not have moral, ethical, or religious objections, the lack of oversight and accountability, threats to the disabled and mentally ill, and the terror of lethal drugs sitting unmonitored in peoples' homes should horrify us all. We must also be aware that as in Oregon, PAS would mostly likely increase suicides in the general public, because suicide becomes culturally acceptable.

Once a bill becomes law, it is almost impossible to repeal it, so we need to make it clear to our lawmakers we oppose this legislation. It is important that we contact our Senator Pete Harckham, because he is a co-sponsor of the bill. Before and after the Jan 4 & 5 weekend Masses we will have letters available for you to sign stating that you are against Medical Aid in Dying. I will collect all of the letters and deliver them to our lawmakers in Albany by Jan 10.
