

OUR VISION Create a parish of missionary disciples whose personal relationship with Jesus Christ inspires others into a life-changing relationship with Him.

Dear Friends,

I'm always looking for new ideas. So while away on vacation this week, I dropped in to an Evangelical Mega-Church to see how they go about things. They have a way of getting people excited about their mission that we can learn from, and they take the plain words of the Scripture seriously and act on them. At the same time, of course, they're missing out on some of what we consider the most important parts of the Gospel such as the Eucharist and the rest of the sacraments.

They were starting a new series in their preaching schedule called "Just One". Their style is to have a theme for six or eight weeks in a row they drive home. The idea was to encourage everyone this year to focus on just one person they know who is away from faith in Jesus and take that person on. I liked that idea – that everyone "adopt" a person who needs God and find a way to nudge or coach them along.

The preacher talked about how one ordinary person named Ananias was the key to converting St. Paul. And he obeyed God despite his fears and went to meet with Paul. And the rest, as they say, is history.

I bet every one of us can think of one person we'd love to bring back to God. But like Ananias we hesitate, don't we?

Since it was just the first week, they didn't explain much about how to go about working on that one person you know. But it made me think that we Catholics have some great resources to help us.

- 1. Prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. Sometimes we think of Adoration as something mainly for ourselves, to grow closer to God. But it is also the best place to pray for the people God has put on your heart the friends or family members not living in a God-centered way. Just go.
- 2. The Rosary. We can enlist the help of the Blessed Mother by saying the Rosary for our loved ones. Take the time to do it each day and you will see conversions.
- 3. Learn your faith. Sometimes we hesitate to engage in spiritual discussions with people we love and who need it because let's face it we're not sure we really understand our faith enough to convince anyone. That's why our parish offers so much to us in faith formation... to make us into confident Catholics who can explain it to others.
- 4. Alpha. Our Alpha Course is a fantastic way to introduce somebody back to the basics of the faith... just invite them along with you. No pressure, no cost. We're starting another Alpha during Lent, in a month or so...

Can you bring along Just One person?



extraordinary eucharistic miracles that left physical evidence-continued

The Corporal of Bolsena – 13th century



A priest who had been experiencing doubts about transubstantiation was celebrating Mass in Orvieto, Italy. Soon after he had consecrated the Eucharist, the host started bleeding onto the corporal (a liturgical cloth) on the altar. The priest, the story goes, ran to the pope who was visiting the town and confessed his sin

of doubt. The corporal remains on display in the Cathedral of Orvieto.

Some historians, however, question the veracity of the story, since the first accounts of it don't appear until about a hundred years after the miracle supposedly took place. Nonetheless, the corporal remains an object of veneration.

The Hosts of Siena, Italy – 18th century



On August 14th, 1730, while the Catholics of Siena, Italy were attending a special festival for the eve of the feast of the Assumption, thieves entered the Church of St. Francis and stole a golden ciborium containing hundreds of a consecrated hosts.

Two days later, someone noticed something white protruding from the offering box at another church in Siena. The priests opened the box and found the missing hosts inside, entangled in cobwebs and dirt. After

being cleaned as much as possible, the hosts were placed in a new ciborium and taken back to the Church of St. Francis for prayers of reparation and veneration.

Since the hosts were dirty, the priests decided not to consume them but let them simply deteriorate. Over the next few decades, everyone was amazed to see that the hosts did not deteriorate, but actually appeared fresh.

The hosts remain in this state today, 285 years later, and can still be seen in the (now) Basilica of St. Francis in Siena, Italy. (to be continued)

Our leadership teams will be meeting to explore how we can help them and work together. I'm hoping it will be something that is mutually beneficial for our parishes. 


