One of the great classic devotions in our Catholic tradition is the nine first Fridays. It springs from the revelations of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17 th century. To anyone who would observe the First Fridays by attending Mass and receiving Communion worthily, Jesus made twelve beautiful promises:

1. I will give them all of the graces necessary for their state of life.
2. I will establish peace in their houses.
3. I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
4. I will be their strength during life and above all during death.
5. I will bestow a large blessing upon all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source and the infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall grow fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
9. I will bless every place where a picture of my heart shall be set up and honored.
10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be blotted out.
12. I promise you in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who shall receive communion on the First Friday in nine consecutive months the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their sacraments; My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

Wouldn't we all be so much more peaceful and joyful if those promises were fulfilled in our lives? At St. Lawrence, we offer Confession at 6:00 pm, followed by Mass at 7:00 pm and time for Adoration and the Divine Mercy Chaplet from 7:45 pm to 8:15. It is a beautiful evening, and Jesus will pour out his blessing on you and your family.

We encourage everyone that especially on First Friday of the month, to pray with us, to fast by skipping one or two meals, and by giving to the poor.

Join us this Friday night and every First Friday, and you will find the Sacred Heart of Jesus will keep his promises.

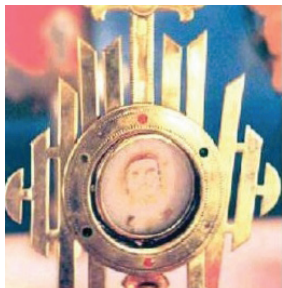

## extraordinary eucharistic miracles that left physical evidence-continued

### The Miracle of Chirattakonam, India – 21st century



On April 28th, 2001, there was Eucharistic adoration at St. Mary's parish in Chirattakonam, India, when suddenly three red stains materialized on the host. The priest didn't know what to do and placed the host back into the tabernacle.

A few days later he retrieved the host to examine it again, and the red stains had arranged themselves to look like the face of a man (Jesus?). He quickly found a photographer and had pictures taken of the host.

### The Eucharistic Miracle of Santarém – 13th century



A woman living in Santarém, Portugal in the 13th was distressed that her husband was unfaithful to her, and she decided to consult a sorceress for help. The sorceress told her the price of her services was a consecrated host.

She went to Mass at the Church of St. Stephen and received the Eucharist on her tongue, removed the Eucharist from her mouth, wrapped it in her veil, and headed

to the door of the church. But before she got out, the host began to bleed.

When she got home, she put the bloodied host in a trunk. That night, a miraculous light emanated from the trunk. She repented of what she had done and the next morning confessed to her priest. Her priest came and retrieved the host and took it back to the church.

After an investigation and approval of the miracle, the church was renamed Church of the Holy Miracle, and the bloodied host remains on display to this day.



## a cemetery is truly “holy ground”

When Christians talk about “holy ground,” it is typically in reference to a church building, the place where God’s presence is most keenly felt. While that is certainly true, one holy place that is often neglected is the local cemetery.

The Church has always treated the dead with the utmost respect and the cemetery is where that belief is clearly practiced. When a new Catholic cemetery is created, the bishop (or sometimes a priest appointed by him) will come out to bless it and hallow the ground where the dead will be buried.

The first action of the bishop is to walk around the entire cemetery, sprinkling holy water on the ground. During that time the following words are sung, reminiscent of music during the Easter Asperges ritual: “Purify me with hyssop, Lord, and I shall be clean of sin. Wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.”

Then the bishop says the following prayer from the Roman Ritual (or other prayers from the updated ritual book), purifying the cemetery from all evil, making it a sacred place until the end of time.

Lord God, Father of everlasting glory, solace of the sorrowing, life of the just, glory of the lowly, we humbly importune you to keep this cemetery free from any vileness of unclean spirits, to cleanse and to bless it, and finally to give lasting wholeness to the bodies brought here for burial. And at the end of time, when the angels sound their trumpets, let all

who have received the sacrament of baptism, who have persevered in the Catholic faith until death, and who have had their remains laid to rest in this cemetery, be rewarded in body and in soul with the unending joys of heaven; through Christ our Lord.

A second prayer is said, recalling the mercy of God and praying for all those who will be buried there. God, Creator of the world and Redeemer of mankind, who wondrously dispose the destinies of all creatures, visible and invisible; we humbly and sincerely beseech you to hallow, purify, and bless this cemetery, where the bodies of your servants are duly laid to rest, after the labor and fatigue of this life come to an end. Pardon, in your great mercy, the sins of those who put their trust in you, and graciously grant unending consolation to their bodies that will lie at rest in this cemetery, awaiting the trumpet-call of the Archangel Michael.

These prayers are important and emphasize the sacredness of a cemetery, a place similar in dignity to a church building. It reminds us that cemeteries are set apart for a sacred purpose and should be treated as such.

So the next time you visit a cemetery remember that you walk on holy ground, blessed not only through the prayers of the bishop, but also by the presence of our deceased brothers and sisters in Christ.

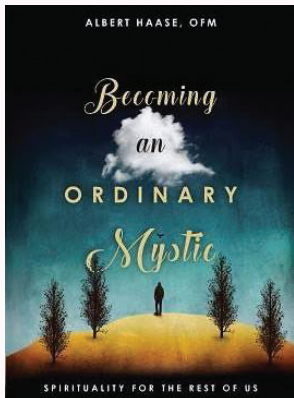
