#### Dear Friends.

Ten days until Lent is here again. February 26 – just a week from Wednesday is Ash Wednesday. This is going to be our best Lent ever, because we want this to be our best Holy Week and Easter ever. So we have to start day one. We've got to jump into this season of prayer and penance starting on Ash Wednesday. Many people say they are stuck in neutral spiritually. Lent can jumpstart your spiritual life.

- 1. **Ash Wednesday**: We'll have ashes in the morning and evening at Sacred Heart, and Masses at St. Lawrence morning and evening as well. See the schedule in this bulletin or on the website.
- 2. It's a day of fasting and abstinence, which means if you're 14-59, you're required to fast (i.e., only one main meal) and no meat.
- 3. **Every Friday in Lent** a day of abstinence: no meat or poultry. It's a bad season for you if you are a fish. Make a sacrifice for our sins and the sins of others.
- 4. **Time for Confession**: every Monday 4:00 pm 7:00 pm at St. Lawrence and Saturdays 3:15 pm 3:45 pm pm at Sacred Heart. *Confession Monday is April 6*. Don't miss Confession if you forgot how, or you are rusty, welcome back! Easy penances promised. We have brochure guides to the sacrament in the Church.
- 5. **Lenten Seasons of Praise** every Monday in Lent with great preachers and time for Adoration: 7:00 to 8:30 pm Mondays at St. Lawrence.
- 6. **Stations of the Cross** every Lenten Friday at 6:15 pm at St. Lawrence in English and 8:30 in Spanish. At Sacred Heart, Stations on Fridays at 7:00 pm followed by Adoration and Benediction.
- 7. **Alpha**: both at Sacred Heart and St. Lawrence and in Spanish as well. This course will get you, and your unchurched or semi-churched friends to catch fire again. It's great food, great conversation, new friends... and a path to Jesus. It's also free. And it's a judgement free zone. Bring someone with you who needs more God in their life. Just imagine, if you reconnect with your faith, or bring someone else closer to God, it will be your best Lent ever.

Oh... and an optional extra: Why not make every Friday in Lent a day of fasting and abstinence? The Church only requires it on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, but would you join me in doing some extra penance for all those who are away from God and have shut him out? Family members, friends, neighbors – who is praying for them? Probably no one. Somebody had better do it, and it might as well be you and me. Are you in?



Lent is a six-week period leading up to Easter. Lent begins 46 days before the Saturday of Easter weekend (Easter Sunday falls on Sunday, April 12, 2020), but is only observed Monday-Saturday each week because every Sunday is viewed as a celebration. Therefore, Lent is observed a total of 40 days.

### true presence

On Christmas Day 2013, a Eucharistic miracle took place in St. Hyacinth's Church in Legnica, Poland, about 200 miles from Krakow. During Communion time, a Host accidentally fell to the floor. The priest at once placed it in a container to dissolve. But two weeks later, as the "Acutis Miracle" site explains, Father Andrzej Ziombra, accompanied by another priest, "noticed that the Host had not dissolved and that a red spot covering a fifth of its surface appeared," Father Ziombra reported. "We decided to inform the bishop, who established

a special theological scientific commission to analyze the event."

When two major forensic medicine institutes were asked to examine samples from the Host, both found it was composed of myocardial (heart) tissue. Even more, the second source at the Pomeranian Medical University's department further found

it to be "human heart muscle with alterations that often appear during agony." Once the Vatican's Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith was given the results, it recognized this as a supernatural experience. Nor was this the only Eucharistic miracle in this century

in Poland. On Oct.
12, 2008, 409 miles
northeast in Sokółka,
Poland, at St. Anthony
of Sokółka Church,
a priest accidentally
dropped a consecrated
Host during Mass. He
also decided to dissolve
that Host in water in the

vessel priests use to purify their fingers after Communion.

As several sources would reveal, after Mass the nun serving as sacristan placed the container holding the Host in the safe for sacred vessels. A week later, on Oct. 19, the sister checked and found the Host partly dissolved but the rest had a "strange red clot." She called the priest. After many examinations of a sample by everyone from archbishops to doctors and world-renowned scientists, that spot proved to be tissue from a human heart. Scientists — unaware where the samples came from — agreed there was no explanation for this because the bread of the Host had turned into heart muscle and was still living tissue.

In 2009, the Metropolitan Curia of Białystok declared: "The case of Sokółka does not contradict the faith of the Church, but rather confirms it." Indeed, such miracles are a boon to people's faith.

I think the item that struck us the most was the monstrance. It is beautiful and has such an powerful job: to display and

honor the (Host) Body of Christ, and we, just a mom and son from Brewster, got the privilege to hold and examine it! We were in awe. The children were looking around as if to get a second and third confirmation that it was acceptable to handle the monstrance. It was very moving for me, and I know the kids felt very special to be able to do this as well. They were captivated and intrigued. How often do you get to touch something so significant?

Once we finished in the gallery, we were able to make a craft together. We made our very own lighted monstrance to take home. It has been on each night in Dylan's room. It is truly a symbol of something so marvelous and meaningful, but also a reminder of this unparalleled opportunity we had with

each other on Saturday. Dylan and I continued the conversation long after the session and discussed our remarkable experience with our family. Even grandma has never held the monstrance!

I am learning things at the **Family Program** alongside my son. As we left, I asked Dylan if there was anything more im-

portant than our encounter here today. He gave me his dimple-smile and said that he couldn't imagine anything better!

When you put your busy life aside to spend time with God, you will truly see how He loves us!

Transformed will kick off in the Sacred Heart Parish Hall in the middle of May and run to the end of June. Stay tuned for day and time and registration information.





### alpha — come and see!

I recently took a trip with others from the parish out to Phoenix, Arizona to participate in an Alpha conference. Alpha is an organization that was born in England, and its main goal is to help answer questions about life, our existence and the existence of God. In Alpha, we explore how there is so much more to life than just this! By "this", I mean the everyday grind of life. Sometimes we may feel caught up in it, and if we're really honest with ourselves, we might ask the question, "Is there something more to life than this?" Well...... Alpha is the way to find out what that something is. The main thing I took away from the Alpha conference was that Alpha is for everyone. Christians, non-Christians, people young and old, people with questions about life's purpose, people who have not been to church and even those who do attend.

During the conference there was music by Grammy winner Matt Redman; that was pretty cool. But that's not all, there were some very interesting people there who spoke about how Alpha has impacted their lives. There was a young woman, Jo Hearn from Liverpool England, who now lives in Chicago. At a young age she was going through difficulties in her life, anxiety, depression. Like so many of us, she did not know what to do. A friend invited her to Alpha, and she said "sure, I'll go". But deep down she admitted to herself that she had no intention of going. In the days ahead, something changed her mind and she ended up giving it a try. She said it turned her life around and she now helps to run the Alpha series at the Soul City Church in Chicago. By the way, she is known as "Alpha Jo," among the parishioners there. There was also Ricardo Cabrera from San Diego, who decided that running drugs across the southern border was a good idea. Long story short, it wasn't a good idea; he went to prison and you guessed it....found Alpha. It totally changed his life. He is now running Alpha for the East Lake Church prison inmates in southern California. Hearing these stories first hand was really powerful. I'm not saying that you will be running Alpha after you attend, but hey.....you never know.

At St. Lawrence there is an Alpha group for everyone. We have **Alpha Wednesdays** from 7-9pm in English, and in Spanish. We have **Alpha Pub Young Adults** for people ages 21-39, **Alpha at Sacred Heart** on Sunday mornings from 8:30-10:15, and also **Alpha Marriage**, for couples who either are married; not married, but living together; or couples that are planning on getting married. As you can see, we are betting on Alpha to help bring more people to Jesus. Can you imagine the effect Alpha could bring forth in a parish like ours?

Imagine your next door neighbor, your coworker, the person you often greet at the supermarket, your children's sport coach, your hairstylist, or the mechanic that fixes your car... what would happen if you invite them to try Alpha? Your conversation doesn't need to be anything elaborate. Ask them

if they would join you for dinner, and to have conversations about our lives, our concerns and dreams. All at no cost, in a nice and relaxed environment with no commitment or follow up rules. After you invite the people in your circle, go home and pray that Jesus will do the rest.

Having our friends and community members encounter Jesus while sharing a meal and building of friendship can change our parish as we know it! We will have more smiles, children, teens, and families living the life of grace that God has planned for us. Invite a friend to join you at Alpha.

Alpha has been running at St. Lawrence for three years. I am helping to run the Alpha course here at St. Lawrence with a team of volunteers.


