Dear Friends,

It's a slow road back to full opening all over. Now we move to Phase III according to the State of New York, and we can have up to 50% capacity in the buildings. Little by little as people are more confident going out, our numbers will be increasing.

In the meantime, we have a limited summer Mass schedule for Sundays and we've added Masses on Tuesday through Thursday evenings at 7:00 pm for those who feel more comfortable with the smaller attendance at a daily Mass. So you can attend during the week...

We are also still LIVESTREAMING Mass at 9:30 am Sundays each week.

We're also sanitizing the Church after every Mass, wiping down all the surfaces and cleaning the bathrooms. Each week we have a company come in to fumigate the Church with a powerful chemical that kills all microbes. We're also taking all the precautions of washing hands and wearing masks. So we are creating a totally safe environment for us all to worship.

This week we'll reopen the Parish Center at St. Lawrence and groups can start meeting once again, with all the usual limitations helping us remain cautious and careful.

Summer is the time to celebrate and we want to celebrate our reopening and welcome everyone home. On July 19, we'll be holding an outdoor Mass at Wells Park on Oak Street. Bring lawn chairs and lunch for a big picnic. There will be games for the kids and contests and prizes. More information is in the works and we'll get it to you soon.



5 amazing facts about the power of the Eucharist

A friend recently told me that her father used to help her mother in the kitchen with the most tedious of tasks. One thing he liked to do was peel walnuts and sort them into buckets. Then, he would give bags of the nuts to friends and family. My friend's father recently passed away and a few months later she reached into her freezer to get some of the walnuts to make banana bread. As she looked at the bag of walnuts she realized that even though her father was gone, he had left her nourishment for her journey.

At that moment, my friend suddenly had a deeper understanding of the Eucharist. Jesus knew he was going to ascend into heaven, but he left his followers with something to nourish them, and not just earthly food but his own Body and Blood.

We are looked after. We are cared for.

We have a heavenly Father who knows our every need and goes to great lengths to give us what we require. Our daily bread is not a symbol or mere earthly sustenance; it is true spiritual food, the real flesh and blood of our Savior the Godman. The Eucharist is nourishment that transcends ceremony and finds its power and its essence in the very workings of the Trinity itself.

Here are some of the amazing effects of the Eucharist:

1) Union with Christ: Reception of Jesus in the Eucharist fuses our being with that of Christ. St. Cyril of Alexandria describes it as similar to "when melted wax is fused with other wax." The Christian journey is a journey to become like Christ,

to "abide in him" and he in us. The Eucharist is the means for this to happen.

- **2) Destruction of venial sin**: The Eucharist destroys venial sin. Destroys! Through sin, the fervor of our charity can be dampened by venial sin. But when we receive the Eucharist we are united with Charity himself, which burns away the vestiges of our venial sins and leaves us cleansed and ready to begin again.
- 3) Preservation from mortal sin: While we should refrain from receiving the Eucharist when we are aware of being in a state of mortal sin, we should receive the Eucharist as much as possible when we are able because it preserves us from grave sin. It is as if the Eucharist's power washes away the venial sin in our souls and then covers us with a protective coat which helps us to stay away from serious sin.
- **4) Personal relationship with Jesus**: Many Christians speak of the importance of a personal relationship with Jesus, which is very true. But it is primarily through the Eucharist that we can truly have an intimate encounter with the Person of Jesus. Benedict XVI once pointed out this connection:

"Today, there is a need to rediscover that Jesus Christ is not just a private conviction or an abstract idea, but a real person, whose becoming part of human history is capable of renewing the life of every man and woman. Hence, the Eucharist, as the source and summit of the Church's life and mission, must be translated into spirituality, into a life lived 'according to the Spirit'" (Sacramentum Caritatis).

5) Gives life: According to the Catechism, the Eucharist "preserves, increases, and renews the life of grace received at Baptism" (CCC 1392). In other words, reception of the Eucharist increases the life of grace already present within us. Sounds even better than a trip to a spa!to the world, and leave behind a lasting legacy.



sacred heart celebrates their namesake

On the liturgical calendar of the Roman Catholic Church, a solemnity is a feast day of the highest rank celebrating a mystery of faith such as the Trinity, an event in the life of Jesus, his mother Mary, or another important saint. In other words, it is a very big deal.

The Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus goes back to a series of apparitions from Jesus to a French nun, St. Mary Margaret Alacoque in the late 1600s. It came at a time when rigid Protestant influences were leading some in the Catholic Church to view God as a severe and unforgiving judge. The

message of the Sacred Heart is simple: "God is Love".

We, as the sheep in his pasture, experience the overwhelming mercy of God and His infinite desire to be in a relationship with us.

The Sacred Heart Choir, accompanied by Choir Director Melody Salas-Curra, was back in full force and sounded like a choir of angels. They welcomed a new member Mike Camarotta.

Two people shared that it was their first time "out" because they felt "safe" celebrating the Feast of the Sacred Heart.




Even when my mind wanders at times during Adoration, I now know that the God that loves me is okay with that. He is just so happy I came for another visit with him.


