## while we're at it

**OUR VISION** Create a parish of missionary disciples whose personal relationship with Jesus Christ inspires others into a life-changing relationship with Him.

#### Dear Friends.

With all the turmoil our country is going through, the pandemic, the racial tension, the violence, and the attacks on the symbols of our nation it's no wonder we get worried about the future. That's why I'm hoping this 4 th of July will serve to remind us of what Abraham Lincoln knew well — that America is a nation established by God, that despite its imperfections and sins, is still a "shining city on a hill" and the greatest force for good in the world. We need to love and to pray for our nation and for its unity as "one nation, under God".



We're in our fourth week of reopening now and people are gradually making their way back to the Mass, and parish formation activities are starting up again. Now we are in Phase III in the Hudson Valley and we can have up to 50% capacity in our churches and buildings. You may have noticed that some priests won their lawsuit against Governor Cuomo when he restricted gatherings in churches but not in protest marches. The court ruled he could not limit churches and not others.

We're opening the Parish Center for meetings and courses, and we'll be making sure it's regularly sanitized and safe. Let's be careful and wear masks and sanitize our hands often. It's not normal for us as Catholics not to associate and share our faith, so let's get back to all the good things we had going on at our parish. But safely.

As you've noticed upon walking up to St. Lawrence Church, we've erected a public life-sized Crucifix to give silent witness to our faith and the most important moment in human history that gave us reconciliation with God.

At Sacred Heart perhaps you've seen some activity in the woods... we're clearing some overgrown areas and making a place for an outdoor altar and Stations of the Cross in the woods. We're also installing security cameras in and around the buildings to keep the place safe.

Finally, thanks to your generosity with the Centennial Campaign and the Centennial Gold envelopes, we made another principal payment of \$150,000 on our renovation loan, bringing our balance down to just \$600,000. That's still a lot of money, but it is down from the original \$3.8 million five years ago. It's amazing what all of you have done to create a beautiful Church and support it with your generosity. Thank you so much. We are scheduled and on track to have the remaining debt paid down in the next four years or so.






