Dear Friends,

One of the unique things about our two amazing parishes is our shared history. St. Lawrence started as a parish in 1878 and built the current stone church in 1915 as the town of Brewster started to grow.

Most people don't remember but Sacred Heart was started in 1932 with the donation of some land and a small chapel built by the Hance family. Priests from St. Lawrence would travel over to Putnam Lake on Sundays to say Mass for the mostly summertime inhabitants around the lake. In 1942, the chapel burned in a terrible fire and it was not until 1955 that the current church was built on a larger piece of land. The Hances are buried on the property they gave to the church, and they donated their home to be the rectory. Eventually, Sacred Heart became a parish on its own. But since 2011, we have shared the same pastor as sister churches and that sort of arrangement is fast becoming the "new normal" for Catholic parishes all around.

We've been integrating our adult faith formation programs and we'll be taking a big step forward in uniting our religious education and sacramental preparation for kids this year as well. Together we can share resources and tap into the experienced staff of St. Lawrence for the good of both churches.

We've developed a joint logo and we're working to unite the two websites into one, making things easier to do everything together in a coordinated way.

Sacred Heart has a nice tradition of a parish picnic every summer and this year we will start to make it a joint outdoor Mass and picnic for both parishes to come together in unity and charity. We'll have it on **August 30 and after the Mass, the day will be filled with good food and fun and games for the adults and kids as well.** More information will be coming your way, but save the date now for the whole family to come and celebrate our parish and our family spirit.







adoration keeps me focused

What Does Time Spent in Eucharistic Adoration Mean to Me? You have to be there to experience Eucharistic Adoration. To me, it is an awesome feeling and experience to be in front and up close to Jesus in the form of the Eucharist. You can say that happens at Mass when the priest

consecrates the bread into the body of Christ and the wine into the blood of Christ, but there is a difference. At Mass, you are doing it as a community, whereas in Eucharistic Adoration, you are one-on-one with Jesus.

One can say that Christ is with us every minute, of every hour, of every day. And that is true. I pray at home, on the

train, and at work. But in my daily grind, full of work and distractions, one thing that I should pay attention to, and I do not, is my relationship with God. If you are like me, there is always too much going on, too many things to do, and not enough hours in the day. When I sit in the Adoration Chapel all this goes away with Eucharistic Adoration. There is a joy I have with a one-on-one conversation with Jesus in His presence that I don't have when I am not at Eucharistic Adoration. It is during this one-on-one time I believe God is listening to me and me to him.

The opportunity to be with the REAL PRESENCE of Jesus in Eucharistic Adoration puts me at peace, as Jesus keeps me serene and safe amidst the chaos that is swirling all around me these days. Eucharistic Adoration keeps me focused on what is really important and it allows me to forget myself. It also provides me with the graces I need to take action and help others in God's providence and God's will. I attended Eucharistic Adoration once before, years ago, when I lived in Marquette, Michigan. It was as awesome then as it is now. I never realized how much I missed Eucharistic Adoration until I started again at St. Lawrence O'Toole/Sacred Heart Church.



in the heart of jesus

Consoling the Heart of Jesus is a 10-week retreat (via Zoom) which is rich with spiritual exercises and helped me better understand the Sorrowful Heart of Jesus. There were weekly readings, a video, and group discussion too.

Fr. Michael Gaitley leads the videos with witticism and candor and brings

his audience to a unique understanding of the Passion of Jesus and how we all long for His graces, as well as how our Lord desires our trust and our love.

What I gained from Consoling The Heart of Jesus, is not easy to put into words, but what I experienced was internal change.

I was raised in a family where religion was tepid even though we were Catholics. I grew up with no formal religious background, but I always had a love for Jesus and the Church. As I started attending faith formation classes at St. Lawrence O'Toole, I learned much, but I wasn't 100% satisfied with myself and I still felt empty. I felt something was still lacking.

What was wrong with me? Where was my reverence? Why wasn't my background rich in Catholicism as so many I've come to know? What is expected of me? What does Jesus desire of me? Well those concerns have been put aside for

my transformative experience in understanding Jesus' Heart and His desire for me became clear after taking this course.

I do not want to give the false impression that the Gates of Heaven opened up for me. That didn't happen, but my heart opened up for Jesus. In other words, at some point, I stopped thinking about Jesus and feeling Jesus, and started placing myself into Jesus. I stopped asking and began believing and understanding what He always has been trying to tell me." To come to Him first not last! "

I heard, "pray outward and not inward. Pray for my children, do not discriminate, for they are members of my body, and most in need of my mercy." All of a sudden, *The Diary of St. Faustina* made sense. I learned not to pray for myself but to pray for Jesus.

I may never know the mysteries of the world and Christ's hand in it, but I do know He needs His children to unite to His sorrowful heart.

I cried reading chapters in Fr. Michael Gaitley's book. My heart ached as I felt Jesus' suffering, yet I learned there is a light at the end of the tunnel. My eyes were opened about my own obstacles of the heart, how they put a wedge between myself and Jesus, and how I overcame those obstacles. Today I'm right where I'm supposed to be, in the heart of Jesus.


