# while we're at it

**OUR VISION** Create a parish of missionary disciples whose personal relationship with Jesus Christ inspires others into a life-changing relationship with Him.

Dear Friends,

One of the many amazing stories at St. Lawrence has been the **Centennial Renovation** we finished just five years ago, commemorating the construction of our stone church in 1915. Instead of moving our church to a new site and starting all over, we opted to renew the traditional church and bring out all its beauty and elegance. We were able to add a wing on to the church for the **Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel**, two new confessionals, a sacristy, handicapped elevator, sacristies and storage areas. We made the church easily accessible from the parish center side where there had been no entrance.

It was also remarkable that we managed to do it all while we were doing a room by room renovation of the old school into a **state-of-the-art Parish Center** and **Early Childhood Learning Center**. Now hundreds of kids and adults are able to use the Center for faith formation, schooling and prayer. Everyone was delighted with the way it turned out and were generous in giving to support the renovation.

The story of that generosity was also amazing. We spent \$3.8 million on just the church renovations, and we pay 5% interest on the money borrowed. But since 2014 we have paid down all but \$600,000 thanks to the generosity of our parishioners! We had many pledges, most of which have been completed over five years. You have all been awesome in your giving and thank you so much.

Many people have also chosen to give once a month through our **Centennial Gold** envelopes or through **WeShare Centennial**. As you can see from the financial report elsewhere in the bulletin, we get about \$4000 a month in these Centennial gifts and that is helping us pay down the balance of our loan.



Our plan is to finish off the loan in the next four years, so we need to keep chipping away at that last \$600,000. If you can help by using the **Centennial Gold** envelopes once a month and give whatever you can, or make a recurring gift on **WeShare**, I would be so grateful. Any amount you can give – large or small – will be a great help. And every dollar goes directly to this loan, with no assessments or taxes by the Archdiocese.

We've come a long way and we are getting close! Thank you for your steady support of our parish.

It was great to see each one interact and push each other out of their comfort zones as we made smoothie bowls, played basketball and brainstormed the ideal qualities of our potential future husbands!

"helped me to know that other girls my age may be struggling with the same things that I am going through"


"was a place where I felt free to express my thoughts and feelings" "inspired me to do things I never would have thought about doing."

Through our talks, we learned how social media has hurt many young women's self-esteem and confidence. It is so easy to believe the lie that we're not good enough, we don't have enough friends, money, nice clothes, maybe that we don't look a certain way, or drive the nicest car, or have the best house.

My hope for our next Faithfully Fit Camp is for the ladies to learn that earthly things afford us nothing if we don't have a relationship with Jesus. I want to see more young women (and all people) desiring to practice healthy eating, fitness, and most importantly: seeing themselves the way that God sees them. We just finished the Presence class on Zoom. We had 22 participants, some from Saint Lawrence O'Toole and some from Scared Heart, we even had a few people from different states! We had a great group of people who love the Lord and wanted to understand in more depth the power of the Eucharist. The class is so informative, exploring Scared Scripture and how it all relates to now. Everyone in the class learned something new or had an "aha" moment! I highly recommend anyone to watch the Presence videos on Formed.org for a deeper understanding of the Eucharist and it's origins.

This was such a powerful class, that it is not enough to take it just once. This is my second time participating in this class and it is just as awe-inspiring as it was the first time around. We learn from the Old Testament that Adam and Eve ate the fruit from the Tree of Life and lost favor with God. Jesus was crucified and the cross becomes the new Tree of Life and the Eucharist is the fruit. When we eat this fruit, we will live forever. -Kathy Friedlander

This class was particularly meaningful during this time we were deprived of receiving the Eucharist because of the Pandemic. The references to the Eucharist in the Bible were discussed and it made us explore how much we didn't know existed about the Eucharist In the Bible. The questions presented in each class gave us more insight into how the Eucharist was found in the Bible.

The **Presence** sessions have done an excellent job in reinforcing our belief in the Eucharist being the source of our Catholic faith. That at Mass the Holy Eucharist is transformed into the body and blood of Our Lord, son of God, when the celebrant, reenacting the Last Supper, raises the host and says: "This is my Body"; and when he raises the chalice and says: "This is my Blood." The sessions cite numerous biblical passages including the words of Jesus: "I am the bread of life. Unless you eat the flesh of the son of man and drink his blood you have no life in you. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and I will raise him up on the last day." The Presence sessions drive home the point that, for us Catholics, transubstantiation does, indeed, mean the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. That's a very powerful reminder when we attend Mass. Thank you Savannah and Ellen for organizing these sessions and for allowing us to participate. Well done.

Thank you Savannah for stepping forward to facilitate this beautiful course, **Presence**. You both did an excellent job in presenting to the group. This is my second time taking this course, and I learned more about this sacrament of love, than I did the first time around. Tim Gray cites many biblical passages, including from "The Bread of Life Discourse", which reinforces, by Jesus' own words, that we are consuming the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, through transubstantiation. Tim Gray also pointed out the objections that Jews, Protestants, pagans and the secular society have in regards to this mystery, which was very interesting. This course was truly informative and worthwhile taking.

# god's plans for me cannot be altered

God had been calling me to Eucharistic Adoration for a while. I felt that daily life demands kept me from committing to an hour weekly for adoration. God always offers a way for you to become close to Him; mine came in the recommenda-

tion by a parishioner to become a substitute adorer. When I started adoration I filled the hour with reading, prayers and singing hymns in my head.

In March, I was temporarily laid off because of COVID-19 closings. A frustrating week followed thanks to my unemployment claim becoming a seemingly insurmountable problem.

Since "at risk" people were staying home, I was called to substitute for adoration more frequently. Perhaps, it was God giving me the opportunity to go to him with my concerns and find peace in his holy presence. My time off from work allowed me to cover more adoration hours and it became a great source of joy. Especially, since I felt lost without the weekly Mass. I missed being in church, my fellow parishioners and receiving communion. I began my adoration hour with some form of prayer and then just enjoyed God's presence. I laid my unemployment concerns in His capable hands. I was never afraid of infection nor death by COVID-19. I know that God's plans for me cannot be altered.

Without adoration, I would not have felt so much peace while everyone else seemed to be in despair and living in fear. Those extra hours of adoration taught me that, just being in God's presence, is enough. I gave up filling the hour with noise and allowed myself to just be comforted by Jesus present in the Eucharist. I learned that silence is an essential part of my prayer experience. You need time to hear God speak to your soul. What I feel in God's presence is ineffable. I am grateful that our church offers Eucharistic Adoration.



The Corona Virus has affected so many lives across the globe in so many different ways. Many people have been devastated by the effects through loss of family members and others by way of job loss, financial stress, loneliness, isolation and for many of us, a separation from the Lord in a way we never imagined, not being able to meet Him in the Eucharist. When we were unable to attend Mass because we hadn't signed up in time, I looked to see if St. Lawrence O'Toole required a sign up. Another blessing, no registration required to go to Mass! We came home a few weeks ago and haven't looked back once. We feel so welcome here and love seeing old friends and familiar faces. The sense of community here is unlike any around and in our time of need, we feel the love of God all around us.



Thank you to Fr. Rich and all of the hospitality committee members for making us feel so comfortable returning to a parish we moved away from 7 years ago.

Previous generations of Catholics built up the church we inherited... leave your legacy for the Catholics to come after us.




