Dear Friends,

The day couldn't have been any more beautiful. The pictures tell the story.

Last Sunday we held the first joint **Outdoor Mass** of our two parishes in the field at Sacred Heart. Parishioners from Patterson and Brewster afterward enjoyed a picnic lunch on a lovely summer day amid the newly landscaped grounds. We reflected together on the nearly 90 year history we share, from the day in 1934 the Hance family built a small chapel on their property and convinced Fr. Costello, then pastor of St. Lawrence, to use it as a mission chapel for the summer visitors to Putnam Lake. We've come a long way since then.



Looking ahead, we know that Jesus Christ is the way forward for every person and he is the answer to every fundamental human question. At St. Lawrence and Sacred Heart, we aren't here just to "hang on" in tough times or just preserve what we have. Our mission together envisions a future in which we bring Jesus to the people of Patterson and Brewster in new ways and make him the center of our lives.

We know this: only when Christ is the center of our personal lives and of our community does the culture change and people find peace of soul. Only then do we get to enter the Kingdom of Christ.

One way forward right now is the new outreach we do, hosting Masses outdoors in various neighborhoods of Brewster and Patterson – bringing Jesus to his people. We're excited to get this going September 13. Check the website for information on what is coming Sunday afternoons in September and in October.

No doubt we're living in "hard times" – vocations are down at crisis levels, parishes are closing and merging, people are drifting from the practice of the faith, and behavior that not long ago we all knew to be seriously wrong and sinful is accepted. We know the Gospel is true and that Jesus is the "Way, the Truth, and the Life". We know how this whole story ends – with Christ victorious. In the meantime, we will preach his Gospel and his Holy Spirit will guide our parishes in the way forward. Together.



into the breach

As a parishioner at St. John's in Pawling who regularly leads music at different churches throughout the Archdiocese, I love telling people about how rockin' life is at St. Lawrence and Sacred Heart. That's right – for you folks reading this bulletin, did you know your parish is amazing? Let me tell you why I love bragging about this place.

Last week, I had the chance to join your parish's staff and senior leadership for two days of prayer where we asked the Holy Spirit what the Lord wants for this parish. I was impressed with everyone's love and dedication for the parish, and their awareness of the crisis facing the greater Church these days, namely, that what worked for previous generations may not have really worked at all. The staff agreed that COVID-19 is a great opportunity to break from the pre-pandemic normal and search for what God is doing in our midst. I think your parish realizes that simply saying "This is the way we've always done it" or "This is how it was when I was growing up" is not good enough. Your parish staff knows you deserve their best and is willing to do what it takes to make disciples for the kingdom.

Our friend Fr. Joe Espaillat from the Bronx spent one morning

with us to shake us up, reminding us of Pope Benedict's words that being a Christian is not about an idea, but is about an encounter and a relationship with the person of Jesus Christ. Fr. Espaillat then asked us to take a good look at our egos and check them at



the door. This challenged me to ask myself: what am I doing to reach people? How am I reaching out in faith, breaking cover, and exposing myself to the rejection that often comes in inviting others to find in Christ the answers and meaning they struggle to find elsewhere? The Lord tells the prophet Ezekiel, "I sought a man who should build up the wall and stand in the breach" (Ez. 22:30). I needed that call to battle! The only reason I'm writing this reflection is because someone had the consistent courage 20 years ago to face my cynicism, sarcasm, and pessimism and invite me to a Eucharistic adoration event where I came face to face with a God who I realized loved me in my teenage brokenness, pain, and anger. That encounter began a lifelong adventure with a truly amazing God; a God who Fr. Espaillat reminded us did not suffer and die so we could remain as we are, but who died to offer us life to the fullest (Jn. 10:10)!


