Dear Friends,

Eleven years ago, Fr. McKeon initiated an adventure to establish daytime Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, convinced that the more devotion we had to the heart of our faith – the Real Presence of Jesus – the more our parish would grow in holiness and fruitfulness.

When we did the renovation of the parish for the Centennial in 2015, one of my priorities was to build a **Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel** so that adoration could be extended around the clock, seven days a week. This is known as Perpetual Adoration. Located in the new wing of the Church to the right side of the altar, the adoration chapel is beautiful and elegant.



I am delighted that this past Sunday, five years after it opened, we reached our goal of at least one person in adoration for every single hour of the week, day and night.

This is a huge achievement for our parish – every moment of the day a member of our parish is before the Blessed Sacrament giving praise to Jesus Christ for all his love and sacrifice, and interceding for the rest of us.

This goes on throughout the night (after hours when the doors are locked, only adorers with an access code can enter), seven days a week.

The song of praise that goes up to God hour after hour without end will have a powerful effect on our parish:

- It will increase our love for Jesus in Holy Communion and deepen our spiritual lives;
- We will win the graces our family and friends need to return to God and to the Church;
- It will draw back the lost and the sinners to Our Lord and win us all forgiveness for our sins;
- It will increase vocations to the priesthood and religious life;
- It will teach our young people what is essential and distinctive about our Catholic faith.

If you haven't got your own hour of adoration, contact the adoration committee for your own time to spend with Our Eucharistic Lord. If you can just drop in occasionally, I encourage you to do so. You will be touched by the power of this Sacrament and you will never be the same.

On Saturday, a global Prayer Rally for our Nation was held in front of the Putnam County Courthouse, led by Reverend Andrew Columbia, Pastor of the Carmel Baptist Church. The Reverend began with

a prayer for "the church", regardless of denomination. The stage was set for unity which is very much lacking in our nation and across the world. Several church leaders were present along with residents of the community.

Twelve leaders each led a prayer for the respect for the sanctity of human life and to return to and deepen their faith in God. Fr. Rich led a prayer for the unborn reminding us it is our job to protect those who cannot protect



themselves and to act as stewards. As each leader spoke on the steps of the courthouse, draped in red, white and blue, I reflected on how great our nation began and how much it has declined. I reflected on the words "with liberty and justice for all" written into our Pledge of Allegiance.

The leaders spoke with conviction and passion. The words that struck a chord in my heart were "thy Will be done, on earth as it is in heaven", spoken in the Lord's prayer. I realized the great gap that lies between heaven and earth. One of the leaders reminded us that when you close your door to God, you leave it open for his opponent. God does not move, we do.



The call for prayer was a call to God to give us strength, to remind us to love like God and forgive like God and to kneel not in protest but only to the one who created us. The prayer rally on Saturday was a reminder of not just how important prayer is in our lives but an even stronger reminder that our choices reflect the world we are leaving to our children.





Previous generations of Catholics built up the church we inherited... leave your legacy for the Catholics to come after us.




