

# who do you say that i am?

On Saturday, November 7, I attended a day retreat at St. Lawrence O'Toole. It revolved around Matthew 16, when Jesus asked his disciples "Who do people say the Son of Man is" and the disciples answer John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah or one of the prophets. Jesus asks "Who Do you Think That I am? Simon Peter responds "You are the Messiah, the Son of the Living God". Jesus responds, "Blessed are you, Simon Son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by flesh and blood, but by my Father in heaven".

In the past, the retreats I have attended include table discussions. I enjoy and benefit hearing how scripture speaks differently to each of us. This retreat was different. It was very personal. You reflected on your personal relationship with Jesus and the importance of holding onto your faith. It was all about Jesus and me that day. I embraced it. The structure of the retreat was such that I felt as though I was walking alongside Jesus during his journey, right to the foot of the cross. I could not help but dig deep and hear what was in Jesus' heart and in mine.

We have had a tough year and there are difficult times ahead. I think this year especially we learned to hold unto our faith a bit tighter and to trust in the Lord a bit deeper. I want to keep that thought and build on that relationship. This retreat reminded me of Who Jesus is and how much I want that personal relationship that will lead me home to him.




## **FOUR WAYS TO HELP:**


Keep this Bible verse close at hand when you have difficulty being thankful to God in difficult situations.



Series 2: Obedience #1 – Good is Not Good Enough

You may be surprised to hear that Jesus never told us to be good. He instructs us to be obedient. That is a consistent message over

and over in the Gospels, and the Epistles, as well as the Old Testament. Interesting, considering that today's culture has shed obedience in exchange for personal independence and the "right" to do whatever we want.

Let's consider the word "good." What is your definition?

In Luke 18:18-19: Jesus responds to an official's question by saying: "Why do you call me good? No one is good but God

alone." Then in Matthew 5:48 He teaches: "So be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect."

Seems to me that God has a much higher bar on the definition of "good" than we do, right? We throw that word around so freely that it has become meaningless. We all defend people by claiming that they are "good people" even though they may not go to Church regularly or follow Christ's teachings or even believe in God at all, because they are perhaps kind to others or generous with their time or money. But are they good like our Heavenly Father is good? How is that possible if they don't know Him and haven't chosen to be obedient to his teachings? We are fooling ourselves if we accept that our mundane and inconsistent definition of good is a standard to live by.

Obedience is mistakenly viewed as a position of weakness, when in reality it is empowering. If we follow God's ordinances, we know we will ultimately be happy in this world and obedience may be God's biggest factor for determining who wants to spend eternity with Him in heaven.

So, if we are going to follow The Way to Jesus and become his disciple, we have to accept that obedience is essential and good is not good enough.

**Scripture**: Read Matthew 5:43-48. What is it saying to you?

**Call to Action**: Pray asking Jesus to reveal one way that you can be more like the Father and to give you the grace to make the change.


