Healing was an integral part of Jesus' ministry. People responded to his compassion by having faith and renouncing sin. The paralytic's restoration is an example. Jesus said to the paralytic, "Your sins are forgiven" and the paralytic rose and walked.

On November 17 at 12 noon, Fr. Richard Gill officiated the Healing Mass with nearly 60 people in attendence. We live in a broken world and we need healing and our faith now more than ever. I need to keep my focus on my spiritual life so as not to lose my footing. I remember the perfect world God gave us in Eden and how we lost it and what it cost.

As Fr. Rich placed his hands on the heads of parishioners and prayed over them, I knew God was working through Fr. Rich. He also anointed my hands with oil while making the sign of the cross and then I thought immediately of Jesus' crucifixion. There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for another (John 15:13). Returning to my seat, I reflected on all he has given me – my life, blessings, forgiveness and his ultimate sacrifice. I attended the Mass to take in my heart those who are struggling and could not attend especially my cousin with brain cancer and Mike Brady. The Healing Mass was a beautiful reminder of God's love for us and how we must respond in return.

When we are living in times of darkness, we respond by carrying the light of Christ.

Other good things I thank you for:

- Sacred Heart is coming along beautifully with its **Parish Improvement Program**, with over 83% of the goal raised. The parish also surpassed its goal for the Cardinal's Annual Appeal ten years in a row! Not bad for a pandemic year!
- We've navigated nicely the transition to online religious education thanks to an awesome and generous staff ready to do whatever it takes. It's not the same as in person, but we'll get back to that when everyone feels safe.
- Many parishes around us are reporting they are on the brink of a financial crisis. But your financial support of the parishes has been steady, loyal and generous all throughout a difficult year and I am grateful to you. It's a sign of how much you love St. Lawrence and Sacred Heart.

Christmas, and a New Year of hope are coming. "O come, O come, Emmanuel!"



# pope reveals 3-word prayer that "gets God's attention"

Keep this Bible verse close by. It's an act of confidence that invites Our Lord to act.

The gospel message of Mk 1:40-45 recounts the story of the leper who approached Jesus with a simple prayer: "Lord, if you will, you can make me clean." Pope Francis, in a homily at Casa Santa Marta, said this prayer, which is an act of trust, is a prayer that "gets

God's attention." "It is a challenge," the Holy Father reflected, "but also an act of confidence: I know that He can do it, and so I entrust myself to Him." The leper, he explained, made this prayer because he had seen that Jesus acted with compassion.

Compassion involves itself. It comes from the heart and gets involved, and it leads you to do something. Compassion is "suffering with," taking the suffering of another person upon yourself in order to resolve it, to heal it. And this was the mission of Jesus. Jesus did not come to preach

the law and then leave. Jesus came in compassion, that is, to suffer with and for us and to give us life itself. The love of Jesus is so great that compassion led Him precisely to the Cross, to give His life.

Francis suggested that we often repeat this little prayer — "if you will" — throughout the day, because Jesus is a God of compassion, who involves himself in our sorrows, in the problems of others.

"Lord, if you will, you can heal me; if you will, you can forgive me; if you will, you can help me." Or, if you want, [you can make it] a little longer: "Lord, I am a sinner, have mercy on me, have compassion on me." A simple prayer that can be said many times a day. "Lord, I, a sinner, ask you: have mercy on me." Many times a day, inwardly, from the heart, without saying it out loud: "Lord, if you will, you can; if you will, you can. Have compassion on me." Repeat this.

The leper, with his simple and "miraculous" prayer, was able to obtain healing thanks to the compassion of Jesus, who loves us despite our sinfulness, the pope reflected.

Jesus is not ashamed of us. "O Father, I am a sinner, how can I say this?..." [That's even] better! For He came precisely for us sinners, and the greater a sinner you are, the closer the Lord is to you, for He has come for you, the greatest sinner; for me, the greatest sinner; for all of us. Let us make a habit of repeating this prayer, always: "Lord, if you will, you can do it. If you will, you can do it," with confidence that the Lord is close to us; and with His compassion, He will take upon Himself our problems, our sins, our inner diseases, everything.



The Way Series 2: Obedience #2 – Worth the Risk?

I was once told by a car salesman that I was a spirited driver. He was endorsing the car's pick-up during a test drive, but I have internal-

ized it as a commentary on my nature. Driving on the open road, I think, "How fast can I go and not get a ticket?" If the speed limit is 65, I convince myself that no police officer would stop me for driving 69. Other times, I set cruise control on 72, confident that I am within an acceptable cushion. Still other times, with drivers whizzing past me at 80 or more, I think, "If they can drive that fast, I should be able to go 75!"

I think we all push the laws of the road at times and I bet we all push God's laws too. We know the rules; they have been clearly explained and are commonly posted with bold signage, yet we still think we should be able to get away with breaking them. We talk ourselves into our own explanations on why my infraction is minimal or meaningless.

Is that God's perspective? I don't think so. I think God gave us laws, gave us prophets and teachers to explain them, and then expects us to embrace and obey them out of love and respect for Him.

The rules of the road are essential for keeping us safe, but those were determined by lawmakers whom we have no personal relationship with. Following God's laws are different. They have been imparted to us out of love and when we follow Jesus as a disciple we want to please Him, to follow his laws for both our own good and out of respect for our God, our creator and redeemer.

Honestly, I have to admit that I deserve a speeding ticket when I drive 69 and I deserve God's punishment for minimal infractions too. What do those punishments look like? I don't know, but is it worth the risk?
