

Virtue – Justice: Economic Justice

The virtue of justice has many spokes maintaining its balance and scope. When any of

them: social, commutative (reciprocal), or religion are damaged or weakened the entire wheel is compromised.

As we dig deeper, we recognize that commutative justice owns several of the spokes in the wheel. In addition to interpersonal relationships, commutative justice addresses ownership, debt, and borrowing; topics that are prominent in our society today. It bids us, to avoid theft by individuals, but also sellers and manufacturers. Businesses are obliged to avoid defrauding people.

Injustice seems to reign: spam phone calls and emails, false advertising, fine print consumer policies... Those of us in business need to take heed, but all of us, when we find honest retailers, need to reward them with our business. They may not be the cheapest, because they may be paying their employees an honest wage, paying their taxes and paying their suppliers for quality merchandise. Let's enhance God's Kingdom to support businesses that display the virtue of justice and avoid the ones who do not.

Justice requires us to pay our debts and to return borrowed goods in good condition. Our nation's borrowing and debt is so out of control that it is incomprehensible to most of us. Astronomical college loan and credit card debt and inflated mortgages have led to financial instability for millions. Justice is violated on both sides of these financial equations: bankers burdening people with loans they can't repay and people borrowing irresponsibly.

Defrauding persons of their money and belongings can have long-term ramifications on their health and wellbeing. The way to eliminating injustice in business and finance starts with us: by shopping and investing in honest businesses and handling our borrowing and lending with this virtue in mind.

Scripture: Proverbs 24:23-25. What's God saying to you?

Call to Action: Analyze your buying, selling, borrowing, and lending through the lens of Justice and see what changes you should make.

Dear Friends,

Three weeks till Easter – where did Lent go? Well, there's still time to get back to those good resolutions and sacrifices you promised to do.

Let's all remember the **key parts of Lent**: **prayer**, **fasting**, **almsgiving** for the forgiveness of our sins and those of others. We should especially be concerned for those around us who are not in a good place right now with the Lord, and be offering our sacrifices for them too.

First of all, **PRAYER**. Every Monday in Lent at 7:00 pm we have the Seasons of Praise Holy Hour. It's an awesome way to get close to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Tomorrow, the 15th Fr. Tom Berg will be giving the talk at 7:00 pm, so join us. Next week is Fr. Joe Espaillat from St. Anthony of Padua. And remember there is Confession every Monday from 4:00 to 8:30 and every Friday from 4:00 to 7:00.

FASTING: This is a great spiritual practice that has largely been forgotten because the Church has made it largely voluntary and optional. But combined with daily prayer, it is a spiritual practice going back all the way to the Old Testament that purifies the soul and detaches us from our impulses and disordered desires. It can be as simple as skipping one meal a day, or cutting out snacks or going 24 hours. Do it and see the spiritual fruits!

ALMSGIVING: An old word for the practice of sacrificial giving to the poor. Many people drop something in the poor box every time they stop into the Church. Others give a gift to Brewster Cares Homeless Shelter that houses an average of a dozen local homeless every day. This month we're trying to help our sister parish – St. Anthony of Padua in the Bronx fix it's roof with \$14,000. St. Anthony's is in a really poor section of the Bronx and is barely scraping by. They never have money for this kind of repair. We're bringing up families from St. Anthony's on Easter Sunday, and sending them back with food, clothing and support for their local homeless too. We need financial help and volunteers – whatever you can do will be so appreciated.

ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA ROOF:

The sacristy dates back before 1927 and its skylights are deteriorating badly. Tarps are being used to cover them and keep rain and snow from seeping in and damaging the ceiling as has happened several times already.

The roof drains clog up regularly and back up - requiring constant maintenance to prevent more flooding inside the Church as has happened over the years. Each time it floods it requires costly repairs in replastering and repainting. St. Anthony's is looking for a permanent solution and the estimate for full repair is

\$14,000. St. Lawrence and Sacred Heart charity fund is committing to cover the cost of these repairs for our sister parish.

On March 6, St Lawrence and Sacred Heart launched the Missionary Rosary Ministry with a retreat led by Ania Szurowski. Twenty-three women joined together for prayer, Adoration, food and companionship with a goal to serve. At the heart of this day was Our Lady, Mother Mary. 


