

Passion - Waiting in the Tomb



A wise woman once advised me to think carefully before asking God for patience. She explained that He teaches patience by providing us with endurance-building life experiences. But we see that God Himself is very patient and no doubt his plan for us is to resemble his likeness.

Look how long God waited from the Fall of Adam and Eve until He sent Jesus to redeem us. In those thousands of years, He began to spoon-feed chosen people, teaching them his ways. Over and over his beloved creatures would fail, and over and over He would modify his plan, presenting it in a different way, like we do with our young children when they cannot understand long division.

Now, in the Easter season, I am thinking about Jesus' patience throughout his ministry, Passion, and Resurrection. The Gospels relate Jesus' untiring dialogs with the apostles, Pharisees, and many others. He even exhibited astonishing restraint when responding to Pontius Pilate.

However, the ultimate witness to Jesus' patience could be the three days his body lay in the tomb. Why did Jesus wait for three days to resurrect? Why not come back to life Friday night or Saturday morning and get back to his ministry work sooner? Why lie in wait in a cold, dark cave when He could be comforting his loved ones who were crying and grieving? A good question for Heaven's Inquiry List, but it was undoubtedly the Father's plan and it demanded patience on Jesus' part.

So often, we can feel like we are in a tomb waiting for the rock to roll away and sunshine to pour into our lives, for our own resurrection from the disappointments and challenges of this sinful world. When the wait seems unbearable and there appears to be no way out of the dark, dank tomb, think of Jesus, the King of the Universe, waiting for his time to come, trusting in the glory that comes when we follow the Father's Way.

Scripture: Read Luke 23:50-56. Put yourself in this scene.

Call to Action: Meditate on how Jesus might have felt during his time in the tomb.

I want to express a sincere "thank you" to all our parishioners – it's been a tough year with sickness and death touching so many families. But you have been prayerful and faithful since the lockdowns, at first following Mass online and then gradually coming back in person. We've been able to keep our **religious education programs and RCIA** going and next month we'll have **First Communions and Confirmations** as scheduled. We've got Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament around the clock, seven days a week. And I am so impressed to see everyone "staying calm and carrying on" as the expression goes.

We've managed to keep up with our payments on our **Centennial Renovation** loan and we're scheduled to pay off the balance (now at \$495,000) in just a few short years. At Sacred Heart the **Parish Improvement Program** is helping to renew the buildings and the campus. Your support of our **Mega Raffle** helps us fund our unique **Family Religious Education Program**. We've sponsored our "**Brewster Cares**" nonprofit to help the poor and homeless locally, and we've given steady support to our sister parish in the South Bronx, **St. Anthony of Padua**. At both parishes we're working to beautify the grounds this Spring season.

It's so easy to be the pastor of parishes that have lots of faith. I'm very proud of our two parishes and all of you.

We've got a lot planned in the coming months including the **Retreat of the Holy Spirit** May 15 in two languages, as well a joint **Outdoor Mass June 13** at Sacred Heart for its feast day, and to bless the new monument for the original chapel and the outdoor Stations of the Cross. We'll be having our **150th Anniversary Gala** for the founding church of St. Lawrence October 16, and then host **Cardinal Dolan** for that anniversary October 24.

Thank you for being great parishioners and drawing others you love closer to Jesus. That's what we're all here to do.

homework help

Beginning this past spring, Brewster Cares began a new program in the community called Homework Help.

This volunteer-based community outreach for English as New Language (ENL) Learners in the Putnam County area allows interested students in

Pre-K through 5th grade the opportunity to sign up for tutoring sessions offered three days a week at different times. Tutors consisting of middle school and high school students as well as adults, schedule times when they are available to meet with students one-on-one to help them with missed and late assignments, as well as their homework. Students and tutors meet at St. Lawrence O'Toole's Parish Center where a quiet area is set up to facilitate learning.



Homework Help has over twenty-two students and over fifty available tutors that meet regularly to work with one another. What's special about the program is that tutors and students are matched to help build rapport and develop a closer relationship with one another. Laughter is often heard during the sessions as students eagerly work on assignments while developing warm friendships. A win-win for everyone, students boost learning skills while many of the highschool tutors receive community service hours for their highschool requirements.

Of course teachers love the idea of the program as well. Karen Barke, a kindergarten teacher at JFK Elementary School in Brewster has a student in the program who works with his tutor Kaitlyn McCarvil three times a week. "She loves working with my student, and they have been working on an alphabet book that he reads to our class every time he works on it. It's been helping him a lot. He is more interested in school now and is

seeing himself as a student. The alphabet book seems so minor, but everytime he does something in it he can't wait to show the class."




