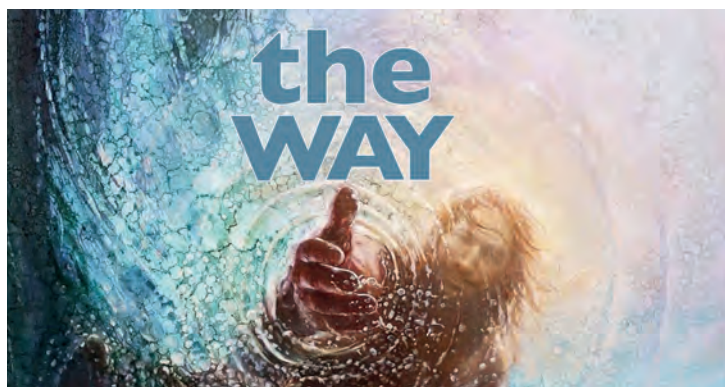

Mary's Mysteries – Precious Moments

As with all mothers, I would expect that Mary's memory of her child's birth has to be one of her most precious. It was 2021 earthly years ago, but probably seems like only yesterday. Those private, quiet moments in the cave holding her newborn son, watching Him sleep,

counting his toes, adjusting to being a mother. Sound relatable?

I am sure there are endless endearing moments of hers that were never recorded: the first time Jesus rolled over, crawled, took his first steps. The first time He called her Eema (mama),

lost his first tooth, memorized his first prayer. All mothers hold these memories dear.

She endured small sorrows when Jesus skinned his knee and was misunderstood by his classmates. Bigger sorrows when He left her to start his ministry and was threatened by townspeople in their synagogue. Then she had immense sorrows when his destiny led Him in a direction she could not control or understand.

Reflecting on the fullness of Mary's life helps us to humanize our Blessed Mother, to remember that she was a woman first, an earthly mother that had the feelings and emotions and experiences of mothers today. A woman that didn't have all the answers or know the future, but grew in knowledge and understanding as each day passed, just as we do. She understands us, and shares in the joys, fears, triumphs, and sorrows that we keep in our hearts.

Mary is relatable to all mothers in both our joys and our sorrows if we allow it. We can mistakenly focus on the differences, but we are more like her than we are different. Mary, Jesus' first disciple, has been there, done that, and can show us the way; and by following her way, we are following the way of her Son.

Scripture: Read Luke 2:51. Imagine some of the memories Mary kept in her heart.

zooming to the EDGE!

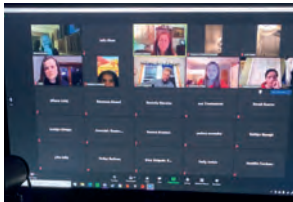

I've been a catechist for MANY years; first for our younger children; now several years with our middle school children. First of all, I find the EDGE middle school ministry to be invigorating and engaging. It truly strives to provide a real life Catholic faith community experience for our children. It relates to our

middle schoolers as they explore who they are as people and as Catholics. And honestly, I always find myself learning and growing more; finding the peace and joy as my heart continues to open to God. (And I always thought I was so faithful before being a catechist!)

Spending time with our youth in person during EDGE nights created connections of faith that I cherish. ZOOM now is our gathering site. I was unsure. It was an adjustment, but surprisingly just as fulfilling. was particularly happy to be able to join XLT Adoration Friday night live streams with our youth, who like me, were unable to attend in person. Brief chat comments were reflective; we felt our closeness to God in the presence of Jesus. I felt so connect-

ed to everyone and our faith! I am oh so very grateful to be able to spend time in prayer, in faith with our youth whether in person or zooming...

Ever think about being a catechist? This is such a joyful way to grow closer to God and to help our children grow in faith as well... Remember, all are welcome here.

I realize sometimes it only takes a moment, a split second, some courage to say "yes" and a commitment to something unknown, and our lives can change for the better. That's what happened to me when I was asked to help volunteer with the EDGE program. I was hesitant to commit and had a lot of "good"

reasons to decline. With a great deal of doubt I accepted this challenge and I have never once regretted it. Initially, I was expecting to help the teens understand the concepts taught during EDGE classes and bring them closer to God. Soon, I found out, it was I who was truly learning too. Through all the years of my Religious Education classes, which I took diligently for several years, I learned very little in comparison to what I learned this year helping the teens to deepen their faith and knowledge. Each week when preparing for the EDGE class, I became aware of my limited knowledge of the foundations of our faith and realized I needed to learn. It was difficult at first, but it was all worth it and deeply rewarding. During one of the initial sessions I had with my Edge members, I was encouraged and assured that with God's grace and putting all my worries into God's hands I would be able to take on this challenge. (*"Do not fear: I am with you; do not be anxious: I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my victorious right hand."* Isaiah 41:10).

Reflecting back on this year I can say without any hesitation, this was one of the most rewarding experiences. Not only did it feel good to give my time, but I was part of our church community, and it was also good to know that I helped the teens as I deepened my own faith. I encourage all of you to take part in this wonderful journey.
