Mary's Mysteries — One Heart

Another of Mary's Mysteries, which could be interpreted as both Joyful and Sorrowful, is Jesus' Presentation in the Temple. Naturally, it was joyful for the young parents to bring their baby to their most holy place and participate in a sacred ritual that was so meaningful to

their faith and culture. Like the joy we feel when we bring our babies to church to be baptized. But what young mother would want an old man, who is clearly a prophet, to tell her that a sword will pierce her heart? I am the mother of two grown sons. No prophet spoke to me at my first-born's baptism to tell me that a sword would pierce my heart, but I still feel I can claim Simeon's prophesy as my own. I am sure most other mothers can as well.

As we reflect on a mother's heart, we recognize that it is intimately connected to the heart of her child. In the womb, their proximity can be measured in inches, but as the child grows and experiences the world outside, no matter how far they travel, mothers stay intimately connected to their children through their hearts. It is a supernatural bond.

When my sons are sick, mistreated, or misunderstood, I feel it as a sword in my heart. If ordinary mothers feel this connection, imagine the attachment between Mary and Jesus. Imagine all the piercings she accumulated during her earthly life as his mother. This prophesy must have climaxed at the foot of the Cross as she watched the centurion thrust his sword into Jesus' heart. I am convinced that she felt that sword as fully as if it had been thrust into her own.

It is clear, Jesus' and Mary's hearts are still one. As she works to bring all of humanity to her Son, she invites us to enter Jesus' heart by way of her own. As our mother, her heart is connected to ours. Let us strive to comfort her heart rather than pierce it.

Scripture: Read Luke 2:33-35. What is your heart telling you? **Call to Action**: Become conscious of how your thoughts and actions impact Mary's heart.

Our faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is also the reason we have the awesome **Solemnity of Corpus Christi** (Body of Christ) on **June 6.** We make the great procession through the streets of the Village of Brewster, from the train station up to the Church that day. We want to celebrate in public that the Lord is among us and walk with him at our side through our daily lives and struggles, trusting that he "**is with us all days**." Be sure to join us on Sunday, June 6 at 3:45 pm.

Learning Religion through Zoom taught us many things. One of them is how hard it is to differentiate your right-hand side from your left-hand side, especially if you are 7 or 8 years old.

During our First Communion rehearsals, we kept on practicing and repeating that the right-hand side was going to be working hard during our First Communion. The right-hand side was in charge of pulling our mask down, reaching out and asking for the host, bringing the host to our mouth, making the sign of the cross, pulling our masks back up, and finally going back onto prayer hands position...Phewww....What a big day for our right-hand side!

And you know what? Our 76 children receiving communion had trouble using their hands because they have only been using them for about a decade. Aside from things like walking instead of running or skipping down the aisle, or finding their pews back after receiving communion, they had no trouble accepting that Jesus himself was waiting for them in the Eucharist. These little people, as little and cute as they are (Let's admit, they were so cute dressed up in their First Communion outfits!) believed with all the might of their young hearts that they were wanted, loved and accepted by Jesus Christ.

Lesson after lesson, their questions, their facial and non-verbal expressions revealed to me and to the heavens that their souls were more than ready to encounter our Lord Jesus in the Eucharist. They had no doubts, regrets, second guessing, priority, crisis or laziness about coming to Mass and receiving our Lord. These children were just READY. I cannot tell you how many times I heard "Mrs. Cecilia, I have been waiting for this day for so long! "Mrs. Cecilia, I have been waiting for this day my whole life" I could see it, they were shaky, nervous, happy and scared! What a blessing to witness such innocent and pure desire to be united to Jesus.

I invite you today, as parents of the First Communicants of 2021: please bring your child every week to Mass, so they can consistently have their second communion, and third communion, and fourth communion...until they lose count. Until they no longer need to count, because no matter what, they know that Jesus is always first, and that mom and dad are their best advocates and allies in leading them to the Eucharist despite all other life commitments and priorities.

Finally, parents, thank you for saying 'yes' to our Family Program against all odds during this year of COVID. Thank you for your commitment and your witness of faith.
