It's Sacred Heart weekend!

Friday night we celebrated the **Feast of the Sacred Heart** at the parish and today, Sunday we'll hold the **Outdoor Mass and BBQ** for both parishes at Sacred
Heart, Patterson. Everyone is invited at **1:00 pm** and
there is food and games for the kids. Bring a lawn
chair and enjoy a fun afternoon with all our parishioners
from St. Lawrence and Sacred Heart.



As part of the celebration, we'll be blessing the two new monuments we put up as part of the **Sacred Heart Parish Improvement Program** – one monument marks the location of the original chapel built in 1934 by Spencer and Margaret Hance. And at the place they are buried nearby we put another monument to honor them for their generosity. Come along and joyfully celebrate our two-parish history.

As you may know, St. Lawrence got started in 1871 as a mission church of St. Joseph's which was then in Croton Falls. St. Joe's had been founded in 1845 as part of the Catholic expansion out from the city which followed the Harlem railroad line northwards. So this year St. Lawrence is celebrating 150 years, and we are kicking off our **Better than Ever** campaign now with Corpus Christi last weekend and Sacred Heart this weekend.

By 1934 the year-round population was growing and created a need for another dedicated church in Putnam Lake. Thanks to the generosity and hard work of the Hances, it came into being, and the pastor of St. Lawrence would send a priest each week for Mass. Unfortunately, that original little chapel of the Sacred Heart burned down in 1942, and the current church was built in 1955.

At the Mass this weekend, we'll humbly pray for all the many thousands of Catholics who came before us in Patterson and Brewster and made possible the Churches where we continue to celebrate the Sacraments day after day. They left us a great legacy of faith. And so on this weekend of the Sacred Heart, let's promise God that we will pass the torch of Faith on to our kids and our grandkids, so our Catholic Faith continues to thrive and flourish all over our area.

Thank you for living out your faith in practice every day. Thank you for your fidelity to God and his Church. Thank you for your active participation and your incredible generosity which enable our local parishes to continue to flourish. We are going to make them **Better than Ever**.

You know that when we touch something dirty, we get contaminated, right? But when Jesus touches something unclean or dirty, He doesn't get contaminated. Instead, His mere presence purifies and sanctifies objects and people.



Now, imagine Main Street. Brewster and all that happens there daily...honking, walking, talking, eating, coming and going trains, commerce, driving, traffic ticketing, you name it! These are ordinary things that happen daily in our town. However, last Sunday was no ordinary day. It was our great Corpus Christi procession!

Jesus was walking with over 200 of us on Main Street! We gave Him the best treatment we could: The Most Holy was transported under a beautiful tent, just like Moses did when transporting the Arch of the Covenant. Children dressed in their First Communion outfits lead the procession, just like

Angels who are now in front of the throne of God. The First Communicants tossed rose petals to create a carpeted red path for Jesus at every station along the way. Our seminarian Joseph, swung incense. The fragrant smoke rose in clouds to symbolize our prayers rising to eternal heaven.

All the ordinary everyday things of Main Street were touched by Jesus, by His presence in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. Jesus was pouring out His holiness onto us which sanctified our businesses, streets, train station, police, daily walking, honking, driving and eating.



The words and actions of individuals make an impact on the lives of others. Our history would not be complete without mention of several priests and parishioners who impacted our parish greatly, guiding us faithfully and zealously. **John and Mary Gilroy** were born in Ireland in 1839 and 1840, respectively. They arrived in America in 1858 and settled in Brewster. John worked at the railroad depot, and they had 13 children. They were blessed and we were provided for because of them.

Before 1871, there was no Catholic church in Brewster. John and Mary evangelized, opening the doors to their home on Eastview Avenue where Masses were said, and Baptisms held. The Stations of the Cross adorned their living room. The land records reflect they owned property on Eastview Avenue, Prospect Street and Main Street. They transferred their property on Prospect Street in order that a Catholic church could be constructed.

How proud John and Mary must have been as St. Lawrence was dedicated in 1871. John, who died in 1898, was very active in the parish. He was well known and respected. Where would we be without their vision? At Mary Gilroy's funeral in 1914, Fr. Phelan spoke, "It was largely due to them, that the little parish of St. Lawrence was established."

I am sure a Catholic church would eventually be built in Brewster. Yet, it was due to John and Mary Gilroy that St. Lawrence was in 1871. God places people in our lives for a purpose. We will forever be indebted to John and Mary Gilroy who looked beyond themselves and focused on above. They laid the first brick that became what we call home. They knew how important faith was. As a parish, we have been blessed multiple times over. Perhaps it is the Irish luck that John and Mary brought with them from Ireland, or perhaps simply, it is that God blesses those whose hearts are pure, for they will see God. John and Mary saw God and they wanted others to see God too.
