

# the world around brewster in 1871

Our original, small wooden church building dates from 1871-a huge step forward for the Brewster Catholics at that time. The population in the area had been growing especially since the establishment of the Harlem train line in the 1840s and the development of the mining companies. After the original Cathedral of St. Patrick on Mott St. in Manhattan in 1815, new parish churches began to spread throughout Manhattan and north into the upper counties, following the population growth of the times.

Our church was one of the early churches in the area and began as a mission outpost of St. Joseph's in Croton Falls, which had been established since 1845. St. Lawrence is older than St. John's in Mahopac (1889), St. Patrick's in Yorktown (1898), St. Mary's in Katonah (1908) and St. James in Carmel (1909). The year 1871 was just six years after the Civil War had ended, President Lincoln had been assassinated, and the country struggled through the difficult Reconstruction period. And the new St. Patrick's Cathedral would not be finished until 1879.

Meanwhile, the Catholic Church was in turmoil all over Europe. Democratic movements were replacing the old monarchies and aristocracies and the industrial revolution was upending the old order. Much good came from that but often it was dominated by a

scientific, relativistic spirit that was fiercely anti-religious and critical of tradition and faith. Marxism and socialism had made their debut as serious movements and threats to Catholicism. In Italy, the Holy See was losing the lands it had controlled for centuries due to a civil war aimed at unifying the country and weakening the power of the Pope.

Faced with the urgency of the situation, Pope Pius IX called the bishops of the world together for the First Vatican Council, to face the intellectual challenges of the day. Meeting in 1869-70 Vatican I became one of the most important Councils in Church history. Among the important doctrinal decisions handed down was the dogma of the infallibility of the pope. That is, when the pope speaks with his full authority as the successor of St. Peter and teaches definitively on a matter of faith and morals, he enjoys the guarantee of the Holy Spirit that he cannot err. This dogma was believed from the beginning but needed to be defined formally because of the challenges the Church was facing from its adversaries in Europe. It was perhaps the single most controversial dogma in centuries.

Meanwhile, in little Brewster, NY, those pioneer Catholics were cutting the wood they would transform into a local house of God in which the mysteries of the faith would be celebrated – now for 150 years, uninterrupted.
