Dear Friends,

Thanks to Frs. Joe, Art, and Tom filling in for me, I'm able to get away for a little break this week and next upstate and in the Berkshires. I'll be back over the weekend. I'm hoping everyone who is used to being cooped up so long with Covid will also get a little time away. And let's all pray Covid doesn't come back and affect too many people – we don't want a repeat of last year by any means.

This weekend we're running the **Midsummer Market** as a benefit for our **Brewster Cares** outreach for the poor. We'll have vendors and tag sale items available and whatever we make will go to the work we do for the poor and the homeless. Our **Golf Outing** on September 10 will also be a benefit for the homeless and we're having a fundraising luncheon at **Las Mañanitas** on Oct. 9 also for **Brewster Cares**.



Whatever you can do to help will be most welcome. Our focus on the local poor and on our sister parish in the South Bronx is a big part of our effort to put Jesus' teachings into practice in our lives. And it brings us together as Christians when we recognize Jesus in the faces of our poor and less fortunate brothers and sisters. Thanks to everyone who gives and who volunteers to help.

The most important benefit we receive when we give is we learn to trust God. Once we take care of our essential obligations, anything we give away is a step forward in turning it all over to God and putting our lives in his hands. To grow in holiness, we have to put our lives in his hands. That's why many spiritually mature people put their "tithes" to God first and live on the rest, trusting he will make sure they have what they need. It works – all the time.

Any donations dropped in our "**poor boxes**" goes to help these causes. In addition, you'll remember we eliminated most of the "second collections" for various missions and relief efforts and replaced it with a once-a-month "collection for missions and the poor." From what you donate in that collection, we support the different missionary efforts of the bishops and also our local poor. All that money is used 100% directly for the poor and for missionaries. Thank you for being so generous each month.

And I've noticed that the more we commit as a parish to help the poor and to our sister parish St. Anthony of Padua, the more God blesses us financially and in growing spiritually. God cannot be outdone in generosity.

When we pray, "Jesus, I trust in you," he definitely responds.

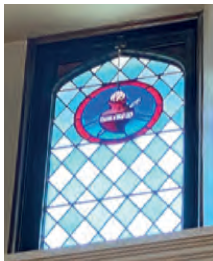
Clerestory Windows above stain glass windows in St. Lawrence O'Toole.

The clerestory is a high section of the wall that contains windows above eye level, for the purpose of admitting light, fresh air, or both. Jean Anthony shares more on the remaining windows in St. Lawrence O'Toole Church.

"We have 21 clerestory windows, plus the hidden window in the choir loft. Our clerestory windows, which tell us many things, are high above the figurative windows. Binoculars will certainly help! In each window, there is a **rondelle**, a circular design depicting one of the many symbols that tell the story of our faith. Look for the **Agnus Dei**, the heart pierced by a sword, the shell, or the pillar. For those who founded our parish, these symbols were easily recognized. The background glass of each window is formed by diamond-shaped pieces of glass. The windows with the designs in the background glass were from our original wooden church. The windows with the pale aqua and white background are new to our stone church.

"Most windows have a dedication - the name of a parishioner who donated it or the name of a person to be remembered. The clerestory window with the palms is a "Gift from Michael Enright." Many of these families are still with us. Without clerestory windows, the upper church would be dark, and we would not see the wooden members of the roof. Our roof is made to remind you of the Ark of Noah. The arc is the symbol of the Church which carries us to our heavenly home.



Our Rose Window

"The two largest windows in our church are the west-facing window in the choir loft and the Rose window on the east facing the sanctuary wall. The west window was recently installed during the 2014 renovations. This window has an image of the Holy Spirit in the center and the four evangelists placed around it. The original window was made of pale aquas and opaque white diamonds, like those in some of the clerestory windows. That large, simple window let in the evening light and was similar to windows that would be found in churches of Ireland where our patron saint, St. Lawrence O'Toole was born. The Rose window above the altar is a gothic style as found in France, where St. Lawrence died while on a peace mission. These two windows refer to his beginning and his end here on earth.

"The new choir loft window recaptures some much-treasured images that were on the wall behind the altar prior to the renovations. There were four icon-like paintings of the symbols of the four evangelists that were done on canvas and fixed to the wall in 1952. The Holy Spirit was at the center top of the wall casting light on the world beneath it (especially Ireland). That little nod to the Irish came from our former pastor, Msgr. Heaney."

We are blessed to be surrounded by the history of our faith and the many original windows from our little wooden church dedicated 150 years ago!

In the Ordinary – Bold Friendship

July 29th was the Feast Day of Saints Martha, Mary, and Lazarus, the siblings from Bethany that were good friends of Jesus. They appear in the Gospels in at least two significant places, teaching us important lessons. Mary and Lazarus

have mostly silent roles, but Martha always speaks out boldly to Jesus. Clearly, she was a close friend that wasn't afraid to demand help and compassion from Him.

In reading the Gospel for that day, John 11:19-27, I recognized an important parallel that I had never noticed before. Jesus came to Bethany because he had learned that Lazarus had died. Martha

went to meet Him and after a powerful dialogue with Jesus, she says these words, "Yes, Lord, I have come to believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world." Sound familiar?

When Jesus took his disciples to Caesarea Philippi and asked them, "Who do you say that I am?" Peter replied, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." Almost the same exact words as Martha. Yet to Peter, Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah. For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father." I believe that these are the only two people recorded in the Gospels to have made that proclamation and we can confidently acknowledge that Martha's words were revealed to her by the Father too.

Jesus' response to Martha is not recorded and chronologically Martha may have said it first. But Peter is asked to become the first leader of Christ's Church and we have no idea what Martha goes on to do. Most likely she continued to tend her house and serve others behind the scenes. I am sure that is not a slight to Martha. In fact, it elevates the value of her life's work of menial service to that of the Pope. Confirming that all of the work that God calls us to do is equally important in his Kingdom.

Scripture: Read John 11:1-27. Reflect on Martha's bold dialogue with Jesus.

Call to Action: Speak boldly to Jesus when you pray and trust that the Holy Spirit will inspire you to serve Him in the ordinary.

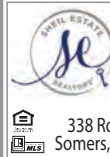
