And more will be coming, including the Cardinal's visit in November.

I've got to mention one unpleasant matter. A group led by an Irishwoman named Christine Gallagher, who claims she gets direct messages from Jesus and Mary, bought the Temple Beth-Elohim on Mt. Ebo Road when it closed last year. They plan to make it some kind of "House of Prayer" and it opened this week. I strongly recommend that no one gets involved in their center even though they will be doing some good things like the Rosary and Divine Mercy. It has not been approved by the Church. They have no permission from Cardinal Dolan. They feature some strange, extreme teachings – such as anyone who takes the Covid vaccine will go to hell. There is a lot of controversy over how she raises money by taking advantage of older people. They do not have permission for Mass or sacraments. Nor may they reserve the Blessed Sacrament in their building.

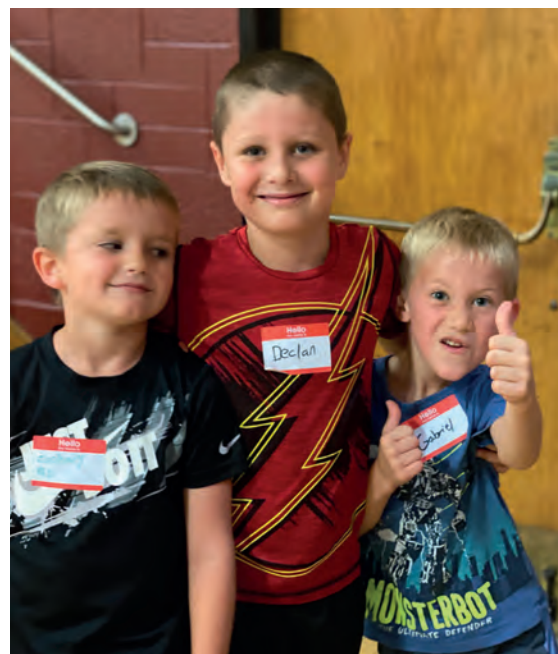

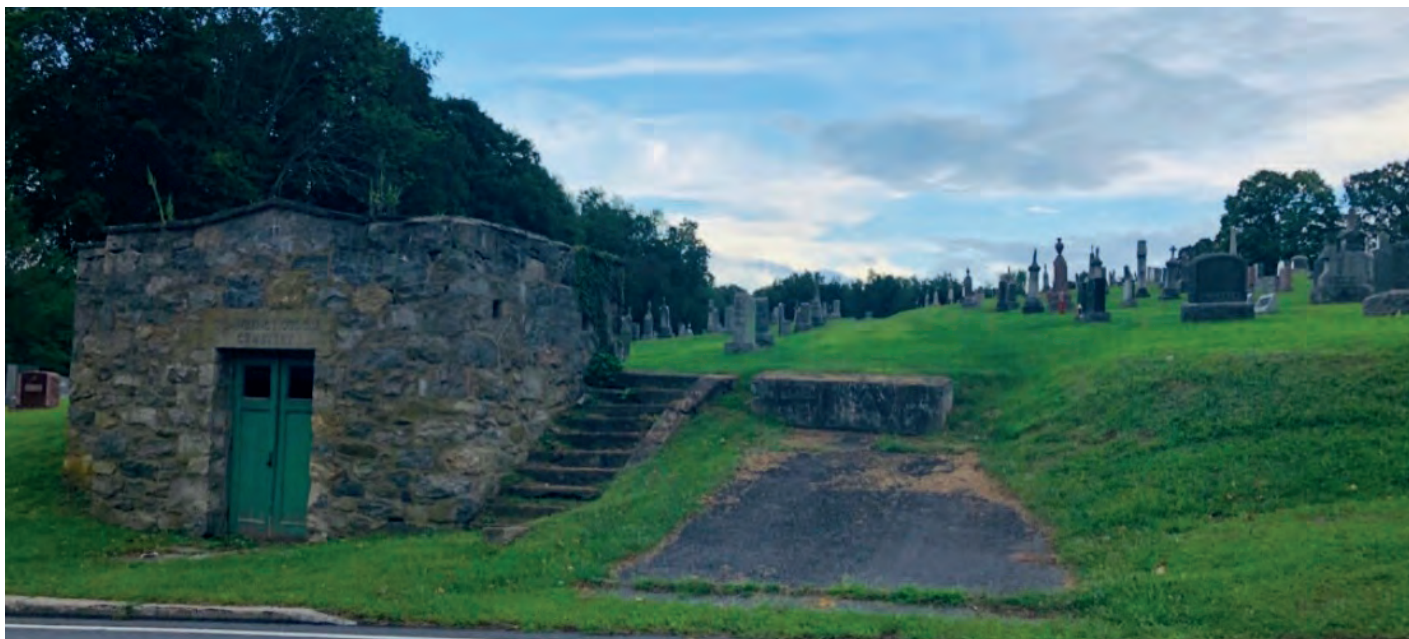

John May's gravestone

On July 19, 1873, our local newspaper reported, "The first funeral service ever held in the St. Lawrence Catholic Church, was conducted by Rev. Lawrence McKenna on Tuesday last, over the body of Mr. John May of Dyke-man's and the first interment in the new cemetery was on this occasion." John May died July 13, 1873, at age 55. On his gravestone is the

inscription: "A native of the parish at Dunard in Sligo, Ireland."

In 1871, there were no funeral homes or automobiles in Brewster. Most wakes were held in people's homes. The advertisement of Knox & Smith, the undertakers at Brewster, read: "All bodies preserved by the embalming process or by the use of ice, as desired. Horse-drawn carriages furnished for all funeral occasions." In 2014, David D. Bruen, our first County Executive and a parishioner of our parish, died. His Mass was celebrated at St. Lawrence, and he is buried in our cemetery. Perhaps as a nod to his ancestors and his love for

nature, he was transported by a horse-drawn carriage to the church.

There still exists a portion of the old road that led into St. Lawrence Cemetery. The road had a very steep incline, and great caution was taken entering and exiting that road. The entrance/exit is now on Turk Hill Road. Adjacent to the old road is a stone building, aged and covered with moss. The following words appear above its wooden, green doors: "St. Lawrence O'Toole Cemetery." The building is empty.

It was a winter holding vault for our deceased. Today, our cemetery has year-round grave openings due to modern technology that provides a backhoe to break through any frost/frozen ground. We are now able to respectfully and timely bury our loved ones.

The last 150 years have brought many changes - the disappearance of farms, the replacement of businesses, vacant buildings, and the passing of loved ones. Plans are in place for our village to undergo a transformation. St. Lawrence O'Toole Church has withstood the test of time. Once a small wooden structure built by a few early parishioners, it has been rebuilt and renovated physically and spiritually. We are very fortunate to have both a church and a cemetery that serve us well. I pray St. Lawrence and Sacred Heart continues to grow to celebrate many more anniversaries.

In the Ordinary—Good Fruit

Bishop Robert Barron is one of the great evangelists of our time. He applauds the powerful reach that social media has in our culture, but also witnesses the dangers that it presents to those of us who are not watchful.

He has excellent advice as to how we can differentiate the good from the bad on the internet.

Bishop Barron quotes Galatians Chapter 5 where St. Paul teaches about the Fruits of the Holy Spirit versus the Works of the Flesh. Just as we can distinguish good people and bad by their fruits, the same strategies can be applied to recognizing

positive and negative cyberspaces that are created and administered by people. The positive Fruits are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. If you go to a site and see those qualities exhibited, there is a good chance that the Holy Spirit is operative there.

In contrast, the Works of the Flesh are immorality, impurity, licentiousness, idolatry, sorcery, hatreds, rivalry, jealousy, outbursts of fury, acts of selfishness, dissensions, factions, occasions of envy, drinking bouts, orgies, and the like. Those are the Marks of the Dark Spirit. If websites exhibit those characteristics, it is indicative of darker spirits at work. Bishop Barron also teaches that the devil has two names in the New Testament, "The Scatterer" and "The Accuser." If we look at a website with a lot of dividing and accusing, we know what kind of spirit is behind it.

Jesus' teaching on this is recorded in Luke: "A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit... the good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good, but an evil person out of a store of evil produces evil." As disciples we should use every opportunity to consume and bear only good fruit.

Scripture: Read Luke 6:43-45. Reflect on the good and rotten fruits around you.

Call to Action: Watch Bishop Barron's Youtube video entitled: "Catholics, Media Mobs, and the Culture of Contempt" to learn more about being a responsible Catholic on the internet.
