Dear Friends,

First of all, thank you for your continuing generosity to the poor! Our second collection once a month (usually on the third Sunday) for missions and the poor, and the money collected in our poor boxes goes to help efforts of the Church to fund missionary work and charity work for the poor in different places. This month I noticed we had some extra, and so we sent \$5,000 to our sister parish in the South Bronx and its pastor, Fr. Joe Espaillat. He's in a dangerous neighborhood and needed help in changing all the locks to the rectory and Church to keep things safe. Thanks to you, we were able to help him protect his parish.

I'm really excited about a **new ministry of intercessory and healing prayer** we are hoping to get off the ground at our parishes. It was Fr. Joe who recommended Tori Harris – a young mom who has done a lot of work in this area, and even wrote a book on how to make it work in parishes. So she's coming to St. Lawrence to give a workshop on how to pray with others and intercede for them in whatever they need: health, healing, reconciliation, trust, renewal. We want to train a group of parishioners who are prayerful and deeply committed to helping those who are suffering and struggling. Give it some thought – maybe God is inviting you to be a prayer warrior for others. The **HOLY SPIRIT 101 worksho**p is September 17 and 18. More information elsewhere in the bulletin...

And we never stop thinking about those among us who have drifted away for various reasons and for those who are struggling with faith. These days those folks are all around us – in our families, at work, among our neighbors. To find Jesus again, they need our help... but how do we do it?

Alpha is a great, low-pressure, free and fun way to re-introduce people to Jesus. It's just a meal together, a video that talks about the basics of faith, and a discussion where no one is judged and no questions are bad questions. It's just about exploring faith and loving each other. We let the Holy Spirit do the rest.

I bet you know some people who could use Alpha and maybe the Holy Spirit will lead them back to Jesus, with a little encouragement from you. The best way is to bring them along with you – Alpha is for everyone and helps everyone get a little closer to God. We start up next month, with different sessions... in Spanish and in English. Stay tuned for details!

spanish consecration to st. joseph

I was very excited to offer the Consecration to St. Joseph program to our Spanish-speaking community this summer. We had our closing consecration ceremony on Tuesday, August 17 and it was a big success!

I was thrilled that we had 40 attendees and many of them were couples! As I was planning for the program, I prayed in Adoration that St. Joseph would send me couples. And he did; we had 11 couples! It was beautiful for the men and women to study and learn about Jesus' foster father together. He is the perfect role model for men on how to be a good husband and father. During the 33-day program, couples that had never gotten married in the Church decided to get married. Couples that were having difficulties in their marriages reconciled. Others that were struggling with forgiveness, received the miracle of forgiveness.

Every week, the group showed up excited to be there, so happy and ready to learn and talk about this important saint. In the past, when I was in front of groups, I would have a panic attack, but St. Joseph removed that problem! I told him, "I just want to be like a guitar that is going to be used for you!" Every single day I heard St. Joseph directing me, showing me what he wanted me to do and how to do it. I know that St. Joseph interceded to bring the couples here. He wants parents to be faithful so that they can raise their children to be holy.

St. Joseph even helped me put a team together. I had people praying for all the attendees. Other people helped with setup and cleanup. Some couples could only come if they brought their young ones, so I even had volunteers to watch the children. They didn't just babysit, they taught them how to pray and they read the Children's Bible together.

We all are beginning a new life now, modeling after the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph!

At St. Lawrence Cemetery, in the circle where the flagpole is, are buried three priests. Each has an affiliation with St. Lawrence O'Toole Church.



Rev. Msgr. Lawrence J. Costello

Rev. Lawrence J. Costello born January 8, 1889, ordained December 20, 1913, and died September 29, 1934 was a Chaplain for the 30th Infantry USA World War and Pastor at St. Lawrence. Fr. Costello opened St. Lawrence O'Toole School and built Sacred Heart Church with Spencer Hance. Ten days before he died, he assisted in the ceremony consecrating Sacred Heart Church where Patrick Car-

dinal Hayes officiated. His obituary flowed with sentiments of parishioners who loved him. One parishioner commented, "His spirit and example inspired others to work with him and to enjoy the experience of real cooperation." At St. Lawrence, he extended the service of the school, secured a new cemetery section, and stimulated Mass attendance. After his death and until his funeral, his body laid in State in our church. Hundreds paid their respects to a priest who added distinctly to the growth of our parish.

Msgr. Bartholomew E. Kilcoyne was born in Brewster on September 5, 1911, ordained May 22, 1937, and died

October 26, 1977. He served St. Ann's, St. Margaret's, and was Pastor of the Most Precious Blood Church. He taught at Cardinal Hayes High School. Msgr. Kilcoyne was the uncle to Judith Bruen, a St. Lawrence parishioner. In 1975, Msgr. Kilcoyne celebrated the funeral Mass of his mother. As was customary at the time, they placed in his mother's hands his manutergium—the pure linen cloth used to bind his newly annointed hands at his ordination. According to a tradition many dioceses are reviving, priests present the manutergium to their mothers at their first Mass. The mothers are then buried holding them. Thus, at the last judgment, everyone on heaven and earth will know they are the mothers of priests and can present the cloths to Christ, saying "my son, too, shared in your priesthood." How beautiful.

Rev. Msgr. Lawrence D. Costello was born December 4,1932, ordained May 30, 1964 and died December 24,1998. (No relation to Rev. Lawrence J. Costello, but was named after him). He was the brother to Maureen (Costello) Durkin, a St. Lawrence parishioner. Maureen's parents who resided in Mahopac, visited Brewster and met Rev. Lawrence J. Costello. They became friends and visited often. When their son was born (Maureen's brother), they named him after the priest they met and loved at St. Lawrence. He served at Our Lady of Lourdes, St. Edward Confessor, and Corpus Christi on Long Island.

All three priests are buried alongside each other, shared a vocation and served Jesus faithfully and with great love. Our flag flies high above them, a symbol of our nation. In 1956 President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed into law our nation's motto which is "In God We Trust." How apropos.

In the Ordinary—Spiritual Genetics

Until recently, I struggled with understanding Original Sin. Not that I didn't believe that the teaching was true, but I couldn't wrap my head around how Adam and Eve's sin could become part of the nature of every human being since.

That each baby born carries the burden of a sinful nature.

Recently I was leafing through The Catholicism Answer Book and read an explanation that satisfies me. "The effects of original sin are significant. If Adam and Eve had been exposed to radioactive material, they would have passed the effects on genetically to

subsequent generations. Spiritually, their sin was transmitted in the same way. We inherit their sin as much as we inherit our genes." So, just as we don't have a choice as to our height or the color of our eyes, we unwittingly inherit concupiscence (the tendency of humans to sin).

I had surmised that all of the bad things happening in God's natural creation, like devastating earthquakes, hurricanes, and tornadoes were somehow directly or indirectly related to generations of sinful human decisions. God had created a beautiful planet, so how could there be so much ugliness in nature? Father Gill told me that some theologians believe that Adam and Eve's sin affected not only their children but cosmically impacted all of creation. That explains a lot.

It is really important that we accept and understand this teaching because without it we can lose sight of why we need a savior. When Adam and Eve sinned, God immediately put Plan B into work; He began setting the scene for Jesus to come and redeem us from our slavery to sin. Jesus began by instituting Baptism and we cannot take that sacrament for granted. By virtue of our Baptism, we not only are cleansed from original sin, but we gain access to the Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit in this life and heaven in the next.

Scripture: Read Romans 5:15-21. Pray on St. Paul's teaching.
