Dear Friends.

Locally we haven't experienced the priest shortage as severely as other places because we have a higher number of foreign priests and priests from religious orders. But last summer I was near Lake George (Diocese of Albany). I saw an article about a priest for that area who oversees twelve parishes, with just two assistants. They rotate among the churches, saying Mass every other week... I wondered if such arrangements would someday be needed here as well.

And a priest friend of mine works in a rural area of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. He runs seven parishes... and around the country, the situation is similar. Very few places have enough priests.

Whatever cushion we had in New York is gone. In a recent meeting with Bishop Whalen, the priests of Putnam and Dutchess Counties had to face some brutal facts: at current rates, priest numbers will decline over 40% in the next 13 years by 2035 as priests retire (we retire at age 75.)

That will impact every parish in our Archdiocese.

Bp. Whalen presented Census data that shows the Carmel and Patterson area with a 20% decline in births and children under the age of five, in just the past five years! Data also shows the Hispanic population growing in those towns by 30% in the same five years.

We added a Spanish Mass in St. Lawrence last year. We'll eventually have to consider a Spanish Mass in Sacred Heart and maybe Carmel will have to do the same for their area.

I've been managing two parishes alone and covering Masses with weekend help from Fr. Tom, who works fulltime at the seminary. And from Fr. Art, who is Judicial Vicar for the Diocese of Bridgeport – he drives an hour on weekends to give a hand. This year we lost our two Maryknoll priests – Fr. Joe Everson was reassigned, and Fr. Joe Heim finally had to call it guits for health reasons at the age of 88.

We have to consider reductions in the number of Masses. The 4:00 pm Saturday Mass at Sacred Heart draws 30-40 parishioners, plus a number from St. Lawrence. Sacred Heart's 10:30 am Mass draws between 75 and 100. Capacity is 240.

So, starting in March, we'll no longer offer 4:00 pm Mass at Sacred Heart. We encourage those parishioners to attend either the 10:30 am Sunday, or come over to St. Lawrence for the Saturday evening Mass, which will be at 5:00 pm starting March 5. People tend to like Mass a bit earlier Saturdays.

Pray for vocations. Bring your families – children and grandchildren to Church. Encourage vocations in your families.

God will help us if we pray, and if we work.



## time well spent


The 1930s, in Brewster, became known as the "era of the chain stores." This era greatly affected the mom-and-pop stores along Main Street that existed since the I800s. A.F. Lobdell & Co., a dry-goods and grocery store on Main Street in existence since 1886, closed in 1933. It could not compete with stores such as the First National and the A&P that established themselves on Main Street and were successful.


As Brewster grew, so did our parish. Following the dedication of Sacred Heart, Fr. Costello took a vacation. While away, he suffered a heart attack and died September 29, 1934, six short days after the dedication of Sacred Heart. His sudden death was deeply felt by all who knew him. The local paper quoted a resident as saying "My friendship for Fr. Costello was one of the unbroken pleasures. I shall have a pleasant memory of Fr. Costello's gentle nature."

Fr. Costello laid in State at St. Lawrence Church. Cardinal Hayes who had dedicated Sacred Heart, officiated at the well-attended funeral Mass. Fr. Thomas Philbin, who would succeed Fr. Costello as our next Pastor, delivered the eulogy. Assisting at said Mass was Fr. Gerard Cahill, who would, in 1957, become the first resident Pastor of Sacred Heart. Fr. Quill, Fr. Costello's assistant, also assisted. More than five hundred cars were in the funeral procession to St. Lawrence Cemetery. Imagine a procession of such multitudes as people stood outside and at their windows to bid goodbye to a priest that was much loved.

It was Fr. Costello's wish to be laid to rest in the cemetery of the parish he called home. He was placed in the center circle of the cemetery, the first priest to be buried there. His sister Mary was present and his sister Grace, who was his housekeeper at the rectory. The American Flag that draped his coffin was presented to Fr. Quill, who in turn, presented it to Grace Costello. Daniel Brandon, Commander of the Argonne Post, placed a poppy on the coffin. The firing squad performed their military salute and "Taps" were played. What a beautiful tribute to our Pastor who was also the former Chaplain for the 30th Infantry during World War I. Today two other priests lie alongside Rev. Lawrence J. Costello - Msgr. Bartholomew E. Kilcoyne and Msgr. Lawrence D. Costello. On my visits to St. Lawrence cemetery, I often stop at the center circle and pray for the priests buried alongside one another; priests of long ago whose lives, especially that of Msgr. Lawrence J. Costello, impacted the lives of parishioners and others and helped mold our parish to what it is today. How grateful I am for their decision to become priests. As we welcome the Seminarians this weekend, let us pray for them and their journey.

Fr. Costello joined a long line of priests before him who served St. Lawrence well. Although his time here was short (I931-1934), it was well spent. In the years that he served as Pastor under Pope Pius XI, there were 20 million Catholics in the world. He was devoted to the parochial school and to the community. He enlarged our cemetery. He supervised the building of a second parish. In Luke 5:1-11 Jesus said, "Come Follow Me and I will make you fishers of men." Fr. Costello was not afraid to think big. He will be remembered for his legacy of evangelization and his response to God's call.



#### **LOVE IS**



I recall that last year I listened to a radio music marathon of love songs on Valentine's Day. As one song transitioned into the next, I started thinking that rather than love songs, I was listening to he-broke-my-heart, she-found-another-man, keeping-my-barstool-warm songs. It left me wondering if it was poor choices by the DJ or

if love is misunderstood these days. Clearly, the Eli Young Band voices the confusion in their song, Love Ain't: "I may not know what love is, girl, but I know what love ain't."


It may be helpful to recognize what love ain't, but more hopeful to understand what love is. As Christians, we are taught that God is pure love. Peter Kreeft explains it beautifully: "He is a volcano of love. He does not fall into love and out of love, as we do, because He is love. God can no more fall in love than the sun can get sunny, or the sea can get wet."

I have found it hard to envision the Father once I matured past the childish image of the old man with the long beard. And an omnipotent Spirit is hard to relate to. So, imagining the Father as The Person of Love – a person made up entirely of love, with Jesus as Love personified, can be comforting, and illuminating.

In his First Letter, John writes, "We love because he first loved us." God models for us how to live love with one another and with Him. Love is misunderstood to be a feeling, when in truth it is a choice. Love is choosing to love people: people who are loveable and people who are not. Love is choosing obedience to God: a work in progress for all of us. As we spend the rest of our lives perfecting our obedience, we can live with the confidence that even our disobedience can't change his love for us.

Scripture: Read 1 John 4:19. What stands out?


