## a challenging time

Our parish continued to embrace **Fr. Philbin**. Rev. John J. Reardon replaced Rev. McGirr as Fr. Philbin's assistant. Fr. Philbin and Fr. Reardon encouraged activities in athletics and theatrical productions which resulted in the increased enrollment in our parochial school, despite the waning years of the Great Depression.

On September 4, 1938, Cardinal Patrick Joseph Hayes died. As New York's fifth Archbishop, he founded more than sixty new parishes. On September 23, 1934, he dedicated Sacred Heart Church. Fr. Philbin attended his funeral service at St. Patrick's Cathedral. Monsignor Lavelle, who presided at the laying of our stone church's cornerstone, spoke, "He was blessed with the combination of prudence, strength, and ability united with a spiritual mildness and modesty that brought success to all his undertakings. He would aspire to be a cardinal shepherd over the vast flock whose spiritual welfare had been entrusted to him, and it was that resolve which stamped every aspect of his episcopate. His greatest tangible work was the organization of the Catholic Charities."

The year 1941 brought joy and great sadness.

During the summer of 1941, repairs were made to our parochial school to prepare for the enrollment of 130 students. In September 1941, the teaching staff consisted of Sisters of the Divine Compassion and Ms. Antoinette Piazza Babon, who taught kindergarten. Mrs. Babon attended our 2016 parish Gala. Sister Mary Justina, R.D.C. taught first and second grade, Sister Mary Alphonsus taught third and fourth grade, Sister Mary Stanislaus, principal, taught fifth and sixth grade and Sister Mary Gonzaga,

R.D.C. taught seventh and eighth grade. Many of us fondly recall these teachers of long ago.

On June 22, 1941, Nazi Germany invaded the Soviet Union. During the holocaust, more than six million Jews were murdered. On December 7, 1941, the Japanese attacked Pearl Harbor killing more than two thousand Americans who drove the US into WW II. As President Roosevelt led our nation, Fr. Philbin led our parish through a challenging time.

In September 1941, fire of undetermined origin razed the Church of the Sacred Heart. Despite the efforts of the Patterson volunteer fire department, the structure was destroyed. It was devastating. The small wooden edifice, with brick foundation, was erected in September 1934 on land donated by Spencer and Margaret Hance, who are buried on the property. Over time, the church was rebuilt. Last June, during a beautiful outdoor Mass at Sacred Heart, a more fitting gravestone engraved with the Hance's names, was unveiled, in fond memory of their generosity and faithfulness.

Brewster continued to develop. Our first firehouse dedicated in 1880 and located near the railroad depot was no longer large enough for our needs. A new firehouse was built, dedicated, and opened on December 15, 1941, located where it presently stands today.

In April 1943, Fr. Philbin, our beloved Pastor from 1934 - 1943, was transferred to St. Bernard's church in White Plains, NY. **Fr. Joseph A. Heaney** became our next Pastor. He had a fiery determination and a strong presence. Many of us remember him well. God gives us what we need. As we unfold the chapter of our history with Fr. Heaney, we will discover that God's plan called for a priest of his caliber.

And it was a gift from God to see families coming with their kids. It was amazing to see the Holy Spirit transforming the lives of these beautiful people and an honor to be God's instrument.

The spiritual health lesson was my favorite. The memory verse for the week was 2 Corinthians 5:17 "Anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!"

The lesson talked about 7 habits for spiritual health. I really found these helpful and I have been trying to put them into practice, such as meeting with Jesus daily, studying and doing his word, learning to love others, serving others unselfishly, tithing, loving Jesus supremely and passing on the Good News! I feel like that is something we could all do better. A simple conversation or interaction could be the tipping point for someone to come to the Lord!

As I read, I waited for him to acknowledge God's providence. But what I disappointedly found here, as in so many memoirs, is that the author is clueless. In his closing paragraph, Brierley writes, "I am astonished at the miraculous turns in my story... It is sometimes difficult not to imagine some forces at work that are beyond my understanding. While I don't have any urge to convert that into religious belief, I feel strongly that from my being a little lost boy with no family to becoming a man with two, everything was meant to happen just the way it happened. And I am profoundly humbled by that thought."

Why is it so hard to credit God for the miraculous turns and coincidences in our lives? And why are we more easily able to recognize God working in other people's lives than in our own?

As disciples, we must reject luck and coincidence as the authors of our lives and give credit to our Father's glorious plan, Jesus' loving mercy, and the Holy Spirit's guiding hand. Ignoring God's presence in our lives rejects God and blocks the full potential he offers us. Two upcoming programs that will help you grow deeper in your faith are **The Search** and **Fr. Couture's talk** on his near-death experience. Deepening our faith not only prepares us to meet God one day in heaven, but also helps us maximize our life experiences here on earth.
