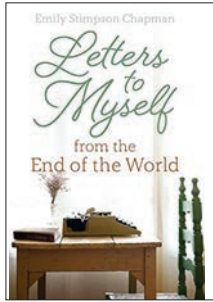

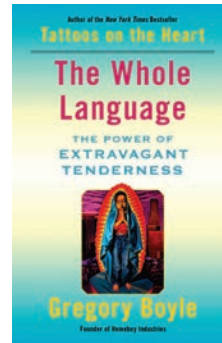

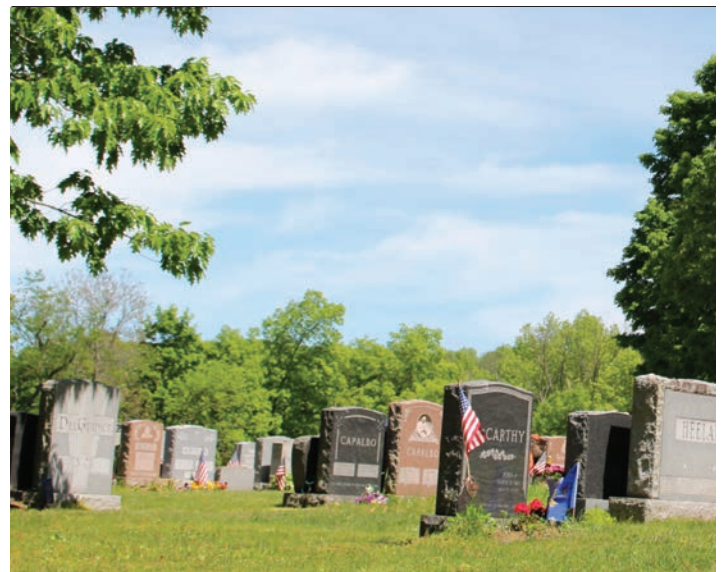

Eucharistic Adoration is when we come to adore Jesus Christ, truly present under the appearance of bread in the Holy Eucharist. Adoration is an extension of the Mass.

Each adorer commits to being a critical link in an unbroken chain of love offered to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament whereby the parish enthrones Him King by giving Him the honor and glory due His name through Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration. By means of perpetual Adoration the community gives great honor and glory to the Lord because, "worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, riches, wisdom, strength, honor, glory and blessing (Rev. 5:12) and to be incessantly adored for all that he has done for our salvation." (cf Rev. 5:9)

The chapel of perpetual Adoration becomes an oasis of peace where people go to gain new strength according to the call, "Come to me all you who labor and are overburdened and I will give you rest." "Be still and know I am God." (Ps 46:11)

During your holy hour, "you are presenting to Christ all those who do not know Him or are far from Him. You keep watch in His Presence on their behalf," bringing down upon these souls in most need of God's mercy the Precious Blood of the Lamb to obtain their conversion so they go to Heaven to be with God for all eternity.

full speed ahead

Fr. Heaney supervised three churches - St. Lawrence, St. Bernards, and Sacred Heart. Each church had its own challenge and Fr. Heaney met each with determination.

In 1948, Fr. Edward A. McCabe became Fr. Heaney's assistant. They were a great match and together raised up our parish and parochial school.

St. Lawrence's stone church had aged over time. Fr. Heaney had to face the challenge of renovating our beloved stone church at a time our parish was struggling financially. God's plan continued to unfold. In 1952, Fr. Heaney contracted Frederick G. Necker, a gifted architect who sought to get his name known, to renovate our stone church at a reasonable price. Fr. Heaney moved full speed ahead with the renovation.

In 1915, only the beautiful Rose Window adorned the back sanctuary wall of our stone church. High across the sanctuary archway was a wooden beam which balanced Our Lord on the Cross, St. John and our Blessed Mother. During the 1952 renovation, the interior was painted, the stations coated in gold, and the sanctuary floor extended several feet toward the church's seating area. Several center aisle front seats were cut back to allow for wheelchairs and to provide a larger accessible area for funerals. On the rear of the sanctuary wall a Celtic Cross design from the famous Irish Book of Kells was placed around the Rose Window. At each corner of the design, were the four evangelists associated with a living creature: Matthew the Man, Mark the Lion, Luke the Ox and John the Eagle. Above the Rose Window

was placed a beautiful scene of the Holy Spirit as a white dove with streams of light focused on an oversized Ireland in its part of the globe. Upon completion of the sanctuary wall, it was found that the three beam figures above the altar, obscured the design. The beam figures were removed. In 2014, during the renovation of our stone church, the beam figures were respectfully placed between our Adoration Chapel and the Sacristy. Some of us remember the beam figures that stood high above the altar and many of us can still visualize the mesmerizing Celtic Cross design that adorned the back sanctuary wall until the 1970s.

In addition to the renovation of our church, the rectory lawn was blacktopped to create a much-needed parking lot. Our catholic cemetery was enlarged, due to the generous donation of a parishioner.

Throughout our history, I am always amazed at how the words spoken by our priests echo one another. During a Lenten Seasons of Praise, Fr. Kareem Smith spoke of sin as being a debt. Fr. Heaney, during a Holy Week homily emphasized "Christ took it upon himself the cross to reveal to us that sin does cost something and must in some way, be paid for. When we surrender our lives to God, our happiness will be our reward."

Under Fr. Heaney, a new church was built for Sacred Heart and St. Lawrence's stone church was renovated. Fr. Heaney and Fr. McCabe believed in the importance of catholic school education. As Brewster continued to grow and develop, the Catholic population increased as did our parish school enrollment.

God's plan for our parish continued to unfold bringing with it changes and growth. Fr. Heaney's vision was again at work as he gazed at our parish school and the next chapter of our history was about to be written.

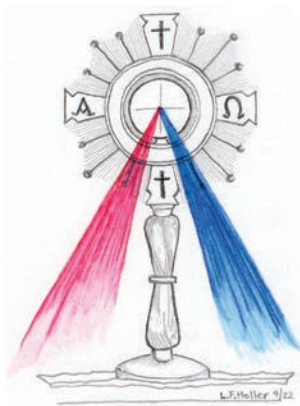

IN THE PRESENCE OF MERCY



This is Divine Mercy Sunday and most of us recognize the now-famous image of Jesus, hand raised in blessing, red and clear/blue rays beaming from his heart and the words, “Jesus I Trust in You” at the bottom. In 1931, Jesus revealed Himself this way to Sr. Maria Faustina Kowalska and instructed her to have the image painted.

Imagine the immense responsibility of that task. She needed to

transmit in words what Jesus Christ Lord of the Universe looked like to an artist who then had to translate her description onto canvas for all the world to venerate! The artist completed the painting after twelve tries and when Sr. Faustina first saw the final work, she went to the chapel and wept with sorrow. In the midst of her tears, she cried to Jesus, “Who will paint you as beautiful as you are?” The Lord responded, “Not in the beauty of the color, not of the brush lies the greatness of this image, but in My grace.”

Jesus promises great graces to those who venerate this image. Divine Mercy expert Fr. Michael Gaitley teaches, “Our faith is about the Word become flesh in Jesus Christ and sacred images are, in a way, the Word become flesh in sacred art. As such,... sacred art can move the heart to an experience of Christ in a way that words cannot always do.”

Jesus provided to us a beautiful way of understanding his mercy through this timeless image, but we must not forget that when we are in church and adoration, we are even more fully in the Presence of Jesus’ mercy. The Blessed Sacrament is Jesus Himself as truly as the Person who posed for St. Faustina’s painting. Jesus is calling us to pour out our hearts to Him. Let’s not fail to see Him right before our eyes.

Scripture: Read First Letter of John 4:16-19. What stands out?

Call to Action: Hang a copy of the Divine Mercy image of Jesus in a prominent place in your home. In church and adoration, remember you are in the Presence of Mercy Himself and ask Jesus to pour out his mercy on you.

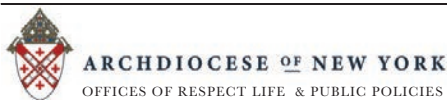
