





Some big deals we should be proud of as a parish, thanks to all of you:

- 1. We raised over \$26,000 plus dozens of cases of supplies for refugees from Ukraine. Thank you! Pray for peace in this terrible, violent world where ambition, lust for power, greed and hatred seem to rule the day and destroy so many lives.
- 2. Our **Divine Mercy Perpetual Adoration Chapel** is inspiring other parishes to make similar efforts in Manhattan, Staten Island, and Orange County. Let's pray it works and we can spread love for the Blessed Sacrament all over. The Bishops are pushing a three year "Eucharistic Revival" now to renew our love for the Eucharist and Jesus's Real Presence. Real reform is always "back to basics" with the Faith. Bravo to our hundreds of Eucharistic adorers!
- 3. Attendance at Easter was up and generally is creeping back now that COVID seems to be fading. Keep on encouraging your family and friends to come back without the Mass and the Eucharist, Jesus occupies an unimportant spot among our priorities.
- 4. **Brewster Cares** was able to purchase a house on Main Street to help our local homeless. We've rented it for a couple of years and it has served as a place for them to come during the day and warm up, get counseling and help. Now we'll be able to expand it and put in showers and laundry facilities. A big win, thank you!
- 5. Our funding for the **Brewster Cares Day Camp** in July-August is getting there.... We've raised over \$60,000 in our parishes and three others are committed to \$10,000 each to cosponsor it. With a little luck, we'll be able to offer full scholarships to more than 200 kids from St. Anthony of Padua parish in the South Bronx to enjoy a summer in the country. Thank you!

The best thing you can do on **May 11** is to go see **Chris Stefanick at St. Joe's in Somers**. We're cosponsoring this event with other parishes and it will be epic. Chris is probably the most important and dynamic speaker in the Catholic world today and he will lead a revival of faith that evening. Check this bulletin for information on getting tickets – there are hundreds of people going already. This will renew our parishes and spark some great new initiatives. Don't miss it!





I AGAPE YOU!



Compared to other languages, English can be very inadequate in expressing certain emotions and concepts. For instance, there are 6 different words for love in Greek. John's Gospel was written in Greek, so the original understanding of today's Gospel reading is heightened if we consider the distinct meaning of the words the author used.

Agape is self-giving love that voluntarily suffers inconvenience, discomfort, and even death for the benefit of another without expecting anything in return. Jesus' love for us is agape love. A second form, philia, is brotherly love; expressed by loyalty to friends, family, and community.

In the original Greek Gospel, Jesus asks Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you 'agape' me more than these?" What we can't appreciate in the English translation is that Peter responds with, "Yes, Lord, you know that I 'philia' you." Jesus doesn't comment on the discrepancy, He just asks again, "Simon, son of John, do you 'agape' me?" Peter repeats, "Yes, Lord, you know that I 'philia' you." Interestingly, the third time, Jesus comes down to Peter's level and asks, "Simon, son of John, do you 'philia' me?" Peter responds, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I 'philia' you."

Jesus was challenging the man who He had chosen to lead his Church. Peter was honest enough not to admit to more than he was capable of at that time. In the weeks and years that followed, Peter's faith grew through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. He taught the message of Jesus Christ boldly and over time his love for Jesus matured from philia to agape.

Jesus is patient with us too. He has pure agape love for each of us, yet He understands when we are not ready to respond with the same. But that is the goal. To be open to the Holy Spirit's graces and teachings and to mature in our faith so that we can each respond: "Lord, you know everything; you know that I agape you!"

Scripture: Read John 21:15-17. What stands out? **Call to Action**: Take five minutes of quiet prayer each morning to ask the Holy Spirit how you can love Jesus with agape love.




