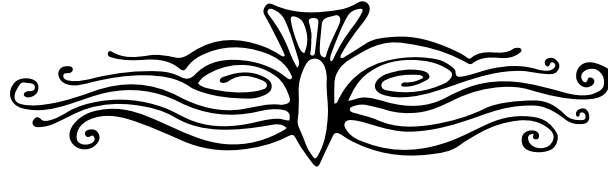

Dear Friends,

When you're in the minority in the culture, it doesn't take long before you start to pay the price for believing differently. Since Jesus' time we Catholics have been in the minority.

This month the Supreme Court may overturn the atrocious abortion decision that legalized abortion. Everywhere in the country pro-abortion groups are preparing to protest at Catholic Churches because we are the Church most steadily and consistently pro-life. You've noticed that the Brewster Police are manning the front of our Church to discourage violence. Let's pray for peace and tolerance of our faith convictions about the sanctity of every human life. In a country founded on religious liberty, we should not need to have police protection. But we do.

In case you haven't noticed, June is "Pride Month" across our society to celebrate people with different sexual or gender preferences and identities. We're even getting a "pride rally" here in Brewster today. Many businesses and sports teams are celebrating "inclusion" and they pressure employees to go along. It was refreshing to see some members of the Tampa Bay Rays have the Christian courage to refuse to wear pride symbols the management was pushing. One player named Jason Adams said:

"A lot of it comes down to faith, to like a faith-based decision. So it's a hard decision. Because ultimately we all said what we want is them to know that all are welcome and loved here. But when we put it on our bodies, I think a lot of guys decided that it's just a lifestyle that maybe — not that they look down on anybody or think differently — it's just that maybe we don't want to encourage it if we believe in Jesus, who's encouraged us to live a lifestyle that would abstain from that behavior... we love these men and women; we care about them, and we want them to feel safe and welcome here."

He expresses the attitude we Catholics should take – be faithful to the teaching of the Gospel, respect and love the others, but stick to the truth.

Next Sunday is the **Feast of Corpus Christi**, and at **3:45 pm we'll have our own procession** through the streets of Brewster in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. Join us to show our love and gratitude to Jesus.

And June is the month of the **Sacred Heart of Jesus** – one of the most beautiful Catholic devotions that expresses the passionate love of Jesus for all of us, and his desire that we all come to his Heart and accept his love. When we do, our lives change to live in the truth. And it is his truth that sets us free.

How appropriate that at the Saturday Vigil, 7:30 pm Mass and

BLESSED FRUIT



We recently celebrated the Feast of the Visitation. Elizabeth miraculously pregnant with John, the Baptist; Mary is carrying Jesus in her womb. Their maternity drew them together and ultimately defined their role in God’s plan of salvation. No human being in the history of the world has made a bigger impact than Mary; Elizabeth may be in

the top ten. No other job or talent trumps their role as mothers. Noah, Abraham, David fulfilled dramatic, heroic jobs for God, but it would not have been possible without the cooperation of their mothers. Who was more important, Moses or his mother?

In contrast, U.S. Treasury Secretary, Janet Yellen told the Senate Banking Committee that the country’s financial stabil-

ity would be rocked if the Supreme Court overturns Roe v. Wade, in part because of its disruptive effect on the labor market. She said, “Roe v. Wade and access to reproductive healthcare, including abortion, helped lead to increased labor force participation. It allowed women to plan and balance their families and careers and research also shows that it had a favorable impact on the wellbeing and earnings of children.”

A favorable impact on children? Interesting how she is disregarding the wellbeing of the 63 million children that were aborted since 1973. Labor force participation? Why is being a computer programmer, a chef in a five-star eatery or even the CEO of a Fortune 500 company a more valuable job than being a mother? Do women have no national value unless they contribute to the Gross National Product?

There is no doubt in my mind that in heaven motherhood will be honored, especially the selflessness and sacrifice that defines that vocation. Elizabeth said to Mary, “Blessed is the fruit of your womb.” As disciples, may we pray that the fruit of all wombs be allowed to grow to perfection and that their mothers be honored for their contribution to the loving Divine Economy rather than the fickle national one.
