Today is the Feast of Corpus Christi where we celebrate our faith in the Body and Blood of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.

All throughout the country, at all the Cathedrals in every diocese, bishops are leading processions with the Blessed Sacrament much as we have done here in Brewster for some years now. It is part of what the American bishops are calling the **Eucharistic Reviva**l over the next three years to celebrate the great gift of the Eucharist.

This afternoon at 3:45 pm, we'll have our procession with the Blessed Sacrament from the train station up to the Church and then Benediction. Bring your family for this beautiful celebration of our faith in Jesus' true Body and Blood. Then we begin 40 hours of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament to honor Jesus's greatest gift to us.



Our **Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel** is one of the great features of our parish, and people are there 24/7 praying for conversions, for return to the faith, and for our parish community all the time in the presence of Jesus. Drop in and make a visit – it is a powerful, spiritual experience everyone should enjoy.

And don't miss **Seasons of Praise Holy Hour** tomorrow night in the Church. Yours truly will be giving the talk and leading the Holy Hour after Fr. Amobi hears confessions from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

Next week is the Feast of the Sacred Heart, and we'll celebrate at Sacred Heart Church with a 1:00 pm outdoor Mass and a picnic afterwards. There will be fun games for the kids and plenty of meeting old friends.

We've got so much good stuff going on at the parishes, and we should give thanks to God for blessing us. But our focus, for all of us, has to be to reach out to those who have either drifted away, or lost their faith or never were raised with faith in the first place. We should invite them back - so many are just waiting and wondering about God, about the purpose of their lives. And a warm, kind invitation from a committed Catholic might be just the moment for them. Give it a try and you'll be surprised how the Holy Spirit works with you...

1960 Cornerstone with Msgr. Heaney, Fr. McCabe and Fr. Fussner

it served us well

TINA GRANT

On November 20, 1960, Msgr. Heaney and Fr. McCabe presided at our auditorium's cornerstone ceremony. Over 250 people attended. Sealed in the cornerstone are: Rosary blessed by Pius XII, medal blessed by John XXIII, St. Lawrence Class of I960 yearbook, list of school staff, picture of Cardinal Spellman, foreign coins, picture of the Connors-Duff house that stood on the auditorium site, and a copy of the New York Times and Danbury Times headlining the election of President John F. Kennedy.

In March 1961, the new school addition and auditorium were completed. On May 20, 1961, dedication ceremonies were held. The Knights of Columbus Fourth Degree Color Guard of the Joseph A. Damin Assembly escorted Auxiliary Bishop Philip J. Furlong, acting for Cardinal Spellman. Bishop Furlong assisted by Msgr. Raymond O'Connor (Mahopac) and Msgr. John Nevins (Croton Falls), blessed the new auditorium "Abide with us O Lord. . . May it remain for all times."

Bishop Furlong blessed the new school's exterior and interior. He blessed and placed on the wall of the new addition the crucifix donated by parishioners Ed and Ann Markel whose son died at 17. Markel Memorial Park built in the l950's by many of our parishioners and members of our community is dedicated to their son. Brewster has always come together as a community and St.

Lawrence has always extended itself outside its doors to be part of that community.

Fr. Kiernan of Maryknoll delivered the declaratory address of the school and hall, "The function of a Catholic school is not primarily to teach the formulas of the Catholic religion, but to transmit a culture, an indispensable element of life, a dimension of our existence, as much a part of man as his hands." Bishop Furlong praised the parish for their hard work sharing how symbolic it was that the dedication took place during the week of Pentecost.

Our school was blessed with Sisters of the Divine Compassion and lay teachers who touched the lives of the students they taught. From 1926 to 1978, over fifty nuns taught at our parish school. We recall the impact they made, their contributions to our parish, their dedication and faith. It was a time we will never see again. It is impossible to include all the history contained within our school walls - the teachers, students and services performed there. Those of us who walked those halls remember and will always cherish what we received and how we grew as a family. When the school closed in June 2008, it marked the end of an era. Yet, it has served its purpose well. For over 80 years, it provided an exemplary catholic education, developed lasting friendships, and added tremendously to the parish community. During the 2014 church renovation, the school became our present parish center. Today, it continues to provide faith filled education and continued community through its Early Childhood Learning Center (ECLC) and the many ministries and events held. The foundation has remained, and the spirit that it was meant for, continues.





msg. mccabe high school scholarship

The St. Lawrence Council of the Knights of Columbus provides scholarships for parishioners of St. Lawrence O'Toole parish to attend Catholic high school. Scholarships can be awarded to an 8th grade student entering a Catholic high school or a 9th grade student who is already enrolled and continuing at the Catholic high school. For students entering freshmen year, a 4-year scholarship could be earned while a 9th grade student entering 10th grade could earn a 3-year scholarship. After the initial scholarship is paid to the school, a student maintaining acceptable academic performance will then be awarded subsequent follow-up scholarships. The maximum scholarship is \$1,000 per year.
